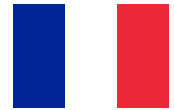

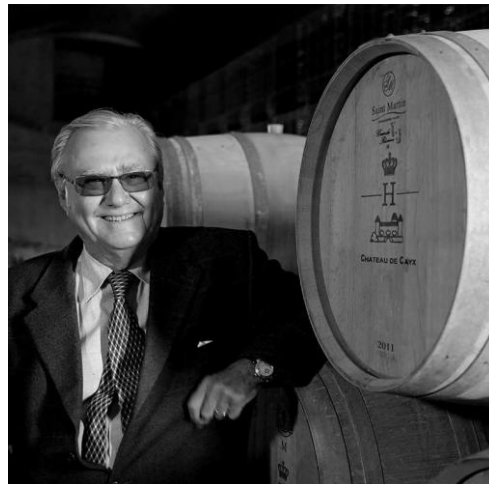
Château de Cayx is located in the middle of the Cahors region and dates back to the early 15th Century.

The 24 hectare Cayx vineyard boasts a magnificent full south-facing orientation, an oceanic climate with a Mediterranean influence. In the valley hollow it is 90 meters above sea level and the river regulates the temperate in the area and acts as source of water for the fine wine terroirs.

Cahors Appellation d'Origine Protégée (AOP) - This wine comes from 7 hectares of vines with an average vine age of 35 years old.

Wine Area

Clay-limestone, on a hillside, south facing.

Vinification

Following green harvesting, the leaves are manually removed from the grapes and the berries are selected on a sorting table. The grapes are mechanically harvested and first sorted by machinery before being sorted manually for the second time on the table in the cellar. Château de Cayx AOP undergoes a cold (8°C) pre-fermentation-controlled stainless steel tanks. Alcoholic fermentation and maceration take 28 days at a temperature of 26/28°C, while final maceration occurs at a temperature of 32/35°C. Malolactic fermentation and the aging process takes place in new barrels, filling up 1/3, for a minimum of 12 months.

Tasting Notes

A purple-coloured wine, Château de Cayx has a delicate aroma of red fruits and delivers all the intensity and fleshy character typical of Malbec. The wine has spicy notes and silky tannins on the palate. Château de Cayx's concentrated nature is characteristic of the finest Cahors wines; it is elegant and can be cellared for up to 10 years.

Serving Suggestions

To be served at 19° C and compliments with a duck breast or a leg of lamb.

LA CIGARELLE CHARDONNAY

Summary

A local wine from Cayx, La Cigaralle comes from 4 hectares of Chardonnay planted, mostly on the limestone terraces around the Château. "Cigaralle" is an old word probably from Catalan and was used in Aquitaine and Occitanie to describe a pavilion built in a park or a pleasure garden where you can hear the song of cicadas. The grapes undergoes mechanical harvesting, direct pressing, cold settling, and thermo-regulated fermentation in stainless steel vats before aging on the lees.

Wine Area

First terrace from Lot, limestone plateau.

Vinification

The grapes are mechanically harvested, directly pressed, cold-settled, fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats before maturing on lees.

Tasting Notes

This wine has a complex and expressive nose, with exotic fruit and white fruit notes. It is ample, smooth and slightly buttery on the palate with a delicious mineral base that is supported on the palate by real freshness.

Serving Suggestions

Ideal as an aperitif, with seafood or shellfish.

The grapes are destemmed, followed by maceration before vinification.

Tasting Notes

This stunningly intense black wine has a powerful nose of fresh fruits with grilled and vanilla notes. It is fruity and silky on the palate with a light finish on a coulis of dark fruits.

Serving Suggestions

Serve at 16-17°C. Perfect with tapas, delicatessen meats and grilled sausages. Ready to drink or be drunk within two years.

Wine Area

First terrace from Lot, limestone plateau.

Vinification

After using the skin contact method, the juice thus obtained undergoes fermentation at low temperature.

Tasting Notes

This rosé has a strong bright pink colour. Its linden blossom notes are followed by lychee and grapefruit. This rosé is ample and expressive on the palate, and attains a successful equilibrium between the fruit and acidity.

Serving Suggestions

Serve at 10-12°C. Perfect with cold starters, delicatessen meats, salad, grilled fish and Mediterranean style dishes. Ready for drinking or to be drunk within two years.

Vinification

After harvest, the vine is manually stripped and the berries are selected on a sorting table. A cold pre-fermentation maceration is carried out for 3-4 days, then alcoholic fermentation begins and a long maceration of more than 30 days in a vat of 50 hectoliters. During this period, manual *pigeage* are carried out in order to extract all the contents contained on the grape skin, and to refine the tannins. This wine is then aged in new barrels for at least 24 months.

The *Majesté du Château de Cayx* cuvée lives up to its name. This 100% Malbec red wine comes from the Cahors AOP region. It is a wine suitable for aging and can be cellared for up to 15 years. Cuvée Majesté comes from a plot of 1.5 hectares of vines and benefiting from clay-limestone, on a south-facing hillside. Average vine age is 35 years old, with a density of 5,000 vines/ha.

