# Key Findings

- **Most Jews Say The War With Iran Is Likely To Be A Top Topic At Seder**
- **The Majority Of Jews Disapprove Of The War, With Rough A Third Approving, And Some Feeling Torn**
- **A Majority Feel Conducting War Operations Jointly With Israel Could Be Bad Long Term, Raising Concerns About The Jewish Role In US Policy**

# Methodology

- National survey of 800 Jewish voters
- Interviews conducted online March 13-23, 2026
- Margin of error +/- 3.46% overall (higher for subgroups)

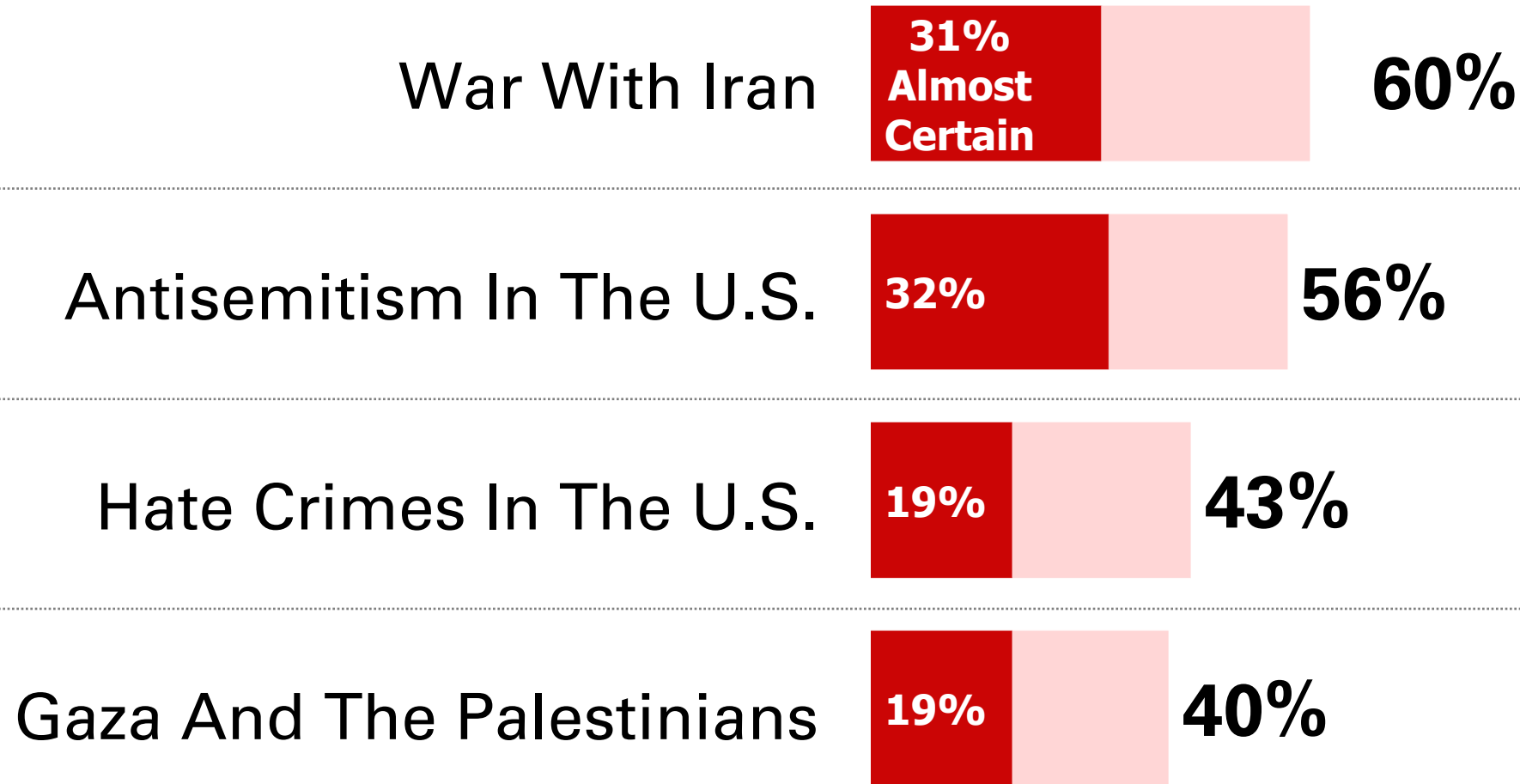


**Most Jews Say The War With Iran Is Likely To Be A Top Topic At Seder, With Antisemitism Being A Close Second**

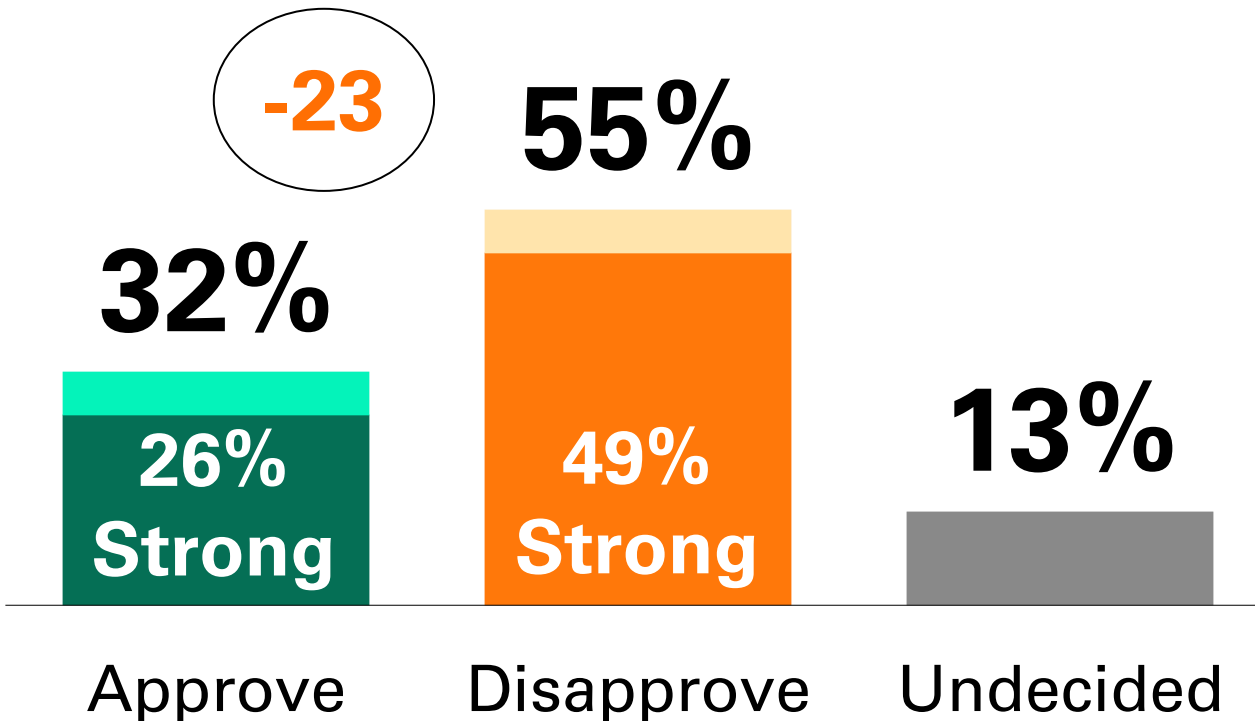

Do you **approve** or **disapprove** of the current U.S. military action against Iran?

