## DAY 1 : ARRIVAL DAY AT DELHI

## DAY 3: DELHI TO UDAIPUR FLIGHT

## DAY 4 : TOUR OF UDAIPUR CITY

The City Palace Museum, Udaipur is housed within the very iconic, 450 year old Palace, the former abode of the rulers of Mewar, later we will visit Saheliyon Ki Bari, or Garden of the Maidens, is an ornate garden complex that stands as an exemplar of regal aesthetics merged with natural beauty. the garden was designed as a peaceful retreat for the Queen of Udaipur and her maidens. lunch at local restaurant and evening in Leisure.

## DAY 5 : UDAIPUR TO JAIPUR FLIGHT/TRAIN

**Thursday, 26 October** **(Long Day)**

After breakfast, we will transfer you to the Udaipur airport to board the flight to Jaipur or we may take train. Jaipur is named after its founder Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II was established on 18 November 1727. Jaipur is considered the first planned city in the country. The city is also known as 'Pink City'



# DETAILED ITINERARY



In the afternoon we will visit City Palace, situated in the heart of the old city occupies about one-seventh of the Old City. Later we will visit Jantar Mantar Observatory, built in the 18th century by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh to study the movement of constellations and stars in the sky. In the evening drive through the Birla Temple and Albert Hall Museum.

## DAY 6 : JAIPUR TOUR WITH SHOPPING

**Friday, 27 October (Relaxing Day)**

After having breakfast, check out from hotel leave for Amber City; on the way we will have a brief stop in front of the Hawa Mahal, 'Palace of Winds' a five-storied semi-octagonal building having 152 windows that was built in 1799 AD by Maharaja Pratap Singh. the capital of Kachhwahas for six centuries before the foundation of Jaipur City. It takes about 3 hours to visit the fort, after fort we will go to see local crafts factory and after lunch we will visit world famous local market and Visit of Gem & Jewel factory is optional in the evening.

## DAY 7 : JAIPUR TO RANTHAMBORE

**Friday, 28 October (Relaxing Day)**

Relaxing Morning and later drive to Ranthambore National Park. Ranthambore National Park a 392 sq km park comprises dry deciduous forests sprawling over on undulating terrain of the Aravalli and Vindhyan ranges. Ranthambore is the finest tiger reserve in the country under the Project Tiger. Besides the Tigers, Ranthambore has a large number of Sambhar, Cheetal, Nilgai, Chinkara, Langur, wild boar, and peafowl. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and rest of the day free at leisure for your own activities or relax in the hotel.

## DAY 8 : SAFARI DAY AT RANTHAMBORE

**Saturday, 29 October**

**Early Morning & Eve Safari**

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Agra; located at the bank of River Yamuna remained the capital of the Mughal Empire under the Emperors till 1689. En route visit 1100 years Abhaneri Step well Chand Baori, It extends approximately 30 m. into the ground, making it one of the deepest and largest stepwells in India. its construction is dated to the 8th-9th century. It has 3500 steps cascading 13 stories deep into a massive tank at the bottom and has been constructed in an upside-down pyramid-style.

## DAY 10 : TAJMAHAL AND DIWALI DAY

**Monday, 31 October**

**Relaxing Day / Diwali Celebration in Night**

After Breakfast visit the Taj Mahal, Shah Jahan built this beautiful monument in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, followed by inlay marble work factory, same work done in Tajmahal. Later visit to the Agra Fort is a world heritage site

listed by UNESCO.

In the evening enjoy the Diwali festival with local family with home hosted dinner, Diwali is a Hindu festival of lights, with variations celebrated in other Indian religions. It symbolises the spiritual "victory of light over darkness, good over evil, and knowledge over ignorance"

## DAY 11 : AGRA TO KHAJURAHO BY TRAIN

**Tuesday, 01 November (Long Day)**

Early in the morning, transfer to Agra train station to board the train to Khajuraho. Have your breakfast in the train. Upon arrival in Khajuraho, transfer to the hotel for check-in. In the afternoon proceed to visit the very famous Khajuraho Temples, UNESCO World Heritage Site for their beautiful and erotic rock carvings.
