DEAR FRIENDS LETTER

DEAR FRIENDS,

LAST YEAR, I WAS WELCOMED TO SERVE AS THE LIAISON TO WORSHIP ON THE VESTRY AT ST. MARK'S. I HAD NO IDEA WHAT THAT MEANT BUT WENT INTO THE ROLE WITH A FULL HEART, AN OPEN MIND, AND AN APPETITE TO LEARN EVERYTHING I COULD! THE PEOPLE WHO BRING THEIR GIFTS AND WORK TO MAKE OUR WORSHIP SERVICES SACRED, REVERENT AND BEAUTIFUL ARE ONLY SOME OF THE MANY WONDERFUL AND GIFTED PEOPLE WHO MAKE ST. MARK'S THE CHURCH HOME AND FAMILY IT HAS BECOME TO ME AND MY WIFE, NANCY. I'M PRIVILEGED AND HUMBLLED TO SERVE WITH SO MANY COMMITTED AND LOVING PEOPLE WHO CONTINUE TO SHARE THEIR KNOWLEDGE, EXPERIENCE AND COMMUNITY WITH US.

I WAS CONFIRMED IN 1963 AT ST. MARK'S LUTHERAN CHURCH IN CHARLOTTE, NC, AND SPENT MY YOUTH IN CHARLOTTE WITH MY 6 YOUNGER BROTHERS AND SISTER. AS AN ADULT, GOD PLANTED A THIRST IN ME FOR FINDING A CHURCH THAT WELCOMED ALL HIS PEOPLE TO ACCEPT HIS UNCONDITIONAL LOVE AND GRACE. FOR ME, THAT WAS THE EPISCOPAL FAITH, WHERE THE LITURGY AND GIFTS OF THE EUCHARIST BROUGHT UNPARALLELED PEACE AND AWE.

GOD BROUGHT NANCY AND ME TOGETHER IN 1991, HELPED US RAISE OUR CHILDREN AND SEE THEM INTO ADULTHOOD, BLESSING US WITH 5 GRANDCHILDREN TO LOVE. FAMILY HAS ALWAYS BEEN IMPORTANT TO US. I'VE OFTEN FELT GOD WAS GUIDING NANCY AND ME IN OUR LIFE TOGETHER ALONG THE PATH HE CHOSE FOR US. FAMILY, FRIENDS, ACQUAINTANCES, EVEN STRANGERS AND OUR EXPERIENCES WITH THEM ALL LED US DEEPER INTO OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE.

WHEN NANCY AND I DECIDED TO MOVE TO DALTON IN 2022, IT WAS MY BROTHER STEVE WHO, WHEN I SHARED WITH HIM I WAS LOOKING FOR A CHURCH HOME, QUOTED TO ME FROM PSALMS 51:10, "CREATE IN ME A CLEAN HEART, O GOD, AND RENEW A RIGHT SPIRIT WITHIN ME. CAST ME NOT AWAY FROM YOUR PRESENCE AND TAKE NOT YOUR HOLY SPIRIT FROM ME." VERY SOON AFTERWARD, WE FOUND ST. MARK'S AND KNEW IMMEDIATELY IT WAS WHERE WE WERE MEANT TO BE. GOD IS EVERYWHERE AND WE FOUND HIM IN THE PEOPLE OF ST. MARK'S, MAKING CONNECTIONS THAT VERY QUICKLY BEGAN TO FEEL AS THOUGH THEY WERE DECADES IN THE MAKING INSTEAD OF JUST A FEW SHORT YEARS. WE WERE CONNECTED AND AT HOME WITH THOSE WE FOUND AT ST. MARK'S. IT WAS ONLY A YEAR OR SO LATER IN 2025 THAT NANCY WAS CONFIRMED AND I WAS RECEIVED INTO ST. MARK'S BY BISHOP WRIGHT.

