How to read Edie Claire books at your local library

If your library offers Hoopla

Congratulations!!! You are very lucky to have such a library. As of 2023, all twenty-seven of my titles are available for you to read for free (or soon will be... the process is a bit slow). Several audiobooks are also available! I adore using Hoopla as a reader myself and am delighted to participate in the program.

If your library doesn't offer Hoopla

Getting access to my books may be more complicated. Whereas with Hoopla, libraries can pay a set amount for a subscription to tons of ebooks and audiobooks, other library suppliers (Overdrive, Bibliotheca, Baker & Taylor Axis 360, or Odilo) require each book be purchased individually. But while it's very difficult to get a library to invest in a print book of anything other than a mega-bestseller, **many libraries will order specific ebooks if a patron requests them.**

How to request that your library order an ebook

If you search an online catalog for a book your library doesn't have, there may be options shown (which change all the time!) for either requesting a title or at least asking to be notified when it is available. Even saying yes to the latter does send a notification to your library that their patrons are interested in it. If enough patrons mention a book or author, acquiring librarians do take notice!

Still can't find a book?

If your library catalog doesn't list a title at all, you may want to contact an actual human librarian and ask if they can help you find it. If it's an ebook, be sure to mention that the book is independently published by the author, because some vendors, including OverDrive, will not include titles from smaller publishers in their main catalog, which could make them difficult to find. But if your librarian knows where to look, they will find my titles available through all major library suppliers.

Don't be shy!

Most librarians truly love helping people find good books to read. There are so many digital books being published today that finding the gems can be a daunting task for all concerned. But by recommending books you like for purchase by your library, you are helping other patrons to enjoy them as well.

What do I have available besides ebooks?

All of my titles are available in ebook, trade paperback, and hardcover formats, and some are also available as audiobooks.
