

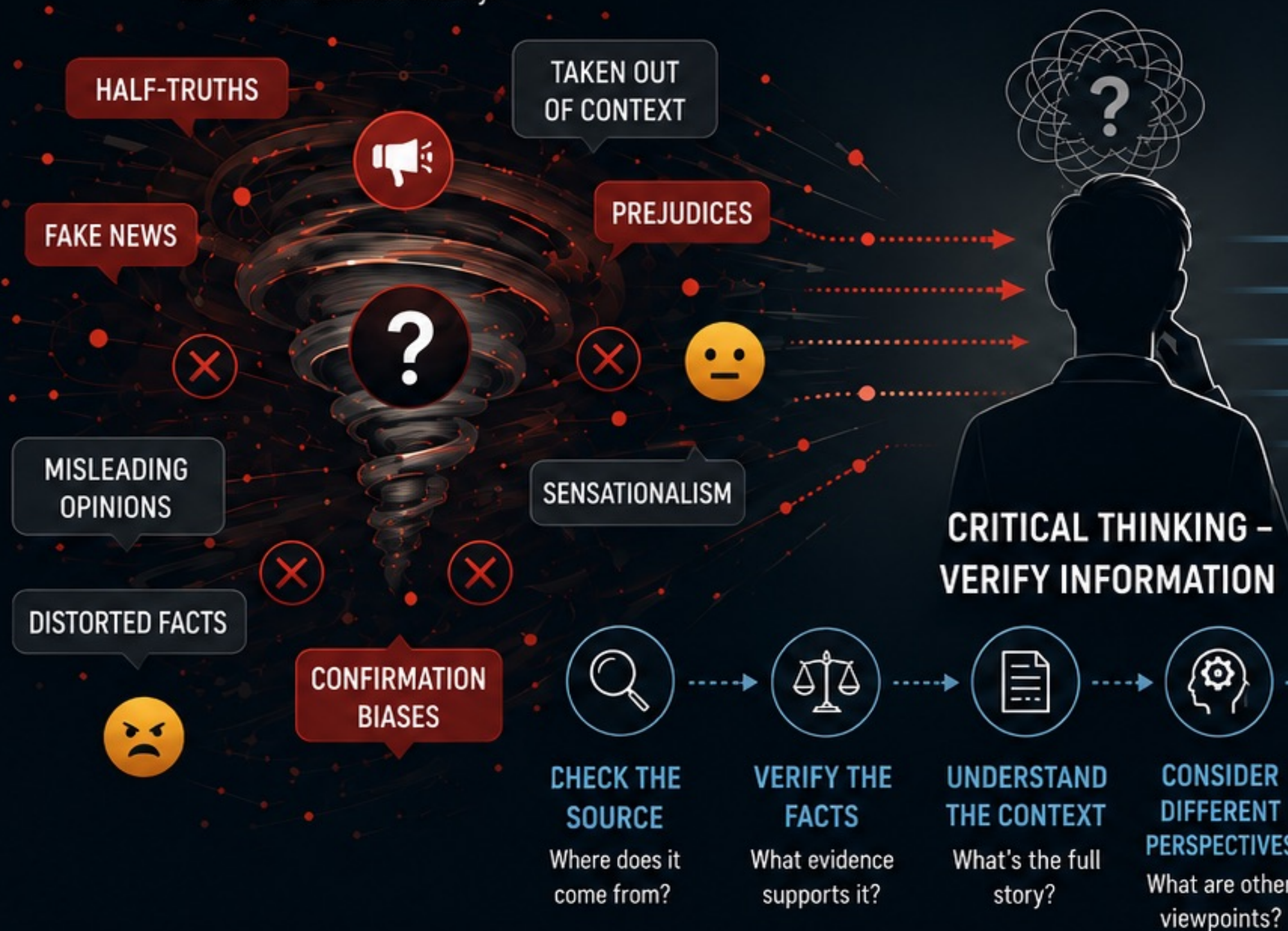
INFORMATION IN THE AGE OF OVERLOAD
