



Dublin Bay Cycling club is the newest cycling club in Dublin. It was set up by Colm Sevastopulo & Tony Woods in May 2024 in response to the fact that there were no cycling clubs on the North side of the city accepting youth members. Colm & Tony work in primary schools across North Dublin, teaching children how to cycle safely on the roads. Dublin Bay CC is open to everyone who likes riding a bike, be that competitive racing or just rolling along on the bike paths.
