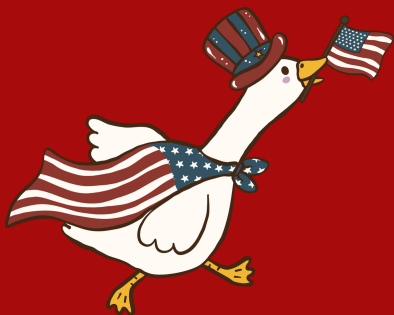

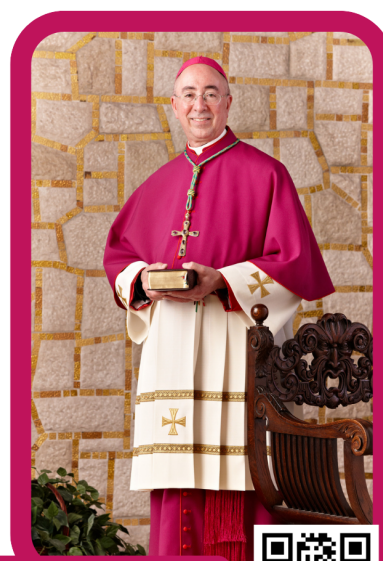

COULD GOD BE CALLING YOU?

As we prepare for another year of Disciple Maker Formation, we are looking for catechists to help lead both our Summer Formation and Traditional Formation classes.

One of the biggest misconceptions about being a catechist is that you need to be an expert in the faith or have all the answers. You don't. What our young people need most is someone who is willing to show up, share their faith, and walk alongside them as they grow closer to Christ.

The beautiful thing about serving as a catechist is that it isn't just the students who grow. Many catechists find that preparing lessons, discussing faith, and spending time with our youth strengthens their own relationship with God as well.

You may be more prepared than you realize. If you love the Lord, care about our young people, and are willing to learn alongside them, you already have so much to offer.

Please prayerfully consider whether God may be calling you to this important ministry. The impact of a caring adult can last a lifetime.

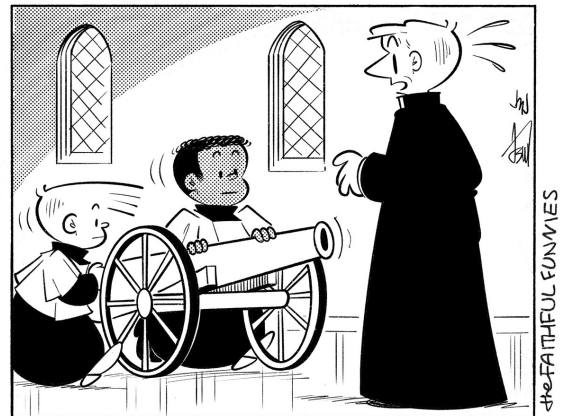
