HOLY COW! SURVEY SUMMARY

In late March of this year, St. Andrew's participated in the Holy Cow Consulting Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT). We had a good participation rate and can therefore be confident about what the assessment showed us about our congregation.

Our assessment revealed that we are a clergy-focused and settled congregation, and that will require specific skills in our next rector. Among those needed skills will be a solid and caring pastoral presence, coupled with strong preaching and teaching. We seek a connector who will help us build relationships and share our faith stories with one another. While we desire an entrepreneurial and strategic thinker, our next rector will need to understand that any change must be considered, intentional, and applied slowly and patiently. We will work together with you to manage expectations about the rector's role in a truly "family" system.
