Pastor Tim's Report

This year marks 50 years of ministry for HFC on the Northwest Freeway.

Throughout this year we have worked to accomplish the vision set by influential leaders from 50 years ago and now look to cast our own vision for what the next 50 years can look like. Our hope is that we can Fuel the Mission from Jesus to be disciples that make disciples.

Pastor Sarah, Pastor David and Naomi will each be describing how God has worked through Kid's Ministry, Youth, Worship, Community Groups and Outreach. All of these areas were significant in the early days of the church on Hwy 290 and God is still changing lives and families through these pivotal ministries. I'm so grateful for the team we have! Each is outstanding in their own right while all of us are better together.

I praise God for 13 people who gave their lives to Jesus in the last 12 months and testified of that change through baptism. Also in that celebration is a prayer request. We are trying desperately to get every new believer connected with a disciple maker but we are falling short. Please pray about how God could use you to help others grow toward becoming disciple makers themselves.

Part of the way we have aimed to Fuel the Mission is through both a Women's Retreat in the fall and a Men's Retreat in the winter. Both brought great challenge and fruit from those times together. As a result of the Men's Retreat a Men's Group started meeting on Wednesday nights with a high focus on transparency and submission to the leading of God's Holy Spirit in those times of gathering.

I have personally taken a step of faith toward Fueling the Mission by serving with the Kid's Ministry on the first Sunday of each month.

This has been an awesome time to build relationships with the kids but has also created opportunities for others to preach and grow in leadership skills that will serve them well in years to come.

In our pursuit of God's vision to multiply the staff and elders meet with Craig from Multiply Project to begin to look at how we can move from talking about church planting to actually starting a new church. We also had a group go to the Disciple Makers Forum in The Woodlands which provided many breakouts for how to live the life of a disciple maker.

Finally then, our year culminated with the 50 Year Anniversary Celebration. We were led in preaching by Pastor Sarah Mathewes, Rev. Charles Flanagan, Pastor Gary Hammons, new graduate Chris Barron, and special guest, Dr. Cliff Sanders. It was a powerful time of worship focused on how we can look back to celebrate in order to Fuel the Mission for the next 50 years.

God has done great things in and through HFC in 2025. Let's all seek ways to Fuel the Mission through personal steps of faith, generous giving of time and finances, and preparing to be sent across town, next door, to coworkers and to family members. We strive to pursue the Vision to Multiply through the mission to be disciples that make disciples.

Pastor Sarah's Report

This has been an amazing year in our children's ministry! Our continued focus on relational discipleship on Sunday mornings is creating a space for children to experience real connection to God and others, and find true belonging with friends and in their faith community. HFC Kids has seen growth in many ways: students surrendering their lives to Christ for the first time, serving in new ways around HFC, and deepening their personal walks with steady growth in prayer and Bible Study. We have had 5 students make first time decisions, 3 at VBS, and are having conversations and planning for baptisms soon!

We have added several new team members who are excited to help guide the next generation in discipleship. We are so blessed to have team members who see the value in all they do with our children's ministry, whether changing diapers, or leading small group time. The new focus in team trainings over the past year has allowed for our team to not only be trained in curriculum, safety, and relational discipleship, but to also focus on the heart of each and every student, meeting them where they are and creating a space to feel safe and seen, while also learning about God. We have seen positive change in our team, our program, and our students!

On Wednesdays at Kids Club, we are focusing on topic studies, either having further discussion and learning from Sunday's lesson, or in answer to specific questions the students are asking. We are having fun with object lessons, games, and crafts. We have a few new Wednesday team members as well, and we are so grateful to all who take time to serve our students and families.

Beyond discipling our kiddos and our volunteers, we are also striving to disciple our parents as well, and provide them tools for family discipleship! We are still hosting a monthly meeting for parents of kids and youth, and we have a new social media platform to help deliver family discipleship and encouragement, *building_young_disciples*, as well as our website content found at: *hfcog.org/family*

Our partnership with ACC for Sunday Kids Club is still intact, and we are so blessed to have this unique combined ministry opportunity. Our students are thriving and continue to learn so much from one another. We look forward to continuing our partnership and celebrating this unique opportunity.

Youth:

What a wonderful year we have had so far. God has been moving in many different areas of our ministry, and it is fantastic to know that so many of you are praying for our students. Our youth ministry has been a beacon of hope and inspiration, with activities such as a youth rally with Concilio, Fields of Faith, and our youth camp this summer. God was working in the lives of our students, and four from HFC decided to get baptized at camp. This was an amazing experience for our entire group and a testament to the power of our collective prayers and efforts.

I've been able to continue partnering with Jersey Village High School's Men of Honor Club, the FCA youth pastor leadership team, and TXM Youth Camp Leaders. I understand that sometimes we don't see what God is doing, but I assure you, our partnerships are opportunities for us to do ministry. Ministry doesn't only happen inside our building; often, it occurs outside of our church walls. We are actively seeking to add adult volunteers to our ministry, and I am very grateful for everyone who has volunteered with our students in any capacity. Your support means a lot to us.

A special thank you goes to everyone who contributed to the youth camp for one of many students; your support made it possible for 18 students to attend Camp.

