The 29th Annual Cheerleading Competition Competition Information

Attention Cheerleading Coaches:

The competition is Monday, August 3 at 6:00 p.m. on the race track in front of the Grandstands. Cheerleaders get in free in uniform, and coach passes will be provided. Grandstand admission is free — bring your supporters! A Spirit Award will go to the school showing the most spirit and sportsmanship throughout the event.

The competition order:

All-Stars Youth, All-Stars Senior, Mini, PeeWee, Junior High, Small Varsity, Large Varsity and Game Day. Winners will be announced after the Gamed Day Division.

*Order may be adjusted closer to the event.

Routine Requirements:

Each routine must include at least one cheer, one chant, and one dance, with a maximum time of 4 minutes. Judging and timing start with the first note of music or first organized word and end when the last squad member steps off the mat. Squads may set pompoms, props, and mats before starting. Tumbling mats will be provided for the competition area. A 40x40 indoor and outdoor carpet will be available as a practice area, but squads must bring their own mats if needed for practice.

Judging:

A panel of 2 or 3 qualified judges will score all areas of the competition, with total scores combined for the final result. In case of a tie in the top 3, tied squads will repeat their performances for review. Judges' decisions are final. Scores will be tabulated by 2 or 3 people to ensure accuracy. Sample judging sheets can be request no more than 1 week prior to the event.

Penalties:

Exceeding the 4-minute time limit results in a 1-point deduction per second from the judges' combined score. No penalties for setting or removing pompoms, props, or mats, or if a squad member steps off the competition floor during the performance.

Awards:

Awards will go to the top two squads in each division, with a spirit award for the squad showing the most spirit and sportsmanship. Each cheerleader will receive a participation button. The awards ceremony follows the competition's conclusion.

Additional Info:

Warm-ups follow the performance order, with each squad getting a maximum of 5 minutes on the mat, followed by open mat time for tumbling. Send a representative with your squad's music to the sound system tent (southeast corner) at least one squad before your performance. Music can be tested during your warm-up.

Per State Safety Regulations, NO MOUNTS are allowed, and mini-tramps, knee drops, slam splits, drop splits, or toe pitches are prohibited. All routines must follow OHSSA and school athletic league safety rules. Penalty points or disqualification may result from safety violations.
