- **Proverbs 26:** According to verses 18-26, what is the importance of our speech? How has harmful speech hurt your relationships? In what ways can you do a better job of thinking before you speak?

Mon, July 27:

- **Proverbs 27:** Sometimes we need to speak up against sin and confront our brothers for their good (5-6). How can we create an open culture of confession and accountability in our churches?

Tues, July 28:

- **Proverbs 28:** According to verse 6, what is better than accumulating wealth and riches?

Wed, July 29:

- **Proverbs 29:** According to verses 22-23, where does anger and wrath lead? How can we cultivate a humble spirit?

Thurs, July 30:

- **Proverbs 30:** According to verse 5, what are we to trust in? How does God’s word become a refuge for us?

Fri, July 31:

- **Proverbs 31:** If you are a wife and/or mother, where do you see the grace of God forming you into the character of this excellent woman? If you are a husband, how can you honor the women (wife and daughters) in your life as they strive to be faithful to the role to which God has called them?

Week One Memory Verses

- **Proverbs 7:** Proverbs shows that there is a personal being, Woman Folly (Satan), who stands behind the people or things that would tempt you to sexual sin. What does that tell us about our temptations? Are they random? Disconnected?

Wed, July 8:

- **Proverbs 8:** What is the significance of Wisdom crying out at the crossroads? What do both she and Folly challenge us to do?
