Admissions Policy

This event is organised by the ICDA Awards LTD and other parties, hereinafter referred to as the organisers.

By purchasing or attempting to purchase a ticket for this event it will be presumed for you to have agreed to this documented Conditions of Entry. Entry is by ticket, E ticket or as a guest of the organisers.

Anyone obtaining a visitor or exhibitor badge by theft, deception or other illegal means may be asked to leave the event.

You agree to abide by any lawful instruction given to you by the organisers, their staff or their agents acting on their behalf.

Young unaccompanied, under 16-year-olds MAY at the discretion of the organisers be refused admission.

Searching is a condition of entry to the event, to protect your safety and that of our other visitors and our staff. We may conduct searches of clothing, bags and other items determined by us using our reasonable discretion.

No one will be admitted to the event who appears to be under the influence of alcohol and or drugs.

Admission may be refused, or you may be asked to leave the event if you are found to be in possession of any illegal or contraband goods. You may also be liable to prosecution.
