All located at YOUR OWN Faith Teams web address. For example:

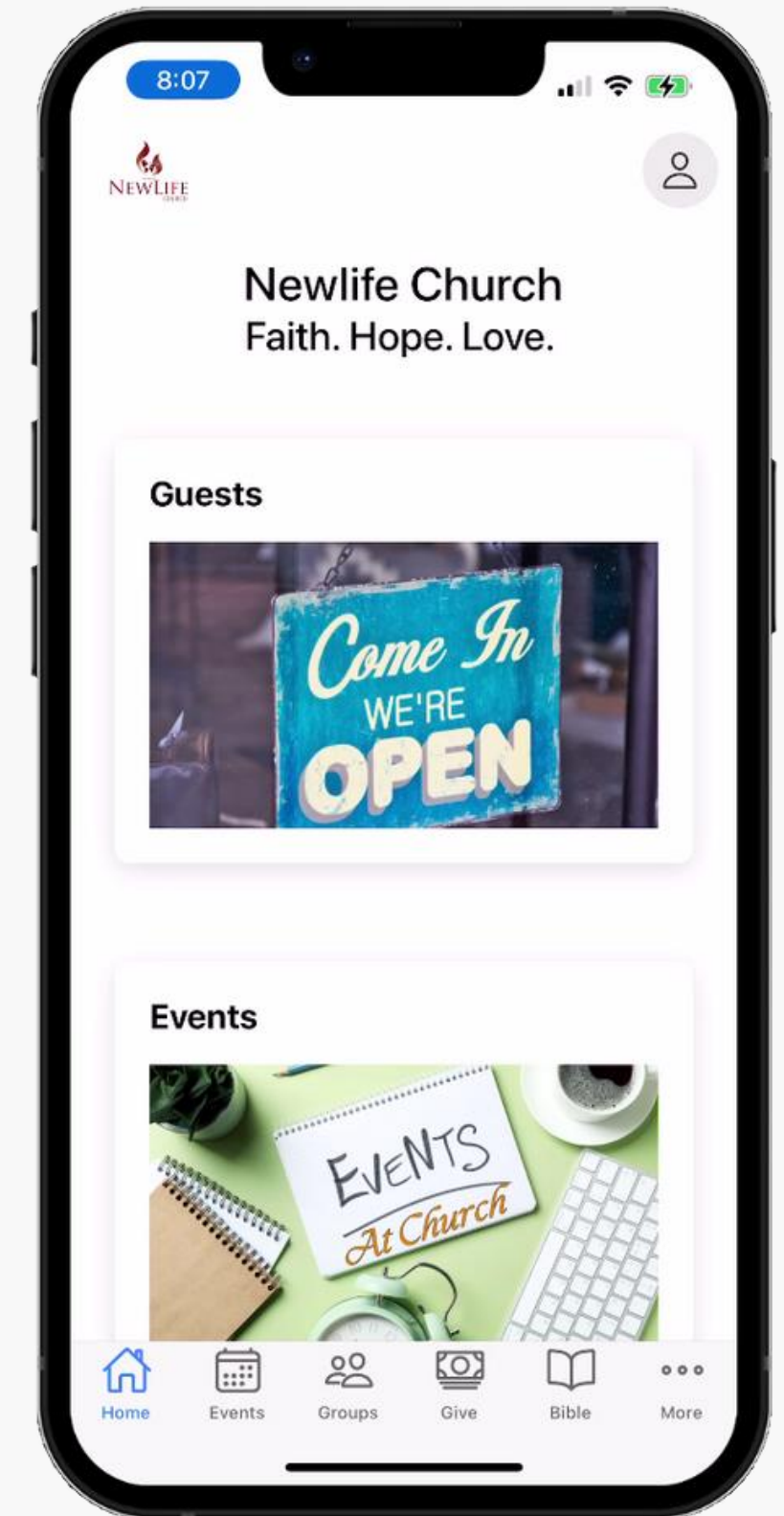