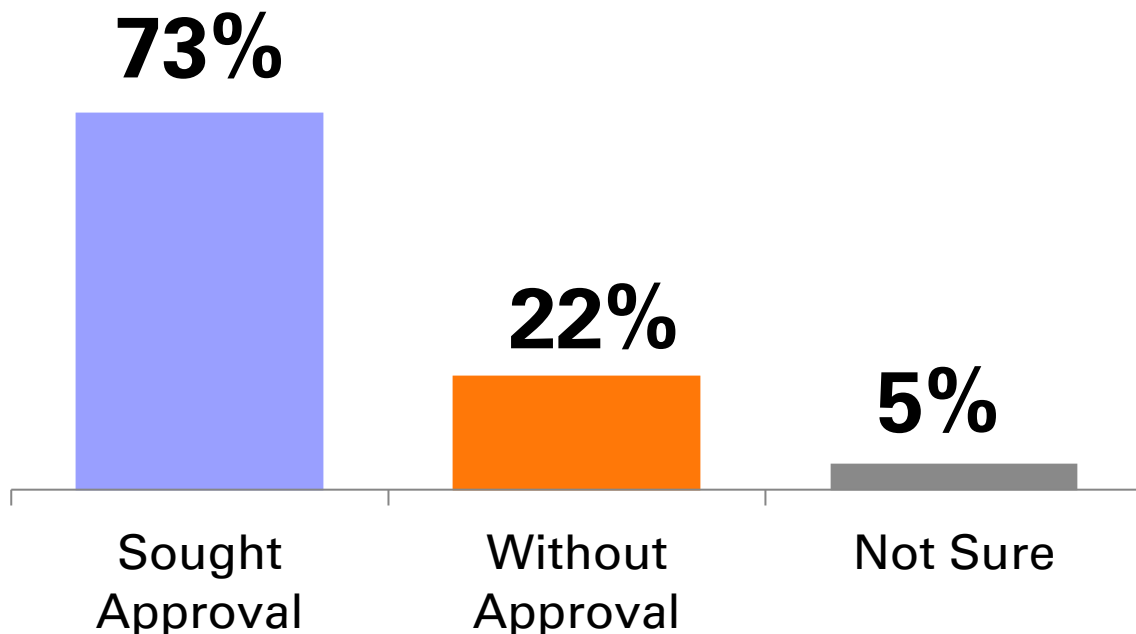

- **Not Sure**

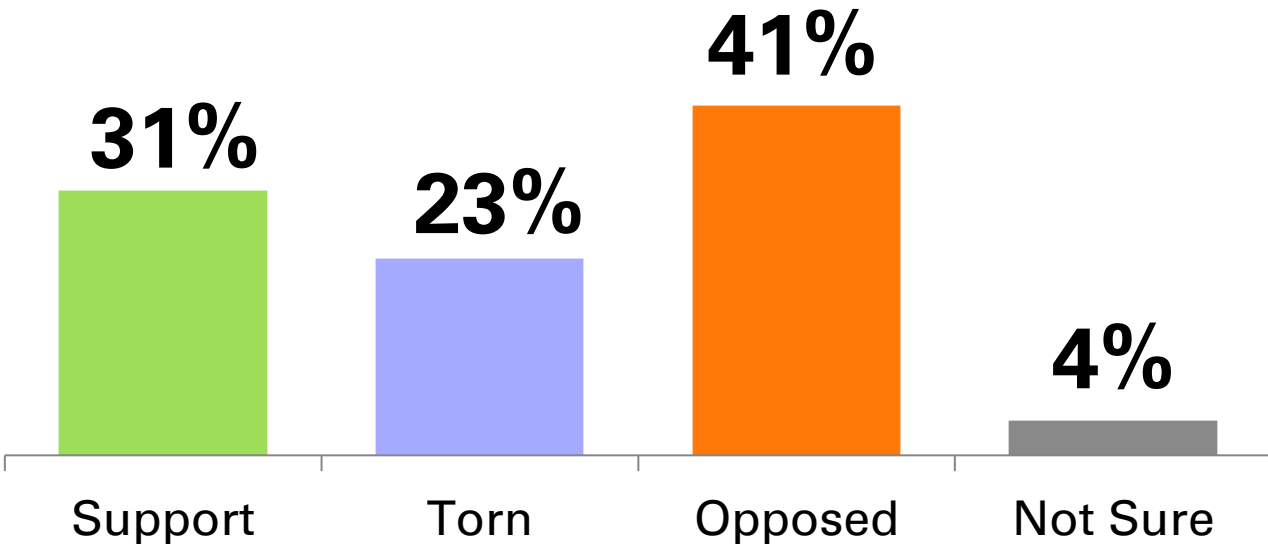

# Nearly A Quarter Are Torn Between The Threat From Iran And Believing This Was Not The Way To Handle It

One In Four Jews Disapproving Of The War Admit To Being Torn

- Which comes closer to your point of view...?
