Something Other Than God by Jennifer Fulwiler

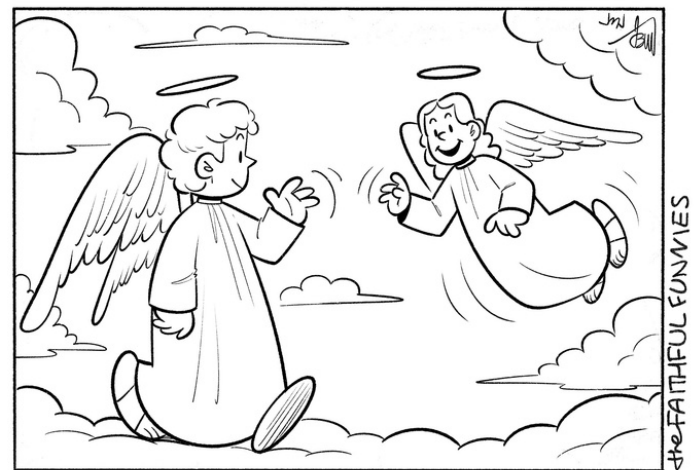
A poignant, profound and often funny tale of one woman who set out to find the meaning of life and discovered that true happiness sometimes requires losing it all.
