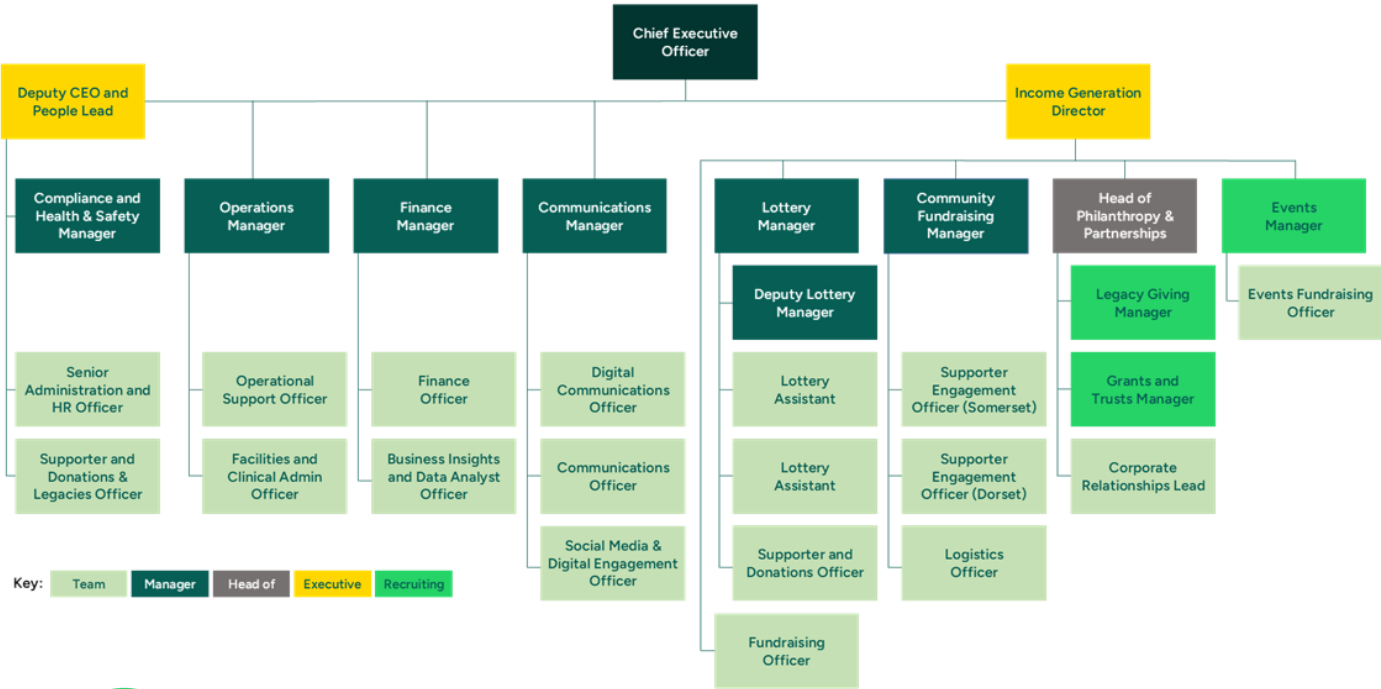
Our Expert Team and Services

The Role

We are seeking a dynamic and experienced Mass Participation Events Manager to lead, develop, and deliver a new portfolio of mass participation fundraising events. You will play a pivotal role in shaping our events strategy, driving supporter engagement, and maximising income to support our life-saving work.

- Collaborative and supportive team player, able to work effectively with colleagues across the organisation.
