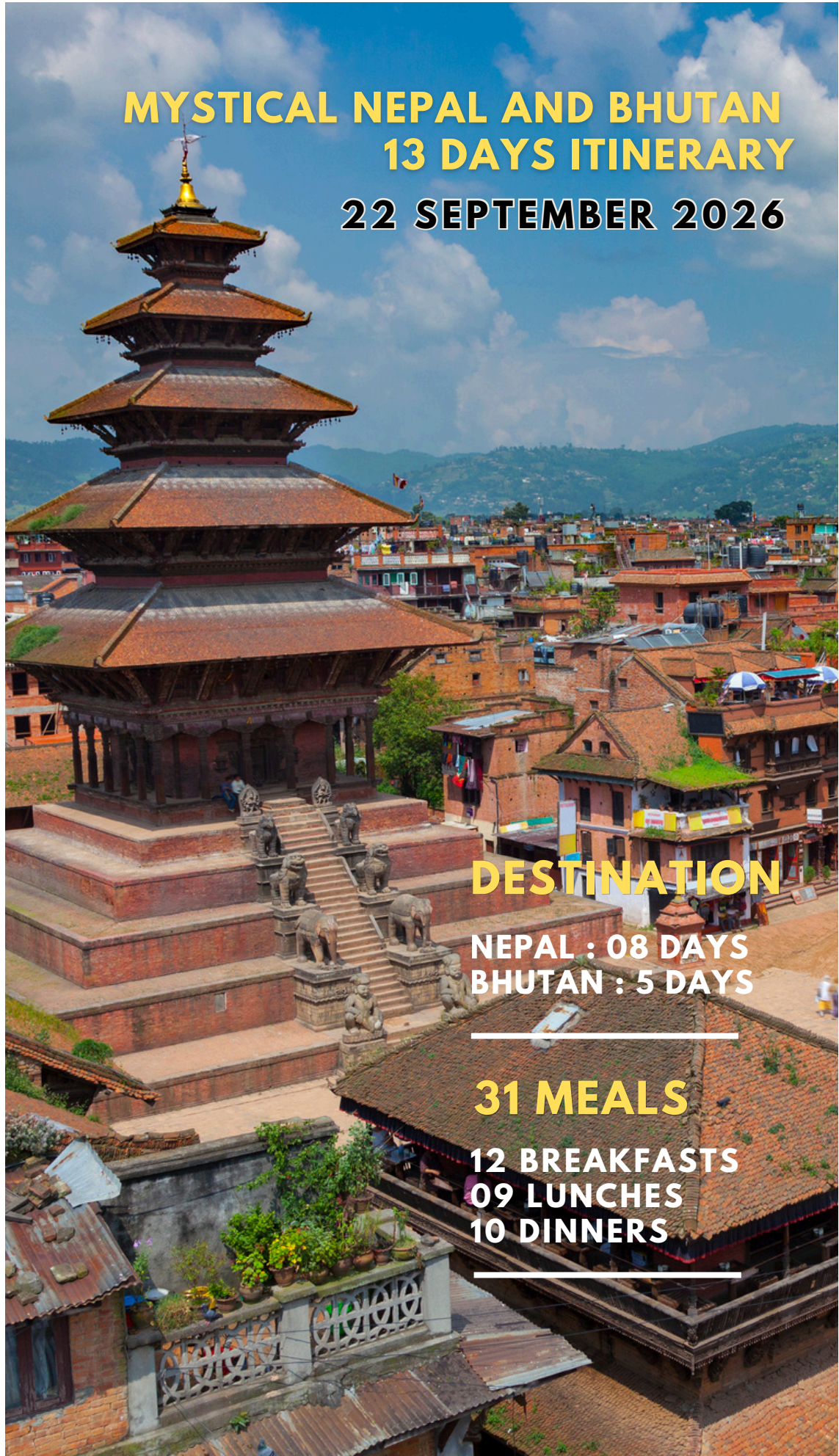

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 : KATHMANDU

Morning arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport at Kathmandu. Our representative will greet you with Khada at the airport escort you to the hotel (Check-in Time at 14:00 hrs). Afternoon free for rest.

Meal : Welcome Dinner at Hotel

DAY 2 : KATHMANDU

Morning sightseeing of **Swayambhunath** (UNESCO World Heritage Site): Swayambhu means "Self-Created." The world's most glorious Buddhist Chaityas **built 2000 years** ago situated on top of the hillock. You will have a panoramic view of the valley from this spot. Swayambhunath is considered one of the most imposing stupa in the world, rises high. One can reach the stupa by going up about 365 steep stone steps.

