

VEHICLES & VEHICLE PASSES AT SEASCAPE FOR VISITORS

All visitors at Seascape are required to display a valid vehicle pass while on the premises, whether driving or parked. Vehicle passes are required for ALL vehicles, including motorcycles, scooters, mopeds, scoot cars, golf carts, etc. All fields on vehicle passes must be filled out completely.





All fields on the vehicle passes must be completed. Fields on the vehicle pass include the following:

Short-term vehicle passes are valid for the duration of your stay, with a **maximum** allowed duration of 15 consecutive days per short-term vehicle pass. Vehicle passes are single-use passes (one vehicle) and cannot be shared.

As stated on the front of the vehicle passes, failure to accurately complete all fields will result in a **\$25.00 ticket**. Other violations of HOA rules may result in additional fines.

Vehicle passes should be **hung from your rearview mirror** or **placed on the dashboard** on the driver's side. The **front** of the pass **must** be visible.



Scooters, Scoot Cars, Scooter Trikes, Mopeds, Motorcycles

- Rental guests and visitors may enter Seascape on a scooter, scoot car, scooter trike, moped, or motorcycle but are only permitted to drive straight to the unit and/or destination at Seascape.

- Cruising through Seascape on any of these vehicles is NOT permitted.

DRIVING & PARKING AT SEASCAPE FOR VISITORS

When driving within Seascape, please observe all posted speed limits.

Unless posted otherwise, the speed limit at Seascape is as follows:

Speed Humps & Bumps: 10 mph
 Tennis Village: 10 mph
 All Other Areas in Seascape: 17 mph
 Main North Entrance Road: 20 mph



At stop signs, please come to a **complete stop**.

There are very few sidewalks within Seascape, all of which are near the high-rise buildings. When driving through Seascape, please use caution and be aware of other Seascapers walking, jogging, **or biking** the property. Please yield to all pedestrians.

When parking your vehicle at Seascape, please follow these guidelines:

- A valid vehicle pass must be displayed on every vehicle at Seascape.
- Park in paved areas only. Do not park on the grass or sand.
- In the villa area throughout Seascape, there are only 1.5 parking spaces allocated per unit, on average. If you have more than two vehicles associated with your rental unit, please be mindful of the limited parking spaces for other nearby units.
- Trailers, watercraft, RVs, or any oversized vehicles are not allowed to park on the streets or in any Seascape HOA parking areas. <u>Trailers, watercraft, RVs,</u> <u>and any oversized vehicle must be kept in off-site storage facilities</u>. Refer to the following page for more info.
- Unauthorized vehicles, those parking illegally or without a valid vehicle pass, may be towed at the owner's expense by an authorized towing company.
- In the villa areas, on Tuesdays & Fridays, please do not block the trash corrals or trash bins, and make sure the trash bins are accessible to the trash company.



Golf Carts & Golf Cart Charging Stations

- Not every unit at Seascape has access to a golf cart charging station.
- If you will be bringing an electric Golf Cart that needs to be charged, be sure to reach out to the property manager or unit owner to confirm access to such charging stations.



TRAILERS / WATERCRAFT / RVS / OVERSIZED VEHICLES – NOT PERMITTED AT SEASCAPE

In general, rental guests and visitors are <u>NOT permitted to park</u> trailers, watercraft, RVs, or any oversized vehicle at Seascape.



If you intend to bring a trailer, watercraft, RV, or any oversized vehicle on your vacation, please make arrangements to **store it offsite**.

A list of local outdoor storage facilities is provided as a courtesy below. This list is for informational purposes only and no company or service is specifically endorsed or recommended by Seascape HOA.

Campers, RVs, boats, trailers (including golf car trailers), buses, and all other oversized vehicles are not allowed to park within Seascape. However, in rare cases, the Association Manager may grant permission for temporary parking for an oversized vehicle if unique circumstances warrant it. The Association Manager shall have sole discretion to determine whether an exemption shall be granted. In such cases, the responsible party must purchase and display an appropriate vehicle pass.

The high-rise buildings (Ariel Dunes I, Ariel Dunes II, Wyndham, and Majestic Sun) may have different policies in regard to oversized vehicles. For additional information, please consult with the CAM of the appropriate building.





PETS AT SEASCAPE - NOT PERMITTED IN SOME BLDGS/UNITS

While some rental units at Seascape allow pets, other buildings and/or units **DO NOT** allow rental guests to bring a pet. **Before you bring a pet, please consult**with your rental company or the unit owner to confirm your rental unit allows
pets. This will help you to avoid a potential fine.



All Seascape owners and guests must follow these pet guidelines:



1) **LEASH your Pet:**

 All Pets must be on a leash at all times, except when inside your unit.



2) **CLEAN UP After your Pet:**

- Please use the 22 dog waste stations located within Seascape (pictured on the right).
- Please be sure to clean up after your pet, or you may be fined.
- Please do not dispose of pet waste in normal trash bins – only dispose of waste at the pet stations.
- Please keep pet waste away from buildings, patios, and entryways. Be considerate of neighbors.

