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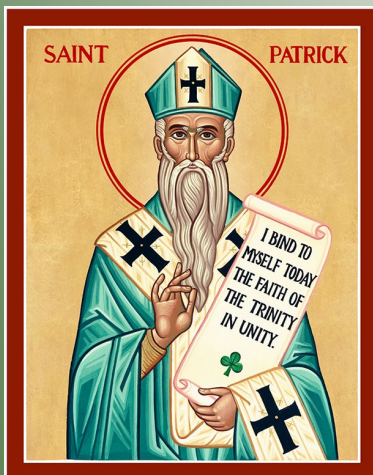

PASTOR'S NOTES -

Fr. George G. Perez CJM - Pastor
XVI Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Sunday's readings focus on one of the most challenging aspects of faith: trusting in God's patience. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the wheat and the weeds. A farmer sows good seed in his field, but during the night an enemy plants weeds among the wheat. When the servants discover the problem, they immediately want to pull the weeds out. Surprisingly, the master tells them to wait lest they uproot the wheat as well. Both are to grow together until the harvest.

We often sympathize with the servants. We want quick solutions to problems, immediate justice, and clear distinctions between good and evil. We look at the world, the Church, our families, and even ourselves, and we wonder why God allows sin, suffering, and imperfection to remain. Why doesn't He act more swiftly? Why does He seem to wait?

The first reading from the Book of Wisdom offers an answer. God's power is revealed not only through His strength but also through His mercy. Because He is truly all-powerful, He can afford to be patient. He governs with clemency and gives people the opportunity to repent and change. His justice is never separated from His compassion.

The parable reminds us that God sees more deeply than we do. Human beings are often quick to judge. We label people, define them by their mistakes, and sometimes write them off entirely. Yet God sees possibilities for growth and conversion that we cannot see. The weed of today may become tomorrow's saint through the grace of God. St. Augustine, once far from the faith, became one of the Church's greatest teachers because God's patience gave him time to respond to grace.

The Gospel also invites us to look inward. The field is not only the world around us but also our own hearts. Within each of us there is both wheat and weeds—virtues and weaknesses, faith and doubt, generosity and selfishness. God does not abandon us because of our imperfections. Instead, He patiently works within us, nurturing what is good while calling us to ongoing conversion.

St. Paul's words in Romans offer further comfort. He reminds us that even when we do not know how to pray, the Holy Spirit comes to our aid and intercedes for us. We are never left alone in our struggle to grow in holiness.

As we gather for Eucharist this Sunday, let us thank God for His patience and mercy. May we learn to trust His timing, extend the same patience to others, and allow His grace to transform the wheat growing within our hearts. In the fullness of time, God will bring His harvest to completion, and His goodness will prevail.

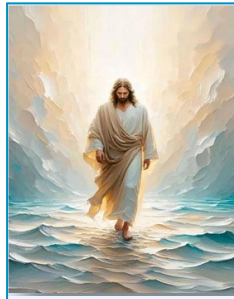
NOTAS DEL PÁRROCO –
P. George G. Pérez, CJM - Párroco -
XVI Domingo Ordinario

Las lecturas de este domingo nos invitan a reflexionar sobre una de las virtudes más difíciles de practicar: la paciencia. En el Evangelio, Jesús nos presenta la parábola del trigo y la cizaña. Un hombre siembra buena semilla en su campo, pero durante la noche un enemigo siembra cizaña entre el trigo. Cuando los siervos descubren el problema, quieren arrancar inmediatamente la mala hierba. Sin embargo, el dueño les pide que esperen hasta la cosecha para evitar dañar también el trigo.

