



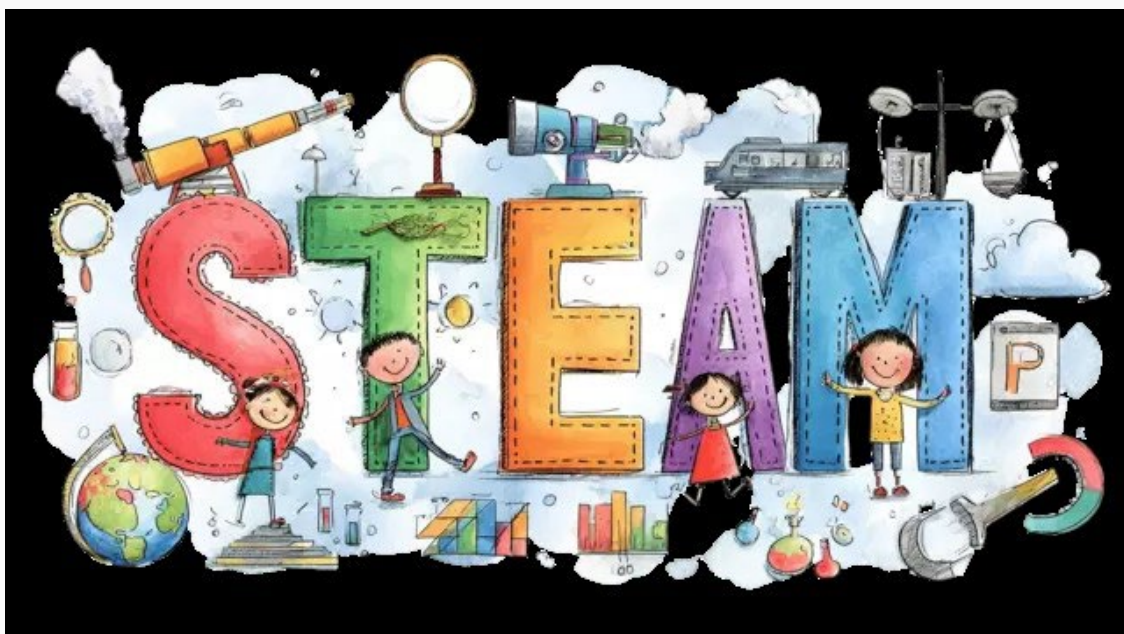

Extended Day Highlights

This month we will begin our new 4-year-old program that extends the days on Monday and Wednesday until 2 pm. This class will be focusing on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) through hands-on activities, we will encourage curiosity and a love of learning while exploring a variety of fun and meaningful themes. In September, the children will dive into exciting activities using their five senses through a nature walk, apple exploration involving engineering, sink or float, life cycle understanding and chemical reactions. These activities are designed to spark curiosity and build important skills such as questioning, problem solving, critical thinking and teamwork. We are so excited for this new adventure!

EXTENDED DAY CLASS (Wednesday, 9/9) - 12pm - 2 pm

Note the 2- day classes will end at 11:30 am during the month of September.
Beginning on October 1st they will end at Noon.

**Preschool Sign In:**

You will need to complete the Sign In Process for your child every day they come to school. The sign in can be accessed online between 8:30 - 9:15 am via the church website under the [PRESCHOOL SIGN IN](#) tab. You can also complete the sign in at school via the QR Codes or tablet outside your child's classroom. Please make sure to do this every day as this is an important procedure for our classes.

Pick Up Procedures:

Just a reminder that when you arrive to pick up your child from their fun day at preschool, please wait outside the classrooms. A teacher will open the door and dismiss each child individually to their parent. Please be sure to stand far enough back from the door that the teacher can see all those that have arrived for pick up. In our wonderful large space it can become quite noisy at pick up. Please help us make dismissal run smoothly by trying to keep all voices lower and please no running.

BABY PICTURES NEEDED!

This month our children will be learning about what a special gift from God they are! They will be discovering how much they have grown in just a few years from when they were a baby. To help during this unit our teachers are requesting a baby picture of all the children at the preschool. Please send in a paper copy or email a copy of your child's baby picture directly to their teacher. See email addresses listed above. This picture will be used to make a special class book which will stay at school. These pictures are needed by Friday, September 18th!





PLEASE REMEMBER: Bring in a change of clothes for your child to keep at school the day of Open House. If you are not able to attend Open House please be sure to bring it on the first day of school for your child. Include a shirt, shorts, underwear, socks and shoes, if possible, in a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. For safety reasons we ask that your child wear only closed-toe shoes at school.

Snacks at School

Your child's snack calendar for September will come home in your tote bag the first week of school. The preschool will provide simple snack items for the first week. If your child's name did not appear on the calendar for this month, you will see it in October. There is a list of requested snack items on the back of the accompanying letter. Please note that any allergies present in your child's class are noted on the calendar and we ask you to try to avoid those items. Your child will be given a snack bag the preschool day before they are to bring snack for their class to help you remember your snack day.

WATER BOTTLES: We are asking each child to bring a water bottle each day labeled with their name. This water bottle will be available to your child whenever they would like a quick drink and will be used during snack time.



Weekly Units

During September we begin exploring "God and Me". Our Bible stories focus on creation. The children will begin the month by becoming acquainted with each other and our routines. Then we will discuss how special and unique

we are in God's eyes, starting when we were babies! We will continue to learn all about each part of me, by weighing, measuring ourselves and learning the different parts of our body. We will also discuss our emotions and feelings, focusing on how to be good friends to each other. By the end of the month our children will understand how important they are at our school!

LOGOS at Christ Memorial Presbyterian Church:

LOGOS is a mid-week ministry open to all young people from preschool through high school. FAMILY TIME: This is more than just dinner! We share food, fun, and conversation around the table each week as a church family.
