**Reading:** Exodus 25:1-40:38

**Big Idea:** *God gives instructions for the tabernacle and the priests. As sinners we cannot approach God unless we have a sacrifice or mediator on our behalf.*

**Memory Verse:** *Commandments 8, 9, & 10 - Exodus 20:15-17*

8. *You shall not steal*

9. *You shall not bear false witness*

10. *You shall not covet*

**April 27th: Exodus 25:1-27:21** *Coming Home*

Q: Exodus 25:1-9. What does the Lord instruct his people to make for him and why?

**April 28th: Exodus 28:1-31:18** *The Way to Worship*

Q: In what way is Jesus—as the ultimate, perfect high priest—the ideal intercessor and advocate who speaks on our behalf before the throne of God? (Hebrews 9:11-14)

**April 29th: Exodus 32:1-32** *Failure Isn't Final*

Q: Why are we tempted to worship things rather than God? What idols compete for your affection today?

**April 30th: Exodus 33:1-34:35** *God's Glory*

Q: What would you rather have, God's blessings without His presence, or God's presence without His blessings? How is your stated preference reflected in your prayers and in the choices you make in life?

**May 1st: Exodus 35:1-40:38** *God With Us*

Q: How might you present the gospel to an unbeliever with an emphasis on the presence of God, rather than on the avoidance of hell and the obtaining of blessings?

**May 2nd: Reflection** Re-Read the memory verse. Read "At Home, At Last Together" and "Category and Context" from Nancy Guthrie's book, *The Lamb of God*

### WEEK ONE

**Reading:** *Exodus 1:1-11:10*

**Big Idea:** *God sees His people and puts in place His sovereign plan to rescue them with His power and might.*

**Memory Verse:** *Commandments 1 & 2 - Exodus 20:2-6*

1. *You shall have no other gods before me*

2. *You shall not make for yourself a carved image*

**April 6th: Exodus 1:1-22** *Desperate for a Deliverer*

Q: How did the Israelite's current circumstances as revealed in Exodus 1:8-14 seem to call the promise of God faithfulness into question?

**April 7th: Exodus 2:1-25** *Living in the Midst of Darkness*

Q: What was the result of Moses taking matters into his own hands?

**April 8th: Exodus 3:1-4:31** *The Great I AM Knows My Name*

Q: How did God protect Moses in Exodus 3:5, and what or whom is he protecting him from?

**April 9th: Exodus 5:1-7:7** *Making Bricks Without Straw*

Q: Ex 5:22-23. When have you been tempted to think that *not* following God would be easier or better?

**April 10th: Exodus 7:8-8:19** *The Plagues Pt. 1*

Q: The plagues were attacks on the "gods" of Egypt. What serves some people as gods of provision and prosperity today?

**April 11th: Exodus 8:20-11:10** *The Plagues Pt. 2*

Q: Ex 8:22. How did God protect His people & how is he protecting you?

**April 12th: Reflection** Re-read the memory verse. Read "What's Your Story" and "If You Really Want to Know Me" from Nancy Guthrie's book, *The Lamb of God*.

## WEEK TWO

**Reading:** Exodus 12:1-18:1-27

**Big Idea:** God miraculously delivers His people by parting the Red Sea and demonstrates He is worthy to be followed.

**Memory Verse:** Commandments 3 & 4 - Exodus 20:7-11

3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain

4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy

**April 13th: Exodus 12:1-13:16** *Christ Our Passover Lamb*

Q: What are the similarities between Passover and the Lord's Supper?

**April 14th: Exodus 13:17-15:21** *Christ Our Resurrected Deliverer*

Q: What, according to Exodus 14:13-14, is God's part and the Israelites' part in the victory over the Egyptians that they will experience at the Red Sea?

**April 15th: Exodus 15:22-17:7** *Grumbling or Gratitude?*

Q: Compare Exodus 16:4 with Deuteronomy 8:3. What does this reveal about God's purpose for feeding his people with manna for forty years?

**April 16th: Exodus 17:8-16** *Christ Our Banner In the Battle*

Q: The "Lord is My Banner" implies a rallying point. In difficult times do you set your eyes on Christ as the banner of truth or on the difficulty?

**April 17th: Exodus 18:1-27** *Deciding to Delegate*

Q: Jethro said overwork would wear out Moses and the people. In what ways does a leader's workload affect the followers?

**April 18th: Reflection** Re-read the memory verse. Pray for Christ to give you a spirit of gratitude today. Read "Safely to the Other Side" from Nancy Guthrie's book, *The Lamb of God*

**April 19th: Reflection** Re-read the memory verse. Pray for Christ to be your Banner as you battle in this life.

## WEEK THREE

**Reading:** Exodus 19:1-24:11

**Big Idea:** God's holiness demands our obedience. God is a just God and gives clear instruction for how His people should live

**Memory Verse:** Commandments 5,6, & 7

5. Honor your father and mother

6. You shall not murder

7. You shall not commit adultery

**April 20th: Exodus 19:1-25** *Making It Up The Mountain*

Q: According to Exodus 19:5-6, what is God's purpose in bringing the Israelites out of Egypt and in giving them his law?

**April 21st: Exodus 20:1-11** *Laying Down the Law Pt. 1*

Q: Many people think of God's law as something opposed to grace. Yet the Ten Commandments are given on the foundation of God's grace. How is grace expressed in Exodus 20:2?

**April 22nd: Exodus 20:12-21** *Laying Down the Law Pt. 2*

Q: How did Moses comfort the trembling Israelites in Exodus 20:18-20?

**April 23rd: Exodus 20:22-23:33** *Living to Love God's Laws*

Q: The laws regarding servants (Ex 21) highlight that God cares for the "least of these." How does knowing that every person is made in the image of God change how you interact with people?

**April 24th: Exodus 24:1-11** *Dining With God*

Q: Ex 24:2-8 and describe what Moses had to do to make it possible for him and the others to enter into the presence of God. How does Christ's death, burial, and resurrection change how we meet with God?

**April 25th: Reflection** Re-read the memory verse. Read "Clouds on the Mountain" from Nancy Guthrie's book, *The Lamb of God*

**April 26th: Reflection** Re-read the memory verse. Pray that God would expand your view of His holiness and give you a desire to love His laws and walk in His ways through the power of the Holy Spirit.
