It's included with your subscription to Faith Teams

What is Community Plus?

An upgrade that adds new features to Community

- Church directory
- Group chat
- Additional publishing features to your Community site and app

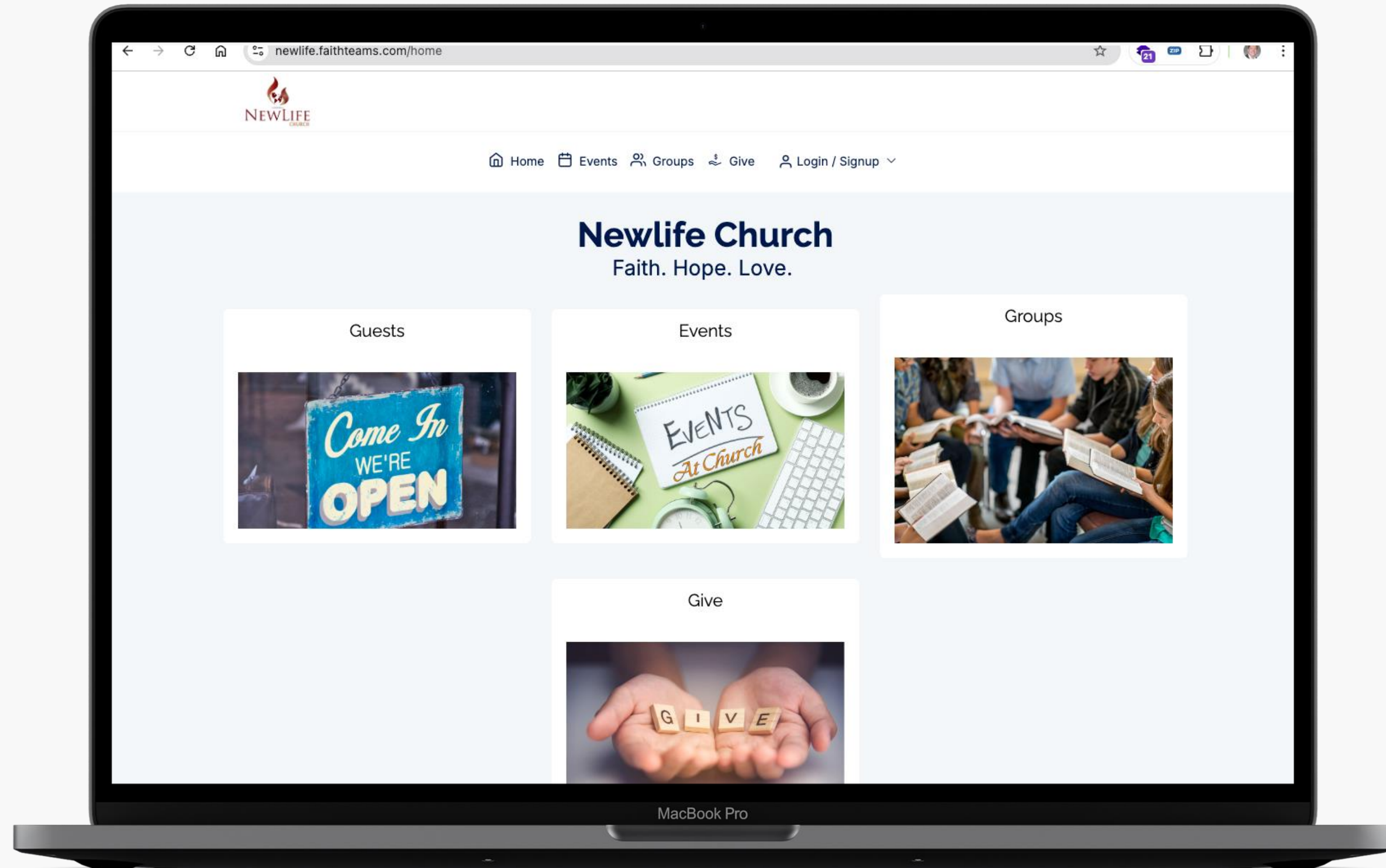
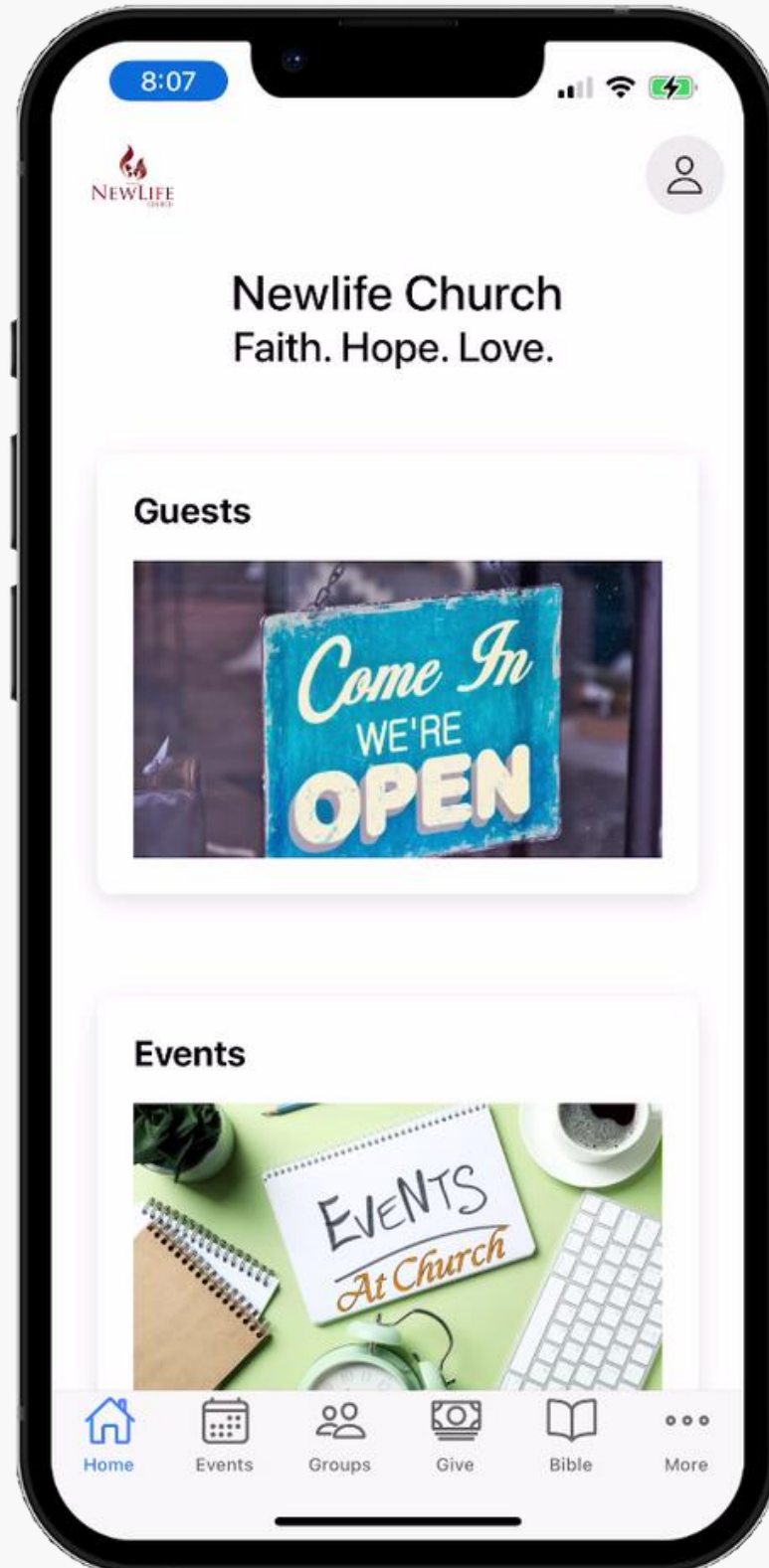
What does it cost to upgrade to Community Plus?

