

Wellesley College Dining OZZI Box Program

The OZZI Box Program is Wellesley College Dining's reusable to-go container option for students who need a meal on the move. Instead of using disposable packaging, students can take food to go in a durable reusable container, return it after eating, and receive a token for a clean and sanitized container for your next use.

How It Works

1. Pick up an OZZI reusable to-go container when you need to take a meal with you.
2. Use the container for your meal and enjoy your food outside the culinary center.
3. After eating, empty or wipe out the container as best you can.
4. Return the used container to a designated return location.
5. Receive a token so you can get another container the next time you need one.

Where to Pick Up and Return Containers

Students can use OZZI containers at participating dining locations, including Lulu, Bates, and Tower. Return bins are available at Lulu, Bates, and Tower, where students can exchange a used container for a token to exchange for a clean and sanitized container.

Important Reminders

- Do not remove the barcode sticker from the bottom of the container; it is needed for returns.
- Outside containers are not allowed because of health code requirements.
- If you lose an OZZI container or token, a replacement fee of \$7 will apply. You can use your Flex dollars to purchase a new or additional container.
- Students who are sick should contact Health Services and use available dining guidance for meal support.

Why Use an OZZI Box?

Using an OZZI box helps reduce single-use waste while making it easier to eat between classes, work shifts, meetings, practices, rehearsals, or other commitments. The program works best when students return containers promptly so they can be washed, reused, and kept in circulation.