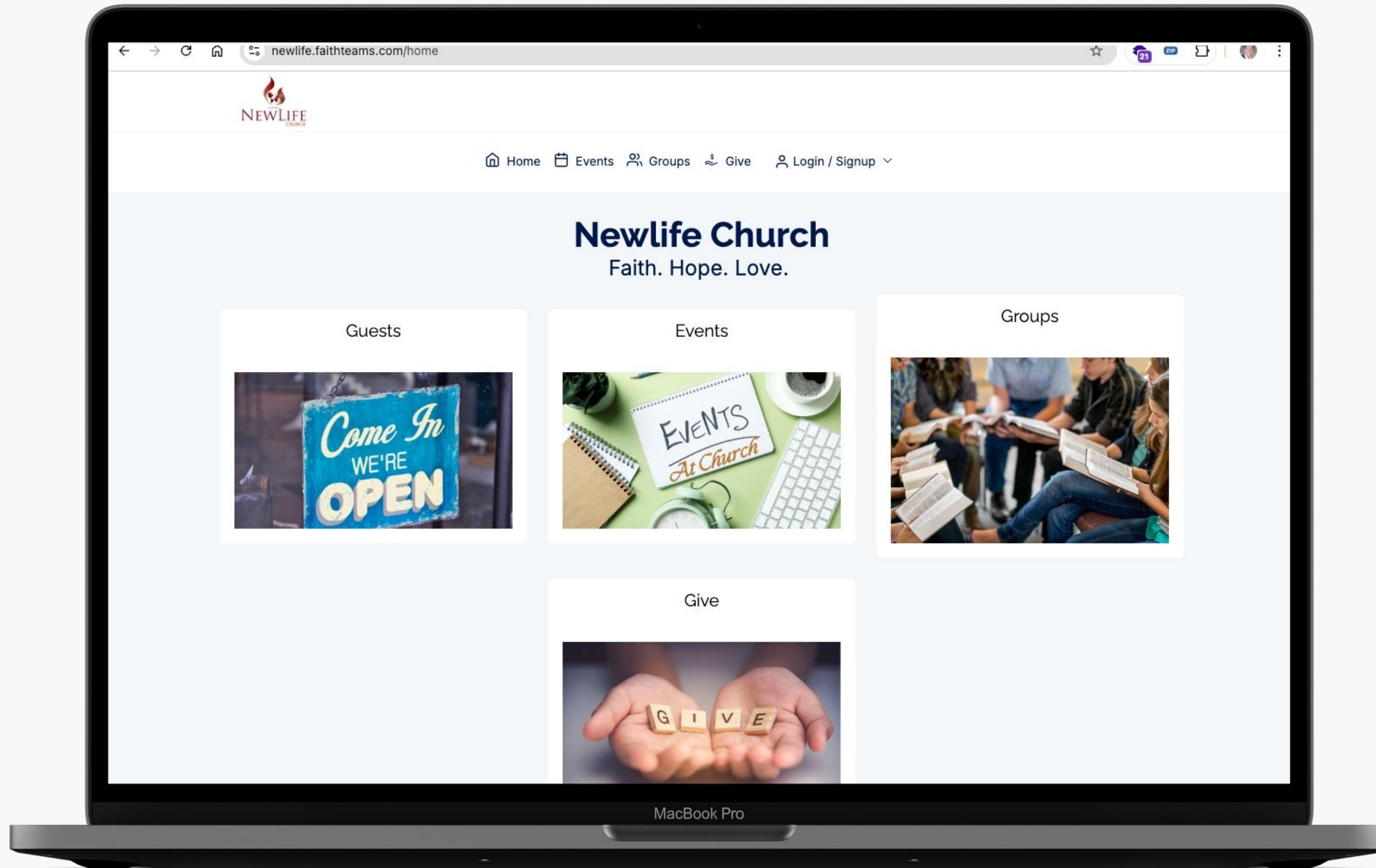

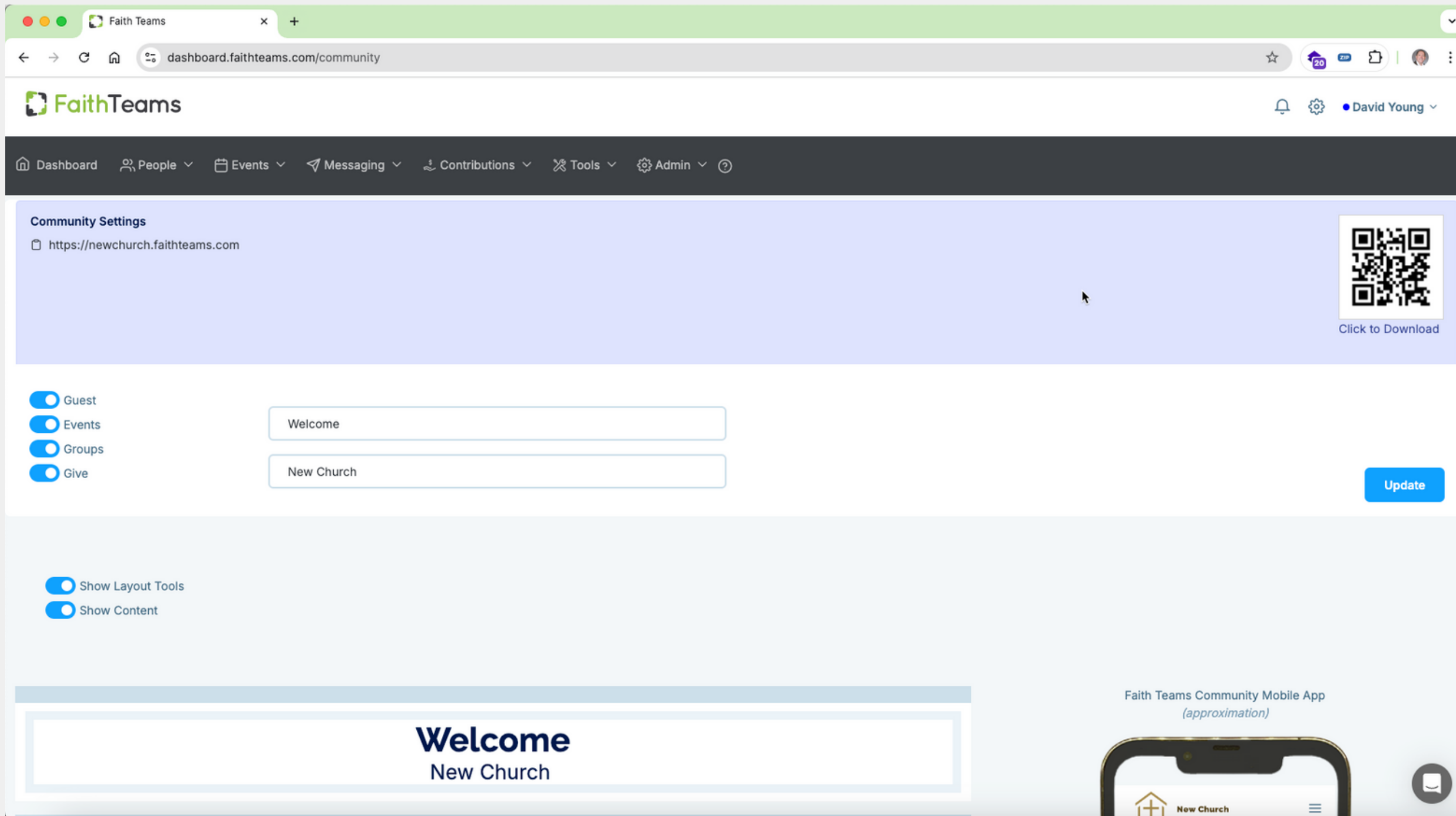
To Activate Community, you must