92 “yes” votes by Allen, Edwards, Green, Falwell, Mansko and Lake.

94 **ORDINANCE: PERMITTING DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS FOR A PERIOD**
95 **BEGINNING JUNE 21 AND EXPIRING JULY 5 OF EACH YEAR**

97 City Attorney Pettie read the first reading of the Ordinance permitting the discharge of fireworks for a
98 period beginning June 21 and expiring July 5 of each year in its entirety. After discussion, it was
99 requested a cutoff of 11 p.m. each night and add any burn bans by the City of Newport. City
100 Attorney Pettie will add these items for the second reading.
