


PROSPECTIVE PARTNERS APPROVAL PROCESS INFOGRAPHIC

The process for application by prospective partners involves a four-step process that may take up to 180 days to become an approved institution of higher learning...




Initial Survey

Prospective institutions
complete the initial survey
found on the Global
Methodist Church website.
The Committee on Approval
will review your survey and
provide a written response
within 30 days to either
proceed to step two, or a
reason why your institution
will not be invited to proceed
further in the process.



Formal Application

A formal application for approval measures five areas (accreditation, ethos, pathos, logos, kairos) on a deeper level. This survey is offered via electronic format to prospective institutions by invitation only.



Interactive Visit

After the formal application has been reviewed, qualified applicants will receive an invitation to the third step: the interactive visit. A team from the Committee on Approval will interact either via video call or in-person to learn more about campus, class settings, chapel, and to hear from leadership and students of the institution.



Final Review

After the process has been completed, the Committee on Approval will offer its findings to the Ministry + Higher Ed Commission for final approval. Institutions will be notified in writing of their final finding.



Helpful Information

Approved institutions will receive either FULL (6 years), or PROVISIONAL (1-5 years), status.

Please consider your planning as completion of the approval process may take up to 180 days.

All partner institutions will be reviewed every seven years.
