Prom Information

The attire for Prom should be formal. Gentlemen should wear either a tuxedo or a dress suit (dress coat/pants, shirt, tie, & dress shoes). Ladies should be dressed formally, either in long or short dresses. These dresses should be **APPROPRIATE** for the occasion. Plunging necklines and super short dresses are not permitted. If any student is not dressed appropriately, he/she will be asked to change/cover up and if he/she refuses...then he/she will not be admitted to the Prom and a parent/guardian will be called to pick up their child. There will be no refund if admission is denied due to attire. **Parents, please assist us in our endeavor to present all of our Panthers as true ladies and gentlemen.**

- The cost of the Prom Ticket includes finger foods and desserts, mocktails, DJ and photobooth, professional photographs, Chicken sandwich “to go” box, and Security Detail (two state troopers to ensure the safety of our students). This year we are also offering an optional party bus transportation opportunity to/from Pallotti.
- Students that are going to be late to the Prom (past 8:30PM) **MUST** call/text to inform the Assistant Principal for Student Affairs, Mrs. Catherine Edwards, at the phone number 301.257.0514.
- Students will not be permitted to leave the dance before 10:30 PM. If you are picking up your child (and their guest), please arrive a few minutes before 11PM. The venue will be closing up shortly after the dance ends.

Ticket Sales

Prom Tickets will go on sale starting Wednesday, April 15th. All tickets will be sold online. Purchasers should visit the Pallotti website at www.pallottihs.org. Click on the “Student Life” tab and you will see a drop down menu. Select the “Prom 2026” option all the way at the bottom. Please complete the information and payment form. You will receive a confirmation email saying that payment has been received.

The attached permission slips must be completed and returned by May 7th at 5pm. Completed forms can either be scanned in and sent to Mrs. Edwards at cedwards@pallottihs.org or faxed to the school at 301.776.4343. Your prom registration will not be complete until both payment and completed forms have been received. Students are more than welcome to check in with Mrs. Edwards to ensure that their registration is complete.

Each Pallotti student is permitted to bring one guest. The guest can be a Pallotti student from another grade level or a non-Pallotti guest. Pallotti students **AND** their guests must have a Permission Slip signed by their parent/guardian. **Non-Pallotti guests must present a photo ID to be admitted to the Prom.**