To **report problems** pertaining to a pet on the property, contact the Seascape Security Patrol Rover at 850-865-7327.

Violations are subject to a **fine** of up to \$100 per day, per violation.



Part 2: About Seascape



AMENITIES AT SEASCAPE

Seascape is a unique 330-acre **beachfront community** located in Miramar Beach in beautiful South Walton (SoWal). Situated on the Gulf of Mexico in the Florida Panhandle, Seascape is a large and diverse property that contains 1,429 units and over 100 residential buildings, including both modern high-rises and charming golf/garden villas.

Seascape offers many fantastic amenities. Perhaps Seascape's top amenity is a wonderful 2,000-foot stretch of undeveloped white sand beach that is within easy walking distance of the entire property. Seascape also has 12 pools, 6 clay pickleball courts, 6 clay tennis courts, an 18-hole golf course, a basketball court, a beach volleyball court, a children's playground, and 5 restaurants.


BEACH AT SEASCAPE

Seascape is fortunate to have 2,000 feet of wide-open beachfront access. Our beach is within **easy** walking distance of every unit on the property. When going to the beach, always use one of the crosswalks when crossing Scenic 98.

Seascape Beach offers several paid amenities that may be of interest to visitors. These include waterfront **beach chairs & umbrellas** provided by La Dolce Vita, as well as a **fun mix of water sports** like paddleboards, kayaks, and jet skis. Parasailing is also available during the summer season.

Beach Flag Warning System

All South Walton (SoWal) beaches utilize a four-color beach flag system to alert beachgoers of general warnings about overall surf conditions. This Beach Flag Warning System has been utilized since 2005 across all the beaches of South Walton, including Seascape.



Beach Showers are Available throughout Seascape


When leaving the beach and before you enter your rental unit or any pools at Seascape, please rinse the sand off your toes at one of the beach showers on the property.

Beach showers are available at the lower level of Whale's Tail as well as all five of the pools throughout the property. The Lakefront area, near the beach entrance, also has beach showers, as does Majestic Sun and Wyndham on the east side of the buildings.



POOLS AT SEASCAPE

There are five pools available for all Seascape rental guests and visitors to enjoy at Seascape. No matter where you are located on the property, you will find one or more pools nearby.



There are additional pools at Seascape that are accessible only to guests staying in certain buildings on the property. These buildings have their own pool bands that are required for entry.



TENNIS & PICKLEBALL COURTS AT SEASCAPE

Tennis Courts

There are six (6) clay tennis courts at Seascape, located in Tennis Village. The Destin Tennis Club (DTC) manages these tennis courts.

These courts are available to owners, guests, and renters – limited to one session of tennis per unit, per day at no charge. A session means a 1-hour session for singles play or 1.5 hours for doubles play. Reservations can be made by calling (850-654-4287) or going to seascapetennis.skedda.com. Locals can play through hourly court rates or memberships. For more info on the Tennis Village courts, call (850) 654-4287 or visit DestinTennisClub.com.



Pickleball Courts

Seascape offers six (6) clay pickleball courts. Seascape's pickleball courts are open daily from 8 am - 10 pm, weather permitting. The pickleball courts are *free for use by all Seascape owners, renters, and guests*.



Seascape <u>wristbands are required</u> to verify your access to Seascape amenities, so please bring yours with you.

The pickleball courts are **located in the Triangle neighborhood of Seascape**. Triangle is located in the center of the Seascape property.

Play is on a first-come basis. If people are waiting, please limit your play to 1 hour total for singles or 1.5 hours for doubles. Please wear clay-court-friendly shoes (i.e., not too much tread). Sweep the court after use. Other rules are posted at the courts.

Note: We recommend the use of **Onix Pure 2 outdoor balls** for playing on the clay courts. Other types of balls may not perform well on the clay.

BASEKETBALL & BEACH VOLLEBYALL AT SEASCAPE

Basketball Court

Seascape's basketball court was transformed in 2020 into a multisurface sport court with two hoops. The basketball court is open daily from dawn to dusk.



The basketball court is *free for use by all Seascape owners, renters, and guests*. Seascape <u>wristbands are required</u> on the court.

The basketball court is located on the west side of Seascape, on N. Driftwood Bay near Tennis Village. Refer to the map at the beginning of this section.

Basketball Court Rules



HOURS:

- Dawn to dusk

COURT USAGE:

- For Seascape owners, guests and renters only
- Seascape wrist bands required for access
- Use courts at own risk
- Keep noise to a minimum in respect of residents
- Usage on a first come basis
- Limit play to 1 hour if others are waiting
- Play fair and friendly
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult
- Paid athletic services or lessons must be authorized by Seascape HOA
- Non-basketball activities on the court must yield the court to basketball players
- Do not hang on the rim or otherwise use the basketball court in an inappropriate or hazardous manner

NOT ALLOWED ON COURT:

- Food, glass, or alcoholic beverages
- Smoking or vaping
- Bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, etc.

