



## A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Each year the Church observes **October as Respect Life Month** and, specifically, the first Sunday of the month as **Respect Life Sunday**. It is an opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate the Church's teaching that **all human life is sacred from conception to natural death**. This includes every stage and situation of the life of human throughout the life cycle.

As Cardinal McElroy has stated: "It is this commitment to the sacredness of human life that lies at the heart of the Church's call to protect unborn children, to feed the hungry and provide decent housing, to oppose the death penalty and protect the elderly and the disabled from being discarded or terminated in our society."

Many of the issues that fall under the heading of "respect for life" have political implications. I dare say, that virtually any issue today is painted with political brushstrokes. Some will ask, why is the Church involving itself in political issues?

The US Bishops have clearly taught that we each need to exercise our political responsibility, particularly through participation in the voting process. Political participation is an important part of the virtue of justice.

Likewise, the bishops tell us that we need to vote based on our conscience. However, one's conscience needs to be well-formed based on the moral teachings of the Church. Conscience is more than my opinion. Conscience is deeply rooted in the message of Scripture and the moral teachings of the Church.

While the Catholic Church will never endorse nor condemn particular candidates for political office, it does have a responsibility to teach courageously and prophetically the social teachings as they relate to the issues of the day. The Church plays an important role in society by applying Catholic morality to the evolving political landscape. Nearly every political issue of our day has a moral content. It is important for every Catholic to educate oneself to the teachings of the Church on the various issues that present themselves in an election cycle. There are many propositions placed before the voters of California. I encourage you to evaluate each one in light of Catholic social teaching.







## WHY THE CHURCH OPPOSES PROPOSITION 1

This year in California, we are called in a very specific way to reject the pathway of making illegal virtually all limitations on abortion.

Proposition 1, which would enshrine in the state constitution the ability to have late-term abortions and abortions for purposes of gender selection, as well as allowing subsidies for abortion for people who do not even live in California, is absolutely incompatible with the Gospel call to protect all human life. And we must witness to that contradiction in our role as citizens.

The very excruciating issue of abortion calls us to balance the challenging problems of women who are pregnant with the lives of unborn children. Proposition 1 simply obliterates the moral reality of the unborn child in striking this balance. As people of faith, we must not accept such a logic.

Instead, we must work within our society to build a comprehensive framework that genuinely protects and builds the dignity and sacredness of human life in its fullness, at every stage and for every person. Only if our state's voters reject Proposition 1 can we meaningfully proceed toward this goal in California. And that must begin with us.




## POR QUÉ LA IGLESIA SE OPONE A LA PROPOSICIÓN 1

Este año en California, somos llamados de una manera muy específica a rechazar el camino que lleve a hacer ilegal casi toda limitación en contra del aborto. La Proposición 1 protegería en la constitución estatal la posibilidad de tener abortos en el tercer trimestre y abortos con el fin de seleccionar el género del bebé, así como también pagar por el aborto por personas que ni siquiera viven en California. Estas acciones absolutamente contradicen el llamado del Evangelio de proteger toda la vida humana. Como ciudadanos no podemos permitir esta contradicción.

El terrible tema del aborto nos llama a poner en la balanza los desafiantes problemas de las mujeres embarazadas y de las vidas de los niños por nacer. La Proposición 1 simplemente elimina la realidad moral del niño no nacido en esta balanza. Como Pueblo de Fe, no debemos aceptar esta lógica.

En cambio, debemos trabajar dentro de nuestra sociedad para construir un marco integral que realmente proteja y construya la dignidad y el carácter sagrado de la vida humana en su plenitud, en todas las etapas y en cada persona. Solamente si nuestros votantes en el estado rechazan la Proposición 1, podremos significativamente avanzar hacia esta meta en California. Y eso debe comenzar con nosotros mismos.
