

Thousand Oaks Girls Softball Association 2025 Season of Thanks Tournament

Manager information regarding the upcoming Season of Thanks Tournament.

Teams with the 1st game of the day cannot be Los Cerritos Middle School prior to 7:00am.

At Los Cerritos-No spectators can sit in the outfield grass. Spectators must sit in the bleachers or along the 1st and 3rd base lines behind the out-of-play fence lines.

Please also inform all parents that no parking is allowed in the condominium complex across from Los Cerritos as these are private streets and any car parked illegally will be towed. All parking must be on the public streets or in the school parking lots. Cars parked in the yellow zones will be towed or ticketed by the Thousand Oaks Police Department. Please respect our neighbors by using public sidewalks and streets to access the fields and not "cutting" through their private property.

Please note that TOGSA will follow and strictly enforce the ASA rules of conduct.

1. **Team managers are responsible for and must have control of their players, coaches, and team followers at all times, including on and off the field of play.**
2. **The Southern California ASA Code of Conduct and all acts that are contrary to the objectives and purposes of ASA, shall be enforced throughout the tournament.**
3. **Artificial noisemakers of any type will not be allowed (i.e. horns or cans filled with rocks).**
4. **Umpires and/or ASA representatives shall have the responsibility and authority to eject (out of sight and sound) any team personnel or spectators for abusive language, charging, bumping, shoving, striking, threatening a player, coaching staff, spectator, or team from the tournament facility.**
5. **An ejected coach, player, or other team personnel is ineligible to participate in the team's next game. Illegal participation of ejected personnel results in the forfeiture of that game for the team. A second ejection in the same tournament makes the participant ineligible for the remainder of the tournament. Each sanction (ineligible for next game, team forfeiture, and ineligible for remainder of tournament) may be appealed to the tournament protest committee.**

NO DOGS will be allowed on school grounds at any time per California Board of Education. Anyone bringing a dog onto Los Cerritos Middle School will be asked to remove the dog from the school grounds. No BBQ's will be allowed at Los Cerritos Middle School.

Any cars parked in the loading zone may be ticketed or towed.
