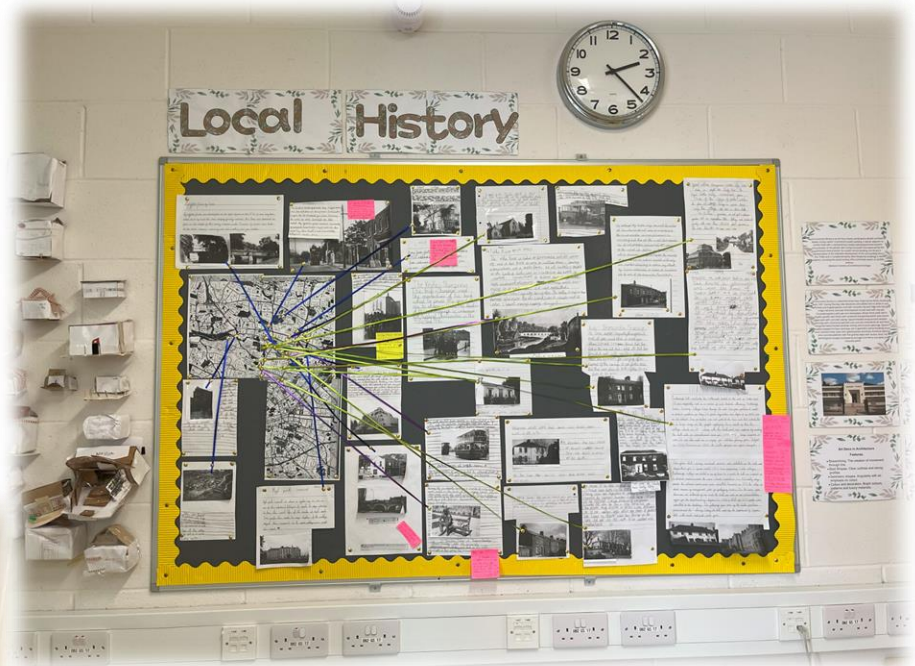
We enjoyed reading and playing treasure hunt with younger classes during Seachtain na Gaeilge.
