Provides grants to low-income households to make their homes more energy-efficient. Energy costs are reduced and homeowners gain more financial independence. To qualify for any of the energy-related grants for home improvements, the household is required to be at the poverty line or 200% below. Priority is given to seniors, families with children, and disabled members of the household who need the home to be handicap accessible.
