V. Standing Committees

Liturgy Committee: Stan Kulas

- 1. Thanksgiving Mass: 30 loaves of bread will be blessed at the Thanksgiving Day Mass.
- 2. Advent Wreath Candle Lighting: Candles will be lit at every Advent Mass. Team Captains from the Liturgy Committee will recruit parishioners to light the candles. The Grandparent Ministry will have a special role at the 3rd Sunday of Advent (Bambinelli Sunday) Candle Lighting. At both the 9:30am and 11:00am Masses, grandparents, along with their grandchildren, will be asked to light the candles. Also, all young parisinoners will be invited to bring Baby Jesus figurines (Bambinellis) to both of these Masses, to have them blessed by Father Daly.
- 3. <u>Distribution of Candy Canes:</u> All Mass on December 10th and 11th. Wrapped gold coins will be distributed on New Year's Day Masses.
- 4. Do You Believe Series: 20 people participated in this series.
- 5. Soup for the Souls: Will be held this Lent.
- 6. <u>Bible Study</u>: The latest study session is ending November 15th. The average attendance was 16 people.
- 7. <u>Adoration Chapel:</u> A dinner was held on October 14th at St. Joseph Church Hall, for adorers, and for those interested in learning more about adoration and the chapel. 64 people attended, incluidng 34 prospective adorers. 3-4 people have already signed up to be adorers. The Adoratoin Chapel is closed the week of November 9th, for repairs.

Faith Formation: Cyndie Glick-Coordinator

- 1. Additional families did register for Faith Formation classes.