Recommendation

We advise you to decant the wine at least 1 hour before tasting to reveal the exceptional qualities of this wine.

Tasting Notes

This cuvée reveals an intense and complex nose offering with a refined marriage of black fruits, vanilla and chocolate, stimulated by menthol notes. The palate, at once full-bodied, velvety and suave. It reveals a woody finish that gradually fades in front of the black fruit notes.

The Duke of Württemberg (Herzog Von Württemberg) estate owns around 40 hectares of vineyards in the Württemberg growing region. They are decedents from King William II of Württemberg. From the middle of the 17th century to the end of the 19th century, the House of Württemberg acquired seven of the best vineyards in the country.

The Duke of Württemberg's winery have been part of the Association of German Prädikatsweingüter eV for over 25 years. The Verband Deutscher Prädikatsweingüter eV (VDP) is the oldest national association of top-quality wineries in the world. They have defined a four-level VDP.classification pyramid that divides the quality of their wines according to their origin: VDP.GUTSWEIN, VDP.ORTSWEIN, VDP.ERSTE LAGE® and VDP.GROSSE LAGE®. The VDP.Traubadler on the bottle cap is the seal of quality of VDP.Wines. It stands for artisanal winemaking from excellent vineyards.

VINEYARD LOCATIONS



Today the vineyards extend from Stetten im Remstal to Maulbronn. Each of the six individual sites has its specific terroir, which is reflected in the wines. Nowhere else in Württemberg can you taste so many different wines of distinguished origin from a single source.

The Duke's wine range takes you on a trip through Württemberg at the highest level: starting in the west with the Maulbronn Eilfingerberg, a former monastery vineyard location from the 12th century; further into the lovely Stromberg landscape to the wine village of Gündelbach to the Steinbachhof there and to the Hohenhaslacher Kirchberg; then towards the Neckar Valley, where sun-drenched red wines thrive on the cliff-limestone cliffs of Mundelsheim.

The State capital is not left out either: near Stuttgart-Untertürkheim, where the ancestral castle of the Württemberg people once stood, the winery has owned vineyards on Mönchberg since 1671. In the Stettener Brotwasser location, which is the sole property of the House of Württemberg, has one of the best Rieslings in the country that grows below the Y-Burg: the Stettener Brotwasser.

"The Herzog" (lat .: Dux) is the top cuvée of the winery. A combination of **Cabernet and Merlot**. The long maturation time in barriques leaves a powerful, yet fine-meshed taste that is reminiscent of ripe forest berries, plums and cherries.

BACKGROUND

A special wine that is not produced every year and occupies the top position in the House's red wine range. **It stands for the life's work of the Duke, His Royal Highness Carl Herzog von Württemberg, who was born in 1936.** 81 years later, the grapes for this wine grew on matured vines and can be enjoyed after almost three years of maturation.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

For this cuvée, the varietal composition changes when the vintage allows it to be produced. In the 2018 vintage, the **Merlot and Cabernet grape varieties** were involved. A small part of the grapes was deliberately left on the vine for a long time. **These very ripe and partially dried berries were harvested separately.** They were supposed to give the cuvée even more depth and ripe tannins - which they did. Most of the expansion took place in **new oak barrels from the ducal forests.** As a result, aroma of wild berries, cherries and plums; the relatively high alcohol content, which is well buffered on the tongue, also suggests rum pot. The taste of the wine is enormously opaque, powerful, fiery and fine-meshed.

The 2017 vintage of this wine took 1st place at the VINUM German Red Wine Award 2020.

The 2016 DUCISSA won 1st place in the FOCUS wine test 2020. This red wine cuvée is made from Lemberger, Pinot Noir and Cabernet. After 18 months of aging in barriques. The wine is finely woven, like a silky robe, with an elegant expression. Notes of cedar wood and pine needles cavorts in the aroma. The combination of the three grape varieties Lemberger, Pinot Noir and Cabernet give the cuvée a powerful, complex taste with an invigorating berry scent. The finish is considerably long.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Lemberger, Pinot Noir and Cabernet are the partners for this wine, whereby the Lemberger has an immense taste and thus represents the "icing on the cake". Half of the wines were matured in new and half used barriques (second occupancy) and combined six months before filling so that they could find each other harmoniously.

The wine has an invigorating smell of blackberries and wild berries, it has a very youthful taste, reveals a good acid structure behind a soft fruit and is supported by well-integrated tannins. Decanting is entirely appropriate.

BACKGROUND

A distinctive and expressive Lemberger. A strictly selective harvest brings density and flavor, paired with lots of black fruits, fine roasted aromas and an enormous body. Classic and typical of its kind - a picture book of Lemberger. Its expansion took place for 18 months in barriques. With a delicate blackberry aroma, cedar wood and some plums, plus a delicate roasted aroma from the first 16-month of aging in barriques. A selective harvest had already provided the basis for a lot of fruit, a pronounced and a rich body to the wine. The wine develops gentle pressure and a brilliant play of fruit on the tongue; in the finish as it remains present for a long time.

