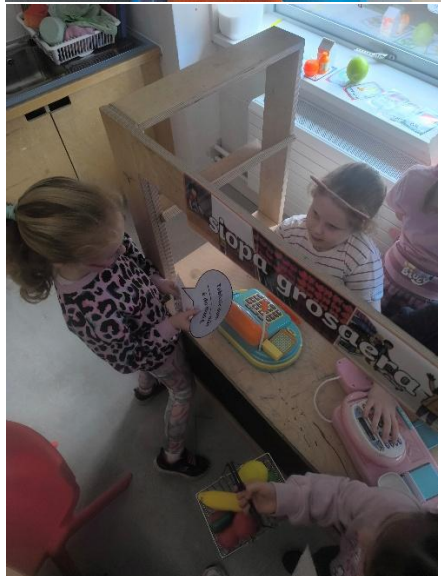
We loved dressing up and having fun!
