Our School is a Safe Place

In our school, we work together to make sure every child feels safe, happy and cared for. School is a place where children can learn, have fun, and be themselves.

Who Can Help You If You Are Worried?

If you are worried or upset, you can talk to a trusted adult in school. This could be your teacher, the principal, or another adult who helps in our school. Trusted adults listen, care about you, and help you.

What Helps Children Feel Safe and Happy in Our School

Children feel safe and happy in our school when adults listen and care about them and when everyone is treated kindly and fairly.

What to do if Something Doesn't Feel Right

You can:

- Say 'Stop' or 'I don't like that.'
- Walk away.
- Tell a trusted adult. Keep telling until you get help.

It is always okay to tell.

We teach **Stay Safe** to help you feel safe at school and in your life outside of school too.

If someone says or does something to hurt you, or make you feel uncomfortable, you can tell an adult that you trust.