\$15 per month for up to 99 active people
\$25 per month for 100 to 499 active people
\$45 per month for 500 to 999 active people
\$75 per month for 1,000 to 1,999 active people
\$115 per month for 2,000 to 4,999 active people
\$165 per month for 5,000 or more active people

To Activate Community, you must migrate your Subdomain to point to the New Community Landing Site.

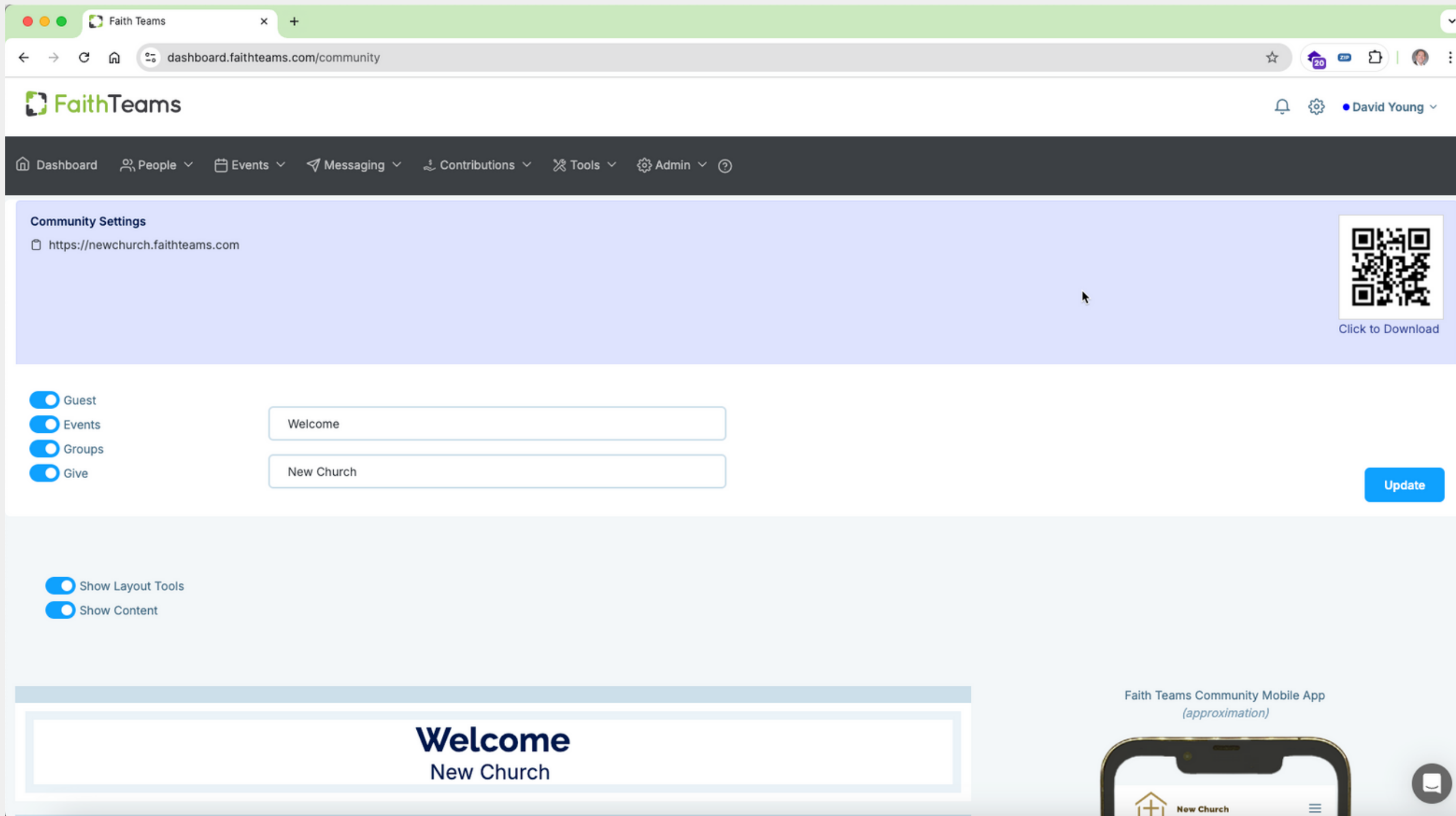

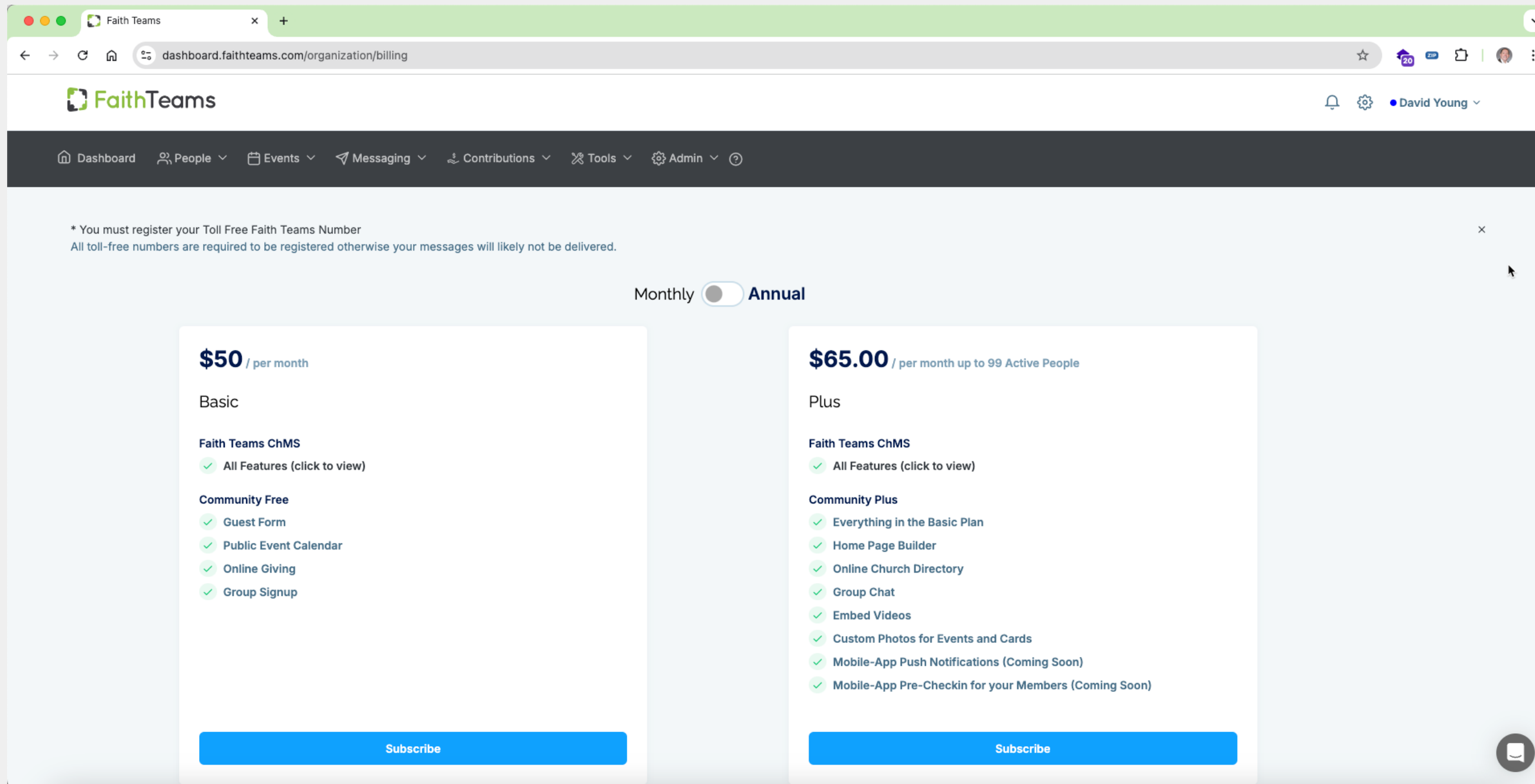

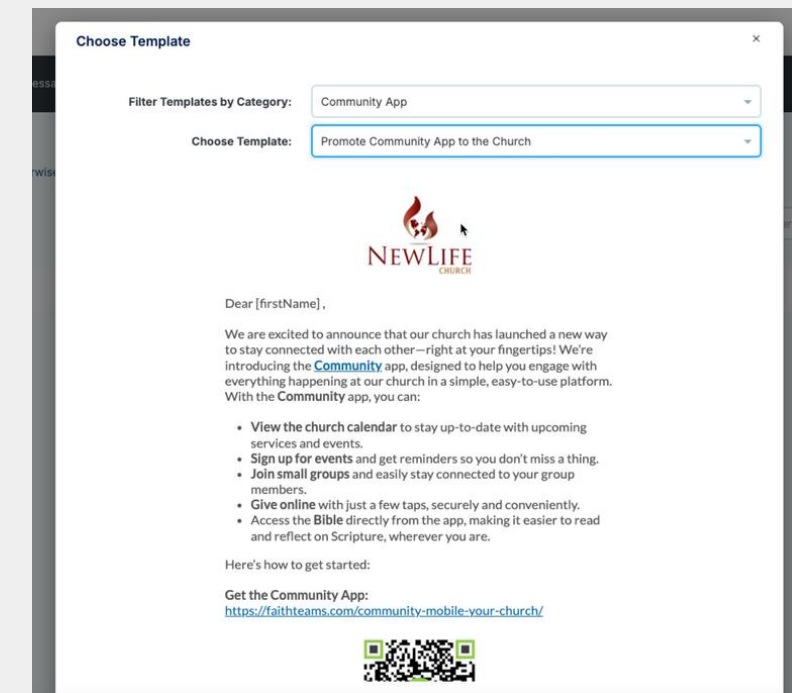
