Marlon previously served as the department's chief administrative officer and director of policy and legislative affairs. He has also held positions at the Michigan Supreme Court and the State Budget Office. Marlon earned a bachelor's degree in political science from American University, a master's degree in public administration from the University of Delaware, and a doctorate in public administration from Valdosta State University.