- I **support** it b/c we cannot allow a nuclear equipped Iran
  - I **am torn** b/c while Iran is a threat to peace, this is not the way to handle it
  - I **am opposed** b/c we should not go to war without clear provocation & ...objectives

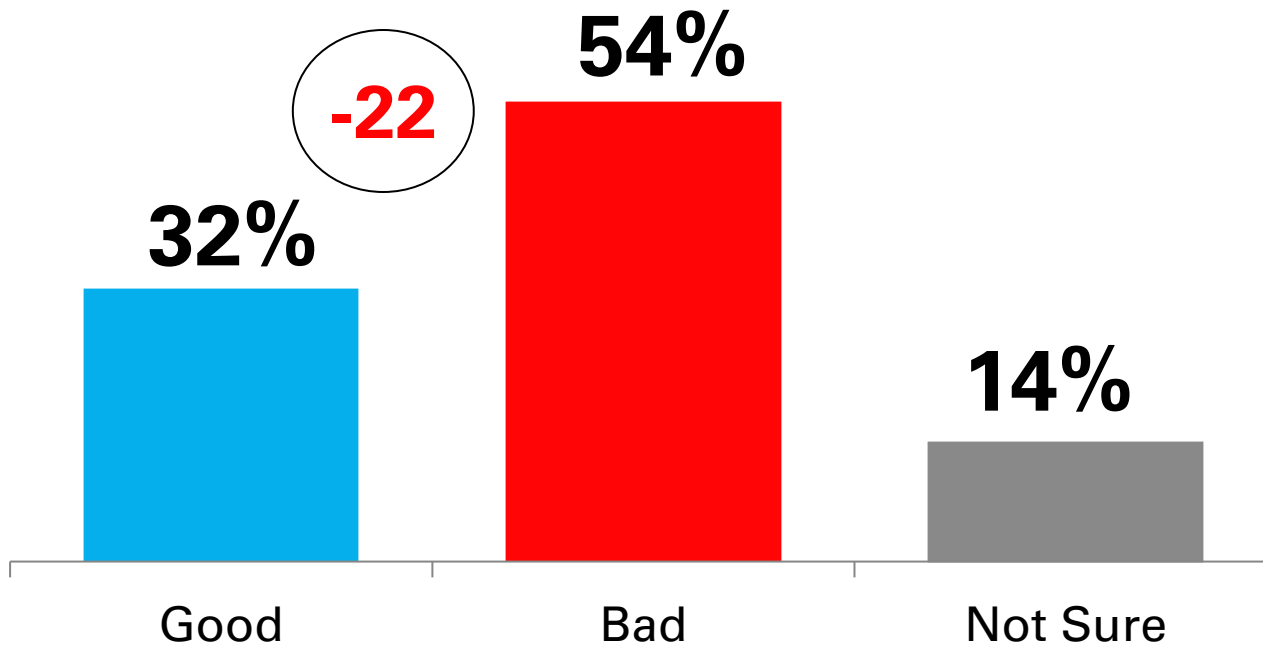
