Mia: My favourite thing this year was when I brought in my snails. They are big African snails.



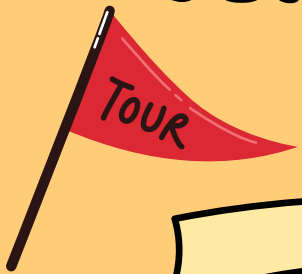

Ariya: My favourite memory this year was when we made a fort out of sticks in the forest.

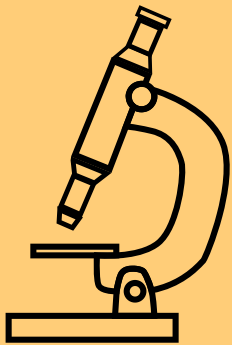
Leon: For the science fair, Ruairí, Cillian and I made two baking soda volcanos and the explosion was huge!!!
