

Get SET Programs: Providing Foundational Support for the Skilled Trades

Elgin, Oxford and Middlesex Counties

Get SET (Skills, Education and Training) programs support people interested in pursuing a career in the skilled trades - including signed apprentices - by offering free:

- Assessments to identify skills strengths and gaps
 - Individualized learning plans
 - Upgrading customized to the skilled trades
 - Skill building for in-school apprenticeship training and exams like the Certificate of Qualification (C of Q) or Red Seal exam
 - Upgrading focused on:
 - interpreting documents (ex. manuals and work plans)
 - professional writing (ex. emailing customers and vendors)
 - math (ex. imperial-metric conversion, area and perimeter, angles, fractions and decimals)
 - people skills (ex. verbal communication and teamwork)
 - computers and technology (ex. the use of email, documents, and spreadsheets, online safety and security)
 - study skills (reviewing content, note-taking, and interpreting multiple choice tests)
 - Support for earning credentials required to sign an apprenticeship contract, including:
 - specific high school credits (ex. science, physics, and math)
 - the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)
 - the Canadian Adult Education Credential (CAEC – formerly the GED)
 - the Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) certificate
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Across Ontario, the Get SET system offers in-person and online programming in English, French, Braille and ASL, and customized to reflect Indigenous teaching and learning philosophies.
