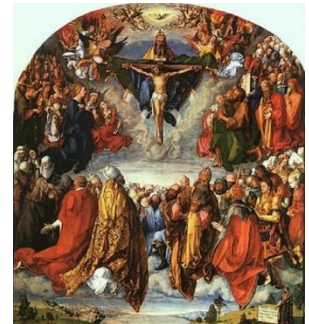


Confirmation Saint Project

You will choose a Catholic saint whose name you will take when you receive the sacrament of Confirmation. You may want to read a bit about several different saints before you decide on your name. Please pray and carefully think about what saint name God wants you to take.

Once you have chosen your Confirmation name, you will research the saint and complete a project displaying information about your saint. You will use a trifold board for your project. You may use books or electronic resources to find information about your saint. Please write the information in your own words. **You should include as much of the following information as possible.**

- ❖ Your saint's name
- ❖ An image of your saint (printed or drawn)
- ❖ When the saint lived (including birth date and date of death if known)
- ❖ Where the saint lived
- ❖ Language(s) the saint spoke
- ❖ Family information (parents, siblings, husband or wife, children, etc.)
- ❖ Vocation information (single, married, priest, nun, etc. and what type of work the person did)
- ❖ How the saint exhibited holiness in his or her life
- ❖ Why you chose this person as your Confirmation saint
- ❖ Miracles attributed to the saint (if known)
- ❖ When the saint was canonized
- ❖ What the person is patron/patroness of
- ❖ Symbol(s) associated with your saint (if applicable)
- ❖ A prayer asking for the intercession of your saint or a prayer that your saint wrote (if applicable)
- ❖ Interesting fact(s) about your saint
- ❖ Any other information you would like to include



Please make your board as visually appealing as possible. Use clearly legible handwriting and decorate your board. The boards will be put on display at the end of the week to be viewed by all involved in the Summer Faith Formation Program and in the Confirmation Retreat. Give this your best effort! Blessings 😊