AND OUR CONNECTIONS IN FAITH EXPONENTIALLY INCREASE, AS GOD CONTINUES TO OPEN OUR HEARTS, MINDS AND SOULS TO HIS LOVE AND GRACE THAT IS EXPRESSED BY YOU ALL, DEAR FRIENDS. BEING INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL LENTEN SERIES, A PART OF THE FAITHFUL INNOVATIONS TEAM AND LATER COHI, WEEKLY BIBLE STUDY AND SUNDAY SCHOOL, EVENING PRAYER, SERVING ON THE FLOWER GUILD AND AS NEW ACOLYTES AND EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS, PARTICIPATING IN THE ROYAL OAKS MINISTRY, AND SO MUCH MORE CONTINUES TO CONNECT US WITH EACH OTHER, OUR FRIENDS, OUR COMMUNITY AND GOD. THROUGH OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH ALL OF YOU WE GROW IN OUR SPIRITUAL LIFE. WE ARE AT HOME AND SO VERY BLESSED TO BE A PART OF ST. MARK'S JOURNEY BESIDE SUCH WONDERFUL PEOPLE WHO OPENED THEIR HEARTS TO US FROM THE VERY BEGINNING AND CONTINUE TO STRENGTHEN US AS WE PRAY FOR GOD'S CALL IN OUR HEARTS TO FOLLOW HIS PATH. SAINT OF THE WEEK: MARY MAGDALENE, FIRST WITNESS TO THE RESURRECTION

JULY 22 IS THE DAY TO HONOR TO HONOR MARY MAGDALENE, ONE OF THE MOST CONTROVERSIAL AND MYSTERIOUS PEOPLE WHO KNEW JESUS PERSONALLY. BECAUSE MARY IS A COMMON NAME AND TRANSLATIONS VARY, THERE IS A LOT OF CONFUSION ABOUT THIS WOMAN. WHAT DO THE SCRIPTURES TELL US? MARY WAS FROM THE GALILEAN TOWN OF MAGDALA, A FISHING TOWN ON THE SEA OF GALILEE ABOUT ONE HUNDRED MILES NORTH OF JERUSALEM. LUKE 8:13 MENTIONS HER AS A FOLLOWER OF JESUS. MANY WOMEN, MOST OF WHOM WERE PROBABLY WEALTHY, ACCOMPANIED JESUS ON HIS TRAVELS. LUKE SAYS THAT SEVEN DEMONS WERE CAST OUT OF HER BY JESUS. DURING THE TIME OF JESUS, THE DEMONS THAT WERE CAST WERE USUALLY A TYPE OF MENTAL ILLNESS. LATER CHRISTIANS BELIEVED THAT THESE DEMONS WERE THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS AND STRENGTHENED THE CASE THAT MARY WAS A PROSTITUTE. IN 591 POPE GREGORY THE GREAT STATED THAT MARY MAGDALENE WAS THE "UNNAMED SINNER AND PROSTITUTE". (THE SECOND VATICAN COUNCIL REMOVED THE PROSTITUTE LABEL IN 1969.) ALL FOUR GOSPELS REPORT THAT MARY MAGDALENE WAS THE FIRST TO WITNESS JESUS AFTER THE RESURRECTION. MARY MAGDALENE IS MENTIONED IN THE GOSPEL OF THOMAS, GOSPEL OF PHILLIP, AND THE GOSPEL OF MARY WHICH DID NOT MAKE IT INTO THE NEW TESTAMENT. WHAT MARY DID AND WHERE SHE WENT AFTER SHE LEFT THE APOSTLES IS NOT KNOWN FOR SURE. IN THE EASTERN TRADITION MARY IS BELIEVED TO HAVE LEFT JERUSALEM WITH MARY, JESUS' MOTHER, AND GONE TO EPHESUS IN MODERN DAY TURKEY. WESTERN CATHOLICS BELIEVE SHE FLED TO FRANCE AND LIVED IN A CAVE FOR THIRTY YEARS BEFORE SHE DIED IN THE SOUTHEAST OF FRANCE. A REALLY EXTREME VIEW, MADE POPULAR BY DAN BROWN'S DIVINCI CODE, SAYS MARY FLED TO FRANCE PREGNANT WITH JESUS' CHILD AND FOUNDED THE MEROVINGIAN LINE OF KINGS. THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO EVIDENCE FOR THIS MYTH. MARY MAGDALENE IS OFTEN PORTRAYED AS WEEPING AS SHE DID AT THE TOMB OF JESUS. FROM THIS WE GET THE ENGLISH WORD "MAULDIN" MEANING TEARFULLY SENTIMENTAL. THERE IS A MAGDALEN COLLEGE AT OXFORD AND A MAGDALENE COLLEGE AT CAMBRIDGE, BOTH PRONOUNCED "MAULDIN".

