

## PROSPECTIVE PARTNERS APPROVAL PROCESS INFOGRAPHIC

The process for application by prospective partners involves a 180 day four-step process to become an approved institution of higher learning...



#### Initial Survey

Prospective institutions are invited to complete the initial survey found on the Global Methodist Church website.

The Committee on Approval will review your survey and provide a written response within 30 days to either proceed to step two, or reason why your institution will not be invited to proceed further in the process.



# Formal Application

A formal application for approval measures five areas (accreditation, ethos, pathos, logos, kairos). This survey is completed via Word doc and is shared with the Committee on Approval for review.



### Onsite Visit

After the formal application has been reviewed, qualified applicants will receive invitation to the third step: the onsite visit. A team from the Committee on Approval will visit your institution for an in-person review, and ask to visit the campus, a class setting, chapel, and for visits with the leadership and students of the institution.



#### **Final Review**

After the initial survey, formal application, and onsite visits have been completed, the Committee on Approval will review its findings and offer a final finding in writing to prospective partners.