Muchas veces pensamos como aquellos siervos. Queremos soluciones rápidas, justicia inmediata y una clara separación entre el bien y el mal. Miramos el mundo y nos preguntamos por qué Dios permite tanta maldad, sufrimiento e injusticia. También observamos nuestras familias, nuestras comunidades e incluso nuestras propias vidas, y nos preguntamos por qué Dios no actúa más rápido para corregir lo que está mal. La primera lectura, tomada del Libro de la Sabiduría, nos ofrece una respuesta profunda. Dios es todopoderoso, pero su poder se manifiesta especialmente en su misericordia. Precisamente porque es Señor de todo, puede ejercer paciencia y clemencia con sus hijos. Dios no desea la destrucción del pecador, sino su conversión. Él concede tiempo para el arrepentimiento y la transformación del corazón.

La parábola también nos recuerda que Dios ve mucho más allá de lo que nosotros vemos. Con frecuencia juzgamos a las personas por sus errores, fracasos o pecados, y llegamos a pensar que nunca cambiarán. Pero Dios mira el corazón y reconoce posibilidades de crecimiento que nosotros no podemos percibir. La historia de la Iglesia está llena de hombres y mujeres que parecían estar lejos de Dios y, gracias a la paciencia divina, llegaron a convertirse en grandes santos. Además, el campo del Evangelio no representa únicamente al mundo; también simboliza nuestro propio corazón. En cada uno de nosotros hay trigo y cizaña. Existen virtudes que Dios ha sembrado en nuestra alma, pero también debilidades, pecados y heridas que necesitan sanación. Dios no se cansa de nosotros ni nos abandona por nuestras imperfecciones. Con amor y paciencia continúa trabajando en nuestra vida para que el bien crezca y dé fruto abundante.

San Pablo, en la segunda lectura, nos ofrece una palabra de consuelo. Nos recuerda que el Espíritu Santo viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad y que incluso cuando no sabemos cómo orar, Él intercede por nosotros según la voluntad de Dios. Nunca estamos solos en nuestra lucha por vivir el Evangelio. Al participar en la Eucaristía este domingo, agradezcamos a Dios su infinita paciencia con nosotros. Pidámosle la gracia de confiar en sus tiempos, de ser misericordiosos con los demás y de permitir que su amor transforme nuestro corazón. Que aprendamos a reconocer la obra silenciosa de Dios en nuestra vida, sabiendo que, al final de la cosecha, su justicia y su misericordia triunfarán plenamente.

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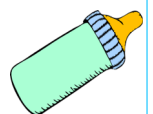
Baby Bottle Drive At St. Patrick Church

For parents: Where do you need the guidance of the Holy Spirit this week?

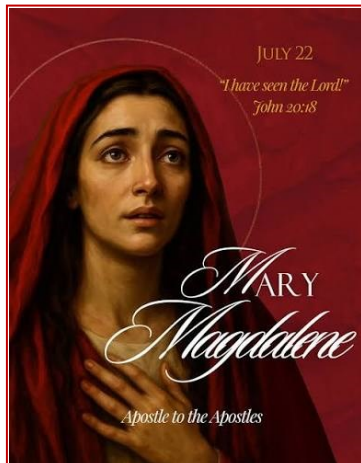
For children: Ask the Holy Spirit for help when you have to do something that is difficult.

The Feast of Saint Mary Magdalene is celebrated annually on July 22. Honored as the "Apostle to the Apostles", she is widely recognized as the first person to witness and proclaim the Resurrection. She is the patron saint of converts, repentant sinners, pharmacists, tanners, and contemplatives.

In June 2016, Pope Francis elevated the memorial of

Mary Magdalene to a full Feast on the Roman Catholic liturgical calendar. This change placed her feast on the same liturgical level as the celebrations for the apostles, highlighting her dignity and role in the early Church.

According to the Gospels, she stayed by the cross during the Crucifixion and was the first to see the risen Christ in the garden on Easter morning.

While earlier Western traditions sometimes conflated her with the "penitent sinner" or Mary of Bethany, modern biblical scholars note there is no scriptural basis for this connection. She is specifically described in Luke 8 as a devoted disciple from whom Jesus cast out seven demons, and who used her own resources to support Jesus' ministry.

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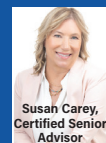