NATURE NOTE: RACCOON — NATURE'S LITTLE BANDIT

FOR THE PAST WEEK OR SO I HAVE HAD A YOUNG RACCOON VISITING MY FRONT BIRD FEEDER. HE OR SHE ARRIVES JUST BEFORE DARK AND EATS SUNFLOWER SEEDS FROM THE FEEDER OR ON THE GROUND REALLY ENJOYS THE SUET ON TOP OF THE FEEDER. THE BIRDBATH SOMETIMES GETS TIPPED OVER. I LIKE RACCOONS FROM A DISTANCE. I SAW A LOT OF THEM WHEN I WORKED FOR THE TENNESSEE STATE PARKS, ESPECIALLY IN THE PICNIC AREAS AFTER DARK WHERE THEY RAIDED GARBAGE CANS. THE RACCOON IS FOUND IN ALL LOWER 48 STATES. THE WORD RACCOON COMES FROM THE NATIVE POWHATAN WORD THAT MEANS "ONE WHO RUBS, SCRUBS AND SCRATCHES WITH ITS HANDS". ONE OF THE UNIQUE FEATURES OF THE RACCOON IS THE DEXTERITY OF THEIR FRONT PAWS. A RACCOON CAN UNDO ALL SORTS OF LATCHES, WHICH MAKES IT HARD TO KEEP THEM OUT OF GARBAGE CANS. WHEN THEIR PAWS ARE WET, THEY HAVE EVEN GREATER SENSITIVITY, WHICH IS WHY THEY WET DOWN THEIR FOOD. (THE OLD IDEA THAT A RACCOON WASHES ITS FOOD BECAUSE IT DOESN'T HAVE ENOUGH SALIVA IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED BY SCIENTISTS.) ANOTHER DISTINGUISHING FEATURE OF THE RACCOON IS THE BLACK MASK AROUND THE EYES, WHICH THEY HAVE FROM BIRTH. THE MASK REDUCES REFLECTION AND HELPS THEM SEE BETTER AT NIGHT, IN THE SAME WAY THAT FOOTBALL PLAYERS AND SOLDIERS PUT BLACK PAINT UNDER THEIR EYES. RACCOONS USUALLY WEIGH 10 TO 30 POUNDS, BUT CAN WEIGH AS MUCH AS 60 POUNDS. THEY ARE NOCTURNAL AND ARE TRUE OMNIVORES, EATING A VARIETY OF INVERTEBRATES, SMALL AQUATIC ANIMALS, AND FRUITS AND VEGETABLES. THEY ALSO LIKE HUMAN FOOD SCRAPS AND PET FOOD, WHICH BRINGS THEM INTO CONFLICT WITH PEOPLE. RACCOONS HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO ENTER HOUSES THROUGH PET DOORS. BESIDES THE FOOD PROBLEM, RACCOONS CAN CAUSE EXTENSIVE DAMAGE TO HOMES IF THEY DEN IN CHIMNEYS AND ATTICS. IT IS BEST TO DISCOURAGE RACCOONS FROM HANGING AROUND YOUR HOUSE. A RACCOON CAN KILL A DOG IN A FIGHT, AS COON HUNTERS KNOW ALL TOO WELL. RACCOONS ALSO ARE A MAJOR CARRIER OF RABIES AND IN SOME AREAS, ORAL RABIES VACCINE IS DROPPED INTO RACCOON HABITAT. AS CUTE AS THEY ARE, A RACCOON DOES NOT MAKE A GOOD PET AFTER THEY REACH PUBERTY SO ENJOY OCCASIONAL SIGHTINGS OF THE LITTLE BANDIT IN NATURE.
