In History, we learned about many people and periods from the past, including the Romans and the Normans. One of the highlights was constructing Motte and Bailey castles, which helped bring our learning to life.





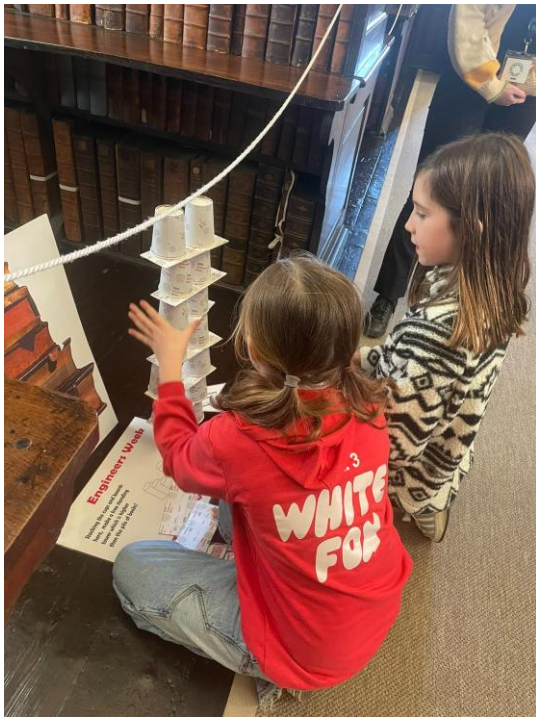