Later **Kathmandu Durbar Square** (UNESCO World Heritage Site): Located in the heart of the capital city, is also known as Hanuman Dhoka square. The name Hanuman Dhoka came from the statue of Hanuman at the entrance of the royal palace, established by the Malla King from **15th to 18th century**. The Major attraction in Kathmandu Durbar Square are **Taleju temple**, gigantic figure of **Kalbhairav (the god of destruction)**, **Basantapur Durbar Palace**, Shiva-Parvati and **temple of Kumari** on the residence of living goddess.

Afternoon **Patan Durbar Square** also known as Lalitpur and Golden Temple, . Patan Square and its surroundings is good specimen of ancient Newari architecture. There are three main courtyards in the



Palace ; **Narayan Chowk. Mul Chowk, Keshav**, Several multi-sized and multi-styled temples occupy the western part of the complex. Main among these is Krishna Temple and the Golden Temple of Hiranya Varna.

Meals : Breakfast and Lunch

DAY 3 : KATHMANDU

Morning sightseeing of **Boudhanath Stupa** (UNESCO World Heritage Site): It was renovated in 8th century. The 36- meter-high stupa of Boudhanath is one of the **largest stupa** in South Asia. Here you can see many monasteries surrounding it. On each side is a pair of the all-seeing-eyes of the Buddha symbolizing awareness. This holy place is very important for pilgrimage and meditation for Nepalese people, Tibetan Buddhists as well as Tourist.

Later **Pashupatinath** (UNESCO World Heritage Site): This is the most sacred Hindu shrines in the world. The richly-ornamented pagoda houses the sacred linga, or phallic symbol of Lord Shiva. Chronicles indicate the temple's existence prior to 400 AD. Devotees can be seen taking ritual dips in the holy Bagmati river flowing beside the temple. **Cremation of the dead body** Hindus/Buddhist takes place at the bank of Bagmati River at Pashupatinath. Later **MOMO Cooking**

DETAILED ITINERARY

Demonstration (making Momo and Lunch): Momo is a type of dumpling popular in Nepal, Tibet, and neighboring regions. Momo is more than just a food; it's a cultural symbol representing Nepal's rich culinary heritage. Making momos can be a social activity, a great way to gather with family and friends.

Bhaktapur Durbar Square (UNESCO World Heritage Site): The ancient Bhaktapur city is also known as Bhadgaon and located 15 Km east of Kathmandu city. Bhaktapur Durbar Square was built by King Yaksha Malla in **15 century** and was renovated by King Bhupatindra Malla in 17th century. This city is one of the unique master pieces of wood carving, stone carving and also for Pottery that preserves the world's oldest pottery profession. The Major attraction in Bhaktapur Durbar Square are: **Peacock Window, Golden Gate, The palace of 55 windows Pottery Square, Taleju Temple** and many more.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch with Momo Demonstration and Dinner.

DAY 4: KATHMANDU - POKHRA

Morning fly to Pokhara. Pokhara is located in the northwestern, at an altitude of 900 meters and 200 Km from the Kathmandu. This is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Nepal. Pokhara is also famous for **beautiful lakes and magnificent views of the Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, Makalu, Manaslu, Machhapurche.** Afternoon sightseeing of **Devi's Fall, Tibetan Refugee Camp and Gupteshwor Cave.** Later **Boat ride on the Phewa Lake** - visit **Barahi Temple**, located at the center of Lake.



Evening observe Aarti in the evening at Lakeside. AARTI: a Hindu ritual dedicated to deities like Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati, takes place at Phewa Lake. The **ceremony, often accompanied by traditional music**, is a draw for both locals and tourists seeking cultural immersion and a peaceful experience.

Meal: Breakfast and Dinner.

DAY 5 : POKHRA

Early morning drive to **Sarangkot** (1592m) to for the sun rise and Mountain view (Weather Permit) then on the way back visit **Bindhyabasini Temple** - This is Hindu temple dedicated to the goddess Durga, and **Old Bazaar** – This is a traditional market and most of the houses are built by using red brick. Then back to hotel for Breakfast and rest. Later visit of tallest Lord Shiva Statue at Pumdikot is one of the major attractions in Pokhara and has developed as a beautiful destination for religious tourism at Pumdikot where Nepal's tallest Lord Shiva Statue is established. It is located in the southern part of Pokhara at an elevation of 1500 meters from sea level. Shiva Temple also has a massive Shiva Damaru which is one of the biggest in Asia.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Then visit World **Peace Stupa**, situated on hilltop. It is a Buddhist stupa; a monument to inspire peace. **Peace Pagoda** is also known as Shanti Stupa, a Buddhist stupa designed to provide a focus for people of all races and creeds, and to help unite them in their search for world peace. From here you can enjoy a panoramic view of **Annapurna Mountain range, Phewa Lake** and Pokhara valley.

