



Dress Code Policy for 4K – 5th Grade (2026-2027)

St. Peter Catholic School believes that the students' clothing attire does influence and reflect school behavior and learning. The students should wear clothing attire that is neat, clean and modest for the school setting.

3K DRESS CODE POLICY: The 3K students must dress in neat, clean and modest clothing, and attire that are practical and appropriate in the classroom. Shorts are allowed during the months May through September. Socks must be worn with shoes with backs on them. Light up or wheeling shoes are not permitted in school.

TOPS

- Solid Colors: Red, White, Navy Blue or Black
- Short or Long Sleeved and Polo or Oxford collared shirts. Shirts must be tucked in on Mass Days.
- Sweaters, sweater vest, cardigans, or pullover sweatshirts without hoods may be worn over dress code shirts.
- Only St. Peter Catholic School logos are allowed.

BOTTOMS

- Solid Colors: Khaki, Gray, Navy Blue or Black
- All pants or slacks need to be worn at the waist. No jeans, athletic pants or sweatpants are allowed.
- Girls may wear skirts, skorts, dresses or jumpers with leggings, yoga pants or tights underneath them. Leggings or tights must be worn between October 1 – April 30. Leggings, yoga pants or tights may not be worn as pants. Skirts, skorts, dresses or jumpers must be worn no more than four inches above knee.
- Shorts are allowed between May 1 – September 30. Must be worn no more than four inches above knee. Shorts are not permitted on Mass Days.

FOOTWEAR

- All shoes must have a secure backing. Students may wear athletic shoes or non-athletic shoes
- Socks must be worn with footwear.
- Athletic shoes will still be needed for Physical Education classes.
- Sandals must have a secure backing. Heels should be no higher than 1 inch. Allowed May 1 – September 30. (Socks with sandals are optional) Light up or wheeling shoes are not allowed.

GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Clothing should be modest and not show undergarments, lower back, midriff, etc.
- No unnatural hair colors (i.e. red, purple, green, blue, pink, etc.).
- Make up is not allowed.
- Necklaces, bracelets, earrings, and rings may not present a safety hazard or be inappropriate.
- Outerwear jackets or coats are not to be worn during class times.

Incidents

First Occurrence

Homeroom teacher will address with student individually and notify parents. The homeroom teacher will inform the principal. Change of clothing from the school office. Clothing must be washed and returned to the office.

Second Occurrence

Principal will call or email parents. Change of clothing from the school office. Clothing must be washed and returned to the office.

Third Occurrence

Principal will call parents and student will have a 30-minute detention afterschool from 2:30 – 3:00 pm. Change of clothing from the school office. Clothing must be washed and returned to the office.

Continued occurrences and consequences will be determined by the principal.
