

Personal Appearance at the Consulate.

What does Personal Appearance mean? Some Consulates require a Traveler to appear in person at the consulate to apply for their visa (whether be Visitor Visa or Business Visa). This may be done just to verify Traveler identity or conduct a formal interview. In these cases, Traveler must submit their visa application directly to the consulate.

Austria, Bulgaria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and Switzerland.