Afternoon Free for walk around Lakeside.

Meal: Breakfast and Lunch.

DAY 6 : POKHRA-KATHMANDU

Morning fly back to Kathmandu Late Afternoon Heritage walking Tour, explore of typical **local market** called **Ason Bazaar**. This is very old market lying in the heart of the Kathmandu valley. The six different streets converge on Ason Bazaar make it the busiest junction in Kathmandu. Later **Rickshaw ride around local market**. Evening is for leisure and preparation for Bhutan trip.

Meal: Breakfast and Dinner.

DAY 7 : KATHMANDU - PARO - THIMPU

Morning fly (1.5 hrs) to Paro. During the flight, one will experience **brehtaking views of Mount Everest, Kanchenjunga** and other famous **Himalayan peaks**, including the **sacred Jomolhari** and **Mount Jitchu Drake** in Bhutan. On arrival at the Paro International Airport. Then drive (65 KM/ 1 hr) to Thimphu.

Later visit **Tashichho Dzong**. Tashichho Dzong means 'the fortress of the glorious



religion.' It is a majestic fortress in all its grandeur and serves as the seat of Bhutan's government. **The Dzong** houses the secretariat, the throne room, the offices of His Majesty the King and the ministries of home affairs and finance. The fortress was initially erected in 1641 and later rebuilt in the 1960s by the third king, Jigme Dorji Wangchuck.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 8: THIMPU

Morning drive up to **Buddha Point**. Buddha Point has the **largest statue of Buddha** in the whole kingdom. You can get a very good view of **Thimphu valley** from here.

Later the Folk Heritage Museum. Built in 2001, the **Folk Heritage Museum** gives a glimpse of how life was lived in a Bhutanese village a hundred years ago.

Afternoon visit the **National Memorial Chorten**. The National Memorial Chorten was built in 1974 in memory of the late Third DrukGyalpo (King) of Bhutan. At the chorten, you will find an extraordinary depiction of Buddhist teachings in the form of paintings and sculptures. Visit the **Changlimithang** ground and explore local market.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner.



DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 9 : THIMPU - PHUNAKHA

Morning drive to Punakha (77 KM /3 Hrs). On the way, stop at **Dochula pass** (3100 m) to view the most beautiful view of the **entire Eastern Himalayan Mountain ranges**. Besides, you will also get to see the **108 Miniature Stupas** at Dochula Pass.

On reaching Punakha visit the Punakha Dzong. Cross over the **longest suspension bridge** in the country over the **Pho Chhuriver spanning** 180 m. You will enjoy the swaying walk across the bridge draped with **colorful prayer flags** and visit the **little village shops** at the other end in this spiritual world.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 10 : PUNAKHA-PARO

Morning Visit **Chimi Lhakhang**. Later drive (142 KM/ 4 Hrs) to Paro. Afternoon visit of **National Museum (Ta-Dzong) and Kyichu Dzong**. In the evening stroll around Paro Town.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 11 : TAKSHANG

Morning visit to (hike about 3 hrs) **Taktsang Monastery (Tiger's Nest)**. (we suggest to wear comfortable shoes for hike, you can also hire Pony by your own expenses). Back to hotel for rest. Evening visit local Market and see the beautiful view of **Rinpung Dzong**. **Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**



DAY 12 : PARO - KATHAMANDU

Morning fly back to Kathmandu. Day is at Leisure, An optional free day in Kathmandu gives you the perfect chance to explore at your own pace—wander through the vibrant streets of **Thamel** for shopping, visit the historic **Narayanhiti Palace Museum**, or simply unwind with a relaxing traditional **Nepali massage**. Evening farewell Nepalese dinner with culture dance at authentic Nepalese restaurant.

Meals: Breakfast and farewell Dinner with wine

DAY 13 : KATHMANDU -DEPARTURE

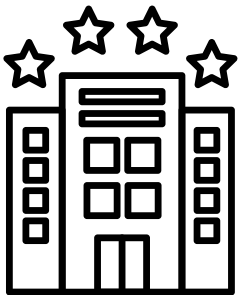
