



**Q: Will there be opportunities for students to take more French classes after they have completed French 4? I know that Spanish for native language speakers may have been offered in place of AP Spanish. Would that be possible for French as well next school year? We don't want our student to lose this language skill.**

A: We are open to offering a conversational French class next year. We also hope to offer AP French again as soon as there are enough students with the interest and qualifications to take the class. In both cases it will require having enough students request the class to allow us to offer it.

**Q: Will there be any policy on consistent and frequent uploading of grades in Plus Portal?**

The school requires teachers to post grades for ordinary assignments within 3 school days of when they are due. For assignments that take longer to grade (e.g., essays, projects, etc.) teachers should post grades within 5 school days of the due date.

**Q: What is the structure for Academic Enrichment and are there things that teachers are giving students to work on during that time or is it just break time?**

Academic Enrichment is a 21-minute time for students to do the following: work quietly on their homework to get a leg up and have less at night, Complete IXL assignment, silent reading, log into PathwayEd and engage in the tutoring module or the SAT prep program. It should be time used productively.

There may have been some chatting during AE time during the first few days of school as students did not have much homework at that time. Now that we have been in school a few weeks, students should always have something productive to do.
