Theme: 'DEMONSTRATION & MANIFESTATION'

And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power – 1 Corinthians 2:4

DEMONSTRATION: *An act of showing that something exists or is true by giving proof or evidence*

MANIFESTATION: *An event, action or thing that is a sign that something exists or is happening*

SUNDAY 4TH JANUARY @ 6.30PM (IN-PERSON & ONLINE)

Topic: The POWER of the CROSS

This year, we focus on God's Power in all areas of our lives. The Power of the Cross changes lives through Jesus' sacrifice, offering Himself in our place as a redemption for our sin. As we apply God's Word, we engage the Holy Spirit who helps us to surrender to God's cleansing power. He convicts us in the secret areas in our lives that need His attention. Pray for cleansing of the mind, our thoughts and speech and our actions that hinder us from living in right standing with God.

Romans 1:16 (KJV) For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Colossians 2:13-14 (TLB) You were dead in sins, and your sinful desires were not yet cut away. Then he gave you a share in the very life of Christ, for he forgave all your sins, 14 and blotted out the charges proved against you, the list of his commandments which you had not obeyed. He took this list of sins and destroyed it by nailing it to Christ's cross.

MONDAY 5TH JANUARY @ 7PM – 8.30PM (IN-PERSON & ONLINE)

Topic: The POWER of GOD'S WISDOM

God's wisdom is supernatural insight that surpasses human understanding and gives us guidance, protection, clarity of purpose and empowers us to overcome challenges. God reveals His wisdom to us through His son, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, His Word, prayer and wise counsel.

Pray for divine guidance, discernment, and understanding, clarity in decision-making, to be filled with the Spirit of Wisdom and for no confusion or ungodly influences.

James 1:5 (KJV) If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

James 3:17 (TLB) But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure and full of quiet gentleness. Then it is peace-loving and courteous. It allows discussion and is willing to yield to others; it is full of mercy and good deeds. It is wholehearted and straightforward and sincere.

Proverbs 2:6 (ESV) For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.

TUESDAY 6TH JANUARY @ 7PM – 8.30PM (IN-PERSON & ONLINE)

Topic: God's Power – The Ultimate Source of Wealth

The Christian perspective is that all wealth and the ability to produce it comes from God. Therefore we posture ourselves in gratitude, humility, and reliance on divine guidance rather than solely on our own efforts or pride. Pray for God's wisdom when making financial and business decisions, asking for divine ideas, strategies, and guidance in choosing the right opportunities.

Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV) Thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth

Philippians 4:19 (NCV) My God will use His wonderful riches in Christ Jesus to give you everything you need.

Proverbs 18:16 (NKJV) A man's gift makes room for him, And brings him before great men.

Proverbs 3:9-10 (TLB) Honour the Lord by giving him the first part of all your income, and he will fill your barns with wheat and barley and overflow your wine vats with the finest wines.

WEDNESDAY 7TH JANUARY @ 7PM – 8.30PM (IN-PERSON & ONLINE)

Topic: To See a Demonstration of God's Power - Personal Prayer Requests

Lift up prayers for your family, friends for God's Power to touch all things concerning you.

Philippians 4:6 (NKJV) Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

Matthew 7:7 (NKJV) Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Psalm 107:6 (NKJV) They cried out to the Lord in their trouble, And He delivered them out of their distresses.

Genesis 12:3 (KJV)

And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV) For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Hebrews 4:16 (ESV) Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

2 Chronicles 7:14 (ESV) If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Topic: God's Power Demonstrated Through Faith

God intends for believers to live daily in His power. We do this by believing and acting on His Word, renewing our minds and our hearts to create an environment for His power to operate freely – That's our faith connected to God's Power which enables us to overcome challenges and live righteously.

This connection means faith isn't just belief but an active principle, activating God's power for life.

1 Corinthians 2:5 (KJV) That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

1 Peter 1:5 (NLT) And through your faith, God is protecting you by his power until you receive this salvation, which is ready to be revealed on the last day for all to see.

2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV) For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Mark 11:24 (ESV) Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

James 5:15 (KJV) And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Romans 1:17 (ESV) For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith,[a] as it is written, The righteous shall live by faith.

James 1:6 (ESV) Let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NIV) Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Psalm 69:30 (NIV) I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving.

James 1:17 (NIV) Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.