FOOD RECOMMENDATION: Tomato essence, pot roast in a strong sauce, beef roulades, game dishes, goulash that is not too spicy, and roast beef.

The dry wine from VDP. GROSSER LAGE is called VDP. GROSSES GEWÄCHS ("GG"). This rating distinguishes the highest quality of German vineyards. The locations are limited to the exact parcel. The best wines with an expressive character and aging potential.

DESCRIPTION

The golden yellow colour indicates that the grape material is very ripe. Citrus and pineapple cavort in the aroma, accompanied by a delicate mineral. The taste of this pleasantly light wine is stimulating, gently vibrating and shows a delicate play of fruit in fine acidity. The yield was greatly reduced. After a selective hand-picking, the must was fermented long and cool. The young wine then lay longer on the fine lees and refuelled with subtleties.

BACKGROUND STORY

The name can be traced back to a lady-in-waiting who lived in Stetten at the end of the 17th century. She had the jug that was intended for the "bread water" filled with wine. It was noticed that the servants did not rush to the well to refill the jar but marched into the cellar.

LOCATION - RIESLING

Stettener Brotwasser is one of the best location in Württemberg with its optimal grapes variety of Riesling. Its old sandstone terraces is protected by dry stone walls around a small basin directly below the ruins of the Y-Burg. It has a slope of up to 60% and is owned solely by the Duke of Württemberg.

LOCATION - ZWEIGELT

In Hohenhaslach Kirchberg, where this Zweigelt comes from, viticulture was already practiced over 1200 years ago. Even then it was probably recognised that the forest on the Stromberg heights offers protection from the wind and has temperature-regulating influences. Meaningful red wines, including Lemberger and Trollinger, grow on the south-facing slopes below the village church. And the Zweigelt, which was first planted here in 2004 by the House of Württemberg and passed its practical test, so that more vines were planted in 2009.

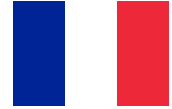

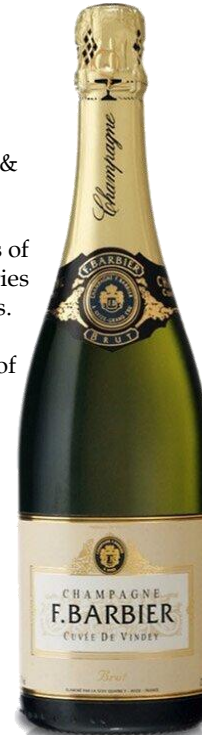

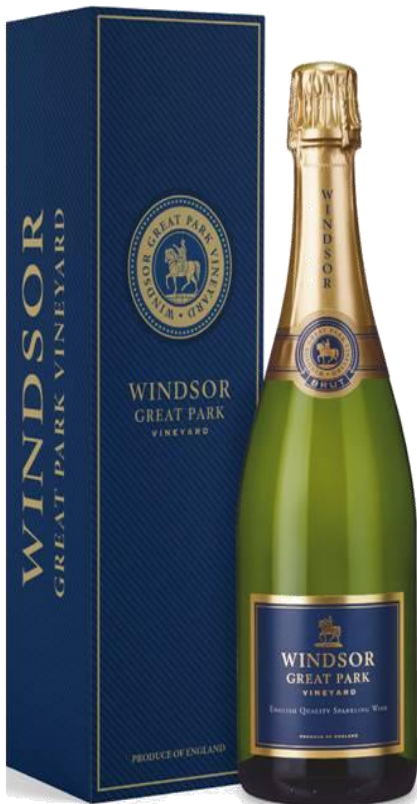

A family affair...

In August 2021, our Director had the pleasure of meeting both Howard and Hugo (father & son) joint-owner of Court Garden Vineyard. Their warm, personal, and welcoming hospitality is the essence of a family run vineyard.

Hugo provided a tour of the vineyard, and explained the varieties of grapes being grown on site. An interesting part of the tour was going through the process of making their English sparkling wine. From pressing, fermentation, to riddling and disgorgement. This is a lengthy process done with care and precision through the *Traditional Method*.



The Vineyard & Winery

Court Garden Vineyard was established in 2005. The Manor of Ditchling Garden, from the middle ages to the reformation, it was held by the monks at the priory in Lewes. After a short spell owned by the Crown, the farm became known as Court Garden.

The farm appears on one of the earliest maps of Sussex, Yeakell and Gardner's map of 1778-1783, just to the north of Ditchling. Not much has changed in the landscape since then. Court Garden Vineyard's sparkling wines are all made using traditional grape varieties and bottle fermentation, where long aging on the lees adds to the complexity of the flavour.