migrate your Subdomain to point to the New Community Landing Site.

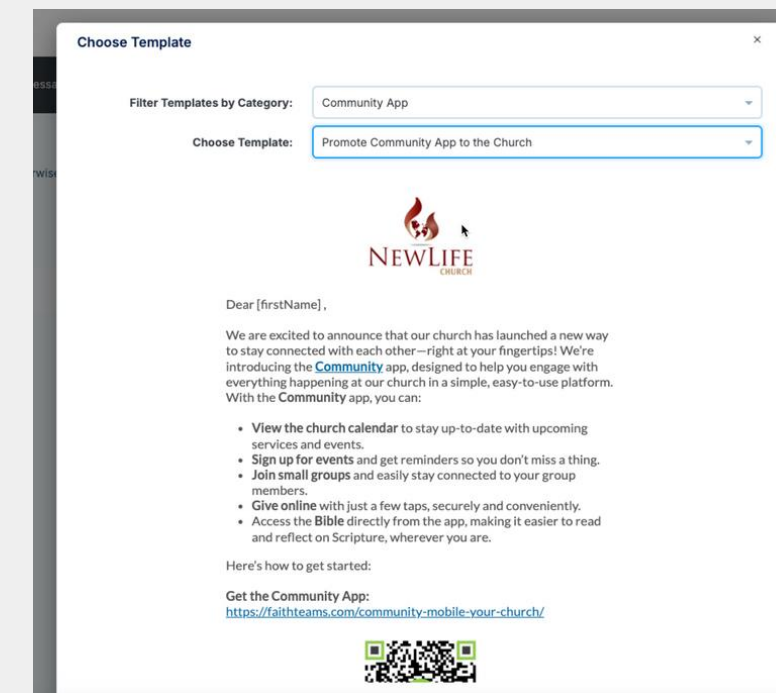
