



### A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

A Word from the Pastor 6-4-23

The bishops of the United States have been encouraging A Eucharistic Revival at all levels of the Church. This movement expresses a desire to help all Catholics to understand better what we celebrate in the Mass, to participate more enthusiastically, to grow in reverence for Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament, and to heal divisions or hurts that may be present in our Church by gathering around the table of the Lord.

The parish phase of this initiative will take place over the next year in all the dioceses of our country. More attention will be given to the various ways that we worship the Lord through the Eucharist. In our parish we will offer some special programs on the Eucharist and encourage active participation as well as try to integrate a Eucharistic theme into our various ministries and organizations.

The kickoff for the parish phase of the Eucharistic Revival across the country will be the weekend of June 10-11, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). It is an appropriate time to begin this revival because this feast invites to focus on the meaning of Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament.

On Sunday June 11, our Family Mass at 9:00 am will conclude with a Eucharistic procession. After Communion, all those who wish are invited to form a procession that will travel across our property, beginning at the church and walking to the covered court of the school. The priest will carry the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance. The choir will sing as we walk. Children (and adults) are invited to bring flowers (with long stems) that they will carry in the procession and place in a vase at the altar. When we arrive at the outdoor altar, we will say some prayers and sing a hymn. We will conclude with **Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.** 

[Note: as the procession passes through the parking lot on the way to the covered court, for a few minutes as a safety precaution, no cars will be permitted to drive through the parking lot.]

Everyone is welcome to join in this Eucharistic procession and honor Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament. The National Eucharistic Revival will conclude with a national Eucharistic Congress to be held in Indianapolis on July 17 -21, 2024. About 80,000 Catholics from across the country are expected to gather for five days of worship, prayer and formation. I pray that as individuals and a community, we may grow in love for the Lord through this coming year. May Jesus, present in the Eucharist, renew us, heal us, and make us more faithful to the mission the Lord has entrusted to us.



### **Celebrating Trinity Sunday**

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is the first Sunday after Pentecost in the Western Christian liturgical calendar, however, in Eastern Christianity there is no specific day set aside to celebrate the Christian doctrine of the Trinity. The Eastern Churches point out that they celebrate the Trinity every Sunday. Westerners do as well, we just set



aside a special feast day for the purpose. In the West, Trinity Sunday, officially called "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than an event or person.

Holy Trinity Sunday is a solemn celebration of our belief in the revelation of one God, yet three divine persons. It was not uniquely celebrated in the early Church, but as with many things the advent of new, sometimes heretical, thinking often gives the Church a moment in which to explain and celebrate its own traditions; things it already believes and holds dear. In the early 4th century when the Arian heresy was spreading, the early Church, recognizing the inherent Christological and Trinitarian implications, prepared an Office of Prayer with canticles, responses, a preface, and hymns, to be recited on Sundays to proclaim the Holy Trinity. Pope John XXII (14th century) instituted the celebration as a feast for the entire Church; the celebration became a solemnity after the liturgical reforms of Vatican II.

Reflection: The Most Holy Trinity (Solemnity)

In the gospel reading, Jesus is speaking to a Pharisee named Nicodemus, who has come to consult Jesus because he accepts Jesus as a great teacher sent by God. Nicodemus has not yet recognized that Jesus is the Son of God, who has come to save all who believe in him. Those who hear Jesus and accept his word will have eternal life. This is the good news for us as well: God so loved us that he gave his only Son, that we who believe in him, may have eternal life. What is your response to Jesus' message? How can you share it with others?

<u>Prayer</u>: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, fill our hearts with your love and guide us to everlasting life.

Liturgy of the Word for Children will be offered during the 9am mass in the summer months. Children ages 5-9 that attend mass with their family will be sent with a catechist to listen to the readings from the Lectionary for Masses with Children. They will return to their family to continue the celebration of the Eucharist with the entire assembly.

### Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity - Year A

### First Reading

Exodus 34:4b-6,8-9

Moses pleads for God's mercy on Mt. Sinai.

### Responsorial Psalm



### **Gospel Reading**

John 3:16-18

God sent his Son into the world to save the world.

### **Background on the Gospel Reading**



Today's Gospel is from the beginning of John's Gospel. The passage we read follows Jesus' conversation with a Pharisee, Nicodemus, about what it means to be born of both water and the spirit. Nicodemus approaches Jesus at night and acknowledges Jesus as a teacher from God. Jesus tells him that only those who are born from above will see the Kingdom of God. Nicodemus misunderstands and questions how a person can be born more than once. Jesus tells Nicodemus that no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. Jesus is essentially explaining Baptism, which we celebrate as a sacrament today. Yet Nicodemus, we are told, still does not understand what Jesus is saying. Jesus continues by testifying to the need to be born from above so that one might have eternal life.

After the dialogue with Nicodemus, the author of the Gospel offers his own explanation of Jesus' words. This is what we read in today's Gospel, John 3:16-18.

In the context of today's focus on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, the reading calls our attention to the action of God, who reveals himself in three persons: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God the Father, out of love for the world, sent his Son into the world in order to save it. Through the death and resurrection of the Son, we have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit. As three persons, God acts always as a God of love; he does not condemn the world but acts to save it.

The Gospel also calls attention to the response that is required of us. God's love for us calls us to respond in faith by professing our belief in God's son, Jesus, and the salvation that he has won for us. This profession of faith is a sign of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
