NEW MANDATORY QUESTIONS ON DSPT FOR 2025-26

The NHS Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT) has been refreshed for 2025/26. While this year's update isn't as extensive as last year's major overhaul, it still brings important refinements—especially for Category 3 organisations, such as smaller digital health companies.

The latest edition of the Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT) is now live.



It includes two additional mandatory questions which adult social care providers need to answer in order to reach Standards Met.

If you are completing or updating your DSPT, you will notice that there are now 45, not 43 questions that you must answer.

The new mandatory questions are:

4.3.1 Have all the administrators of your organisation's IT system(s) signed an agreement to hold them accountable to higher standards?

The people within your organisation who are IT system administrators may have access to more information than other staff. Therefore, they need to be held accountable in a formal way to higher standards of confidentiality than others.

7.1.1 You have an asset register detailing your organisation's hardware, software and data, which is kept up to date.

This is a list of the devices and computer software your organisation uses which has been reviewed in the last twelve months.

There are also some minor changes to the wording of other questions.

DSPT or Data Security and Protect Toolkit is an annual online self-assessment of your organisations data and cyber security arrangements.


It demonstrates compliance with 10 data security standards and the Data Protection Law but completing your DSPT does a lot more than that.

FLU AND COVID-19 SEASONAL VACCINATIONS

We are urging eligible residents to take up the offer of vaccinations as soon as they're able to ensure protection ahead of the peak winter virus season.

The flu vaccine is now being offered to children aged 2 to 3 years, all school-aged children from Reception to Year 11, and children with certain long-term health conditions.



Vaccinations for children will take place at their GP practice, in school, or at a local community clinic.

Pregnant women will be offered the flu vaccine at maternity appointments but can also choose to book at their GP practice or local pharmacy.

<u>The NHS National Booking System</u> is now open for all other eligible individuals to book their winter flu and Covid-19 vaccinations, with appointments starting from Wednesday 1 October.

This year, Covid-19 vaccinations are available to adults aged 75 and over, older adult care home residents, and people who are immunosuppressed.