Playground

The playground is located across from the basketball court and is sure to provide endless fun for young visitors. The hours are from dawn to dusk. *Please note that the use of playground equipment is at your own risk.* An adult must accompany younger children under the age of 5. No rough play is permitted, only one person on a slide at a time, no jumping off of the equipment, and no glass or pets in the play area.

Beach Volleyball

Seascape's beach volleyball court is located on the beach, just east of Whale's Tail. Play is on a first-come, first-serve basis.

The volleyball court is *free for use by all Seascape owners, renters, guests, and other beach patrons*. Seascape wristbands are <u>NOT</u> required on the court.





FISHING AT SEASCAPE – CATCH N RELEASE ONLY

Catch n release fishing is permitted in these locations only at Seascape:

1) Stewart Lake

- Only permitted in front of condo buildings and on the Boardwalk
- Not permitted on the golf course around Stewart Lake
- Refer to the map below (green = acceptable fishing locations)
- Fishing is **NOT** permitted on any golf course lakes/ponds
- The lakes/ponds at Seascape contain **reclaimed water** from South Walton Utility for irrigation purposes, and as such, it is unhealthy to consume fish caught in these lakes/ponds
- A **fishing license** is not required for catch n release fishing at Seascape
- When fishing, be sure to park on paved areas only. Parking on the grass is not permitted.

Trash Pick-Up at Seascape

The way trash is handled varies depending on the location of your unit at Seascape. The table below outlines the basic process for both high-rise units, The Grove units, and villa units.



High-Rise &	Rental guests can dispose of trash via trash chutes, located on					
The Grove Units	each floor in the high-rise buildings.					
Villa Units	 Rental guests can dispose of trash in the trash bins, typically located in trash corrals near the building. Some trash corrals are attached to the front of the building and other corrals are free-standing. In Tennis Village, each unit has an individual trash bin that must be placed in the carport or street on trash days. Please make sure all trash is placed in a trash bag and is broken down. Any trash left outside of the trash bin will not be picked up. Trash pick-up days at Seascape are Tuesdays & Fridays. 					

ote: All trash receptacles are for normal household trash and garbage ONLY.

Leave No Trace on the Beach

Leave No Trace is a worldwide initiative aimed at keeping our beaches clean. When you leave the beach at Seascape, please clean up after yourself and take all your belongings with you. Any items left on the beach overnight will risk being discarded.

- Walton County Municipal Code supports the Leave No Trace program by requiring personal items to be removed from the beach each night.
- Personal articles that are found abandoned on the beach one hour after dusk until one hour after sunrise will be removed.
- Leave No Trace is monitored by TDC Beach Code Enforcement of Walton County.

- Your assistance is appreciated in keeping our beaches clean & safe for both beachgoers & nesting sea turtles.



Beach Trivia

Ever wonder why the sand is so white at beaches in the Florida Panhandle, including the beach at Seascape? Well, our sand particles actually come from the Appalachian Mountains.

At the end of the last ice age, the Apalachicola River carried small quartz crystals from the Appalachian Mountains all the way to the Gulf of Mexico (in the city of Apalachicola, 108 miles east of Seascape). Today, the crystals continue to extend west from Apalachicola all the way to the Pensacola Pass (~50 miles west of Seascape). This explains why our **beaches have the whitest sand between Apalachicola and Pensacola.**

Keep the Beach Clean, Dark, and Flat for Sea Turtles

Nesting season for sea turtles is May 1st through Oct 31st.

These are the three ways that <u>Friends of South Walton Sea</u> <u>Turtles</u> want everyone to leave our beaches.

- CLEAN up as you leave by taking all your beach gear and trash with you. This not only protects turtles and other sea life on the beaches of South Walton from possibly eating or getting trapped on something you've left behind, but it also helps keep mama turtles on track when they're coming ashore to lay their eggs.
- Keep it DARK. Dark as a dungeon. Any flickering light can mislead new turtle hatchlings and cause them to head in the wrong direction when they're struggling to make it to the Gulf.
- 3. Keep the beaches FLAT when you leave. No holes or large sculptures were left behind. Please fill in those holes and knock down those sculptures. The poor mama turtles can get stuck in a hole, and holes can disorient the baby sea turtles.

Cable TV – Remote Troubleshooting Guide

Basic Functions

- 1. Use only the COX Cable remote pictured here for TV operations.
- 2. Press POWER to turn on and off the TV.
- 3. VOLUME and CHANNEL Up/Down arrows will control basic operations.
- 4. Use GUIDE and selection arrows in the center of the remote to preview channels and program scheduling.

Troubleshooting

- 1. If the TV is showing "No Signal", ensure that the cable box is powered on. If the TV is still reading "No Signal," a new input may need to be selected.
- 2. Select new input by pressing the INPUT button to ensure the remote is controlling TV functions. The input button will also be used to change to DVD or other devices. Use directional arrows to navigate and select the appropriate input.
- 3. HDMI1 or HDMI2 should be the proper input selection for the cable box.
- 4. If you are still having difficulties, contact COX at 855-512-8876 and press option 1 for assistance.



SEASCAPE NEIGHBORHOOD MAP