What's next:

Discipleship is something we always look forward to. If you feel the Lord is leading you to disciple someone, please let me know. I'd love to sit down with you to see if one of our students is a good fit. IYC 2026 is just around the corner, and next year we're heading to Cincinnati, Ohio. Our students are already excited about this event. We will be raising funds to cover costs like food, lodging, travel expenses, and more. Please pray for the youth ministry, asking God to provide everything we need for this trip. Our ultimate goal is to lead our students to Jesus. The best way to support youth ministry is to pray for us.

We will continue our partnerships with Fields of Faith, Jersey Village High School, and the Men of Honor & Leading Ladies Club. Also, our parent discipleship meetings will continue to provide a safe space for parents to have conversations and learn more about family discipleship.

Worship:

We have witnessed God's power in many ways; we have met new families and had many get baptized over 2025. This year, we had the opportunity to invest time in our online sound system. As many of you might remember, we purchased two digital consoles a year ago, one for live sound and the other for online sound. We are always learning and improving how we present our video and sound to give the HFC family the best quality possible. Although none of the worship techs are professional audio engineers, we invest time in learning new ways to improve our online experience.

We are thankful to Boyce Erwin for leading our 10:25 service and everyone else who serves in that service. We have maintained a balance between traditional and contemporary and introduced new songs to our worship library. Our students have been able to recommend songs, and we are thankful for their initiative. This year, we started implementing leading worship services a bit differently. Everyone in the worship team has been able to lead more than one song in our 11 am worship services, rather than one person leading every song by themselves; this helps with balance and makes practices more effective.

Naomi Dingle's Report

The vision that God has given Houston First Church of God is clear. To be a church that plants churches. We believe in multiplication, not just in numbers but in discipleship, influence, and Kingdom impact. And the way we will get there is through our mission: to be disciples who make disciples of Jesus Christ.

Community Groups are the heartbeat of discipleship. Places where individuals can grow in their faith, find accountability, and experience authentic connection. Each group provides an opportunity for people to dig deeper into Scripture, pray together, and walk alongside others in their spiritual journey. It is our desire that everyone is connected to a group.

This past year has been one of the most powerful and transformative seasons of ministry I've experienced. Through Leadership Focus and preparation for ministry licensing, God has been refining my leadership, deepening my walk with Him. As I've grown spiritually, I've also watched God multiply His work through the church; in relationships, in community partnerships, and in the lives of people being reached beyond our walls.

Through groups like the Jersey Village Professional Networking Group (JVPNG), BNI, and ABWA, I've had the opportunity to represent Houston First Church of God in business circles, community meetings, and outreach events across Northwest Houston. What began as professional connections quickly became opportunities for ministry; conversations that turned into prayers, business meetings that turned into Bible studies, and friendships that became family.

I've personally prayed with many individuals and families - people I've met in these community settings and watched as God opened doors for meaningful spiritual conversations. Between events, networking groups, and follow-up moments, we've connected with more than 50 individuals who have visited HFC in some way this year. Whether attending a men's breakfast, joining a Bible study, serving on a Saturday project, or coming to hear the Word of God preached.

In addition to prayer, we have been intentional about distributing Bibles at many of these meetings. I'm deeply thankful for those who have taken the lead in bringing God's Word to others and for those who gather small groups together to pray at any given moment. These acts of faith, simple yet powerful, remind me that God is always at work, planting seeds of hope in hearts all around us.

Every handshake, every text message, and every prayer shared in a parking lot or meeting space has been part of God's greater story of redemption. People may not always walk through our church doors, but they are encountering Christ through connection, compassion, and authentic relationship.

In May, HFC attended the Disciple Makers Forum, where one of the sessions I participated in was titled Discipleship in the Workplace. That session confirmed so much of what God has already been doing through our community connections this past year. The speaker shared that ministry doesn't just happen behind a pulpit it happens wherever God places you, whether that's at a networking meeting, in the office, or across a lunch table. That truth resonated deeply with me because it's exactly what I've

seen God doing through ordinary conversations becoming moments of prayer, connection, and transformation.

In addition to these ministry opportunities, I have also had the privilege of engaging with leaders and business owners through the Cy-Fair Chamber of Commerce, CFISD (Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District) and the Texas Workforce Commission. These relationships create new opportunities for partnership and community connection. While much of this work is still in development, we are laying the foundation for long-term collaboration that aligns faith with service.

Additionally, while Pastor David has already been instrumental in connecting HFC with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), this year I was also able to engage with FCA through the Cy-Fair Chamber of Commerce, further layering our outreach efforts. It's been powerful to see how God is aligning these relationships strengthening our collective presence in the community and extending the reach of our church's influence into schools, teams, and families.

Through each of these connections, the church continues to build bridges of influence demonstrating that faith, education, and community leadership can work hand in hand to further the Kingdom of God. I also have the honor of leading a weekly prayer meeting at Shield Bearer Counseling Center, where we pray for counselors, clients, first responders, and our community.

Looking ahead, I believe God is using this season to remind us that the church is not a building, it's a movement. The seeds we're planting through these connections are already bearing fruit in ways we cannot yet see.

As we continue to live out our mission to be disciples who make disciples, we're watching the vision of multiplication come to life. From community groups to prayer gatherings to partnerships across Houston, every act of service and every word of faith brings us one step closer to being the kind of church that plants churches - a church that multiplies for the glory of God.
