Our Student Start-Up Program (SSUP) is a Saugeen Connects Partnership initiative consisting of Brockton, Hanover, Minto, Wellington North, and West Grey, along with the SEDC, launched the Saugeen Student Start-Up Program (SSUP).

2019

SSUP provided 41 youths with the chance to run 34 businesses in the Saugeen Region that year.

2021

The program returned in 2021 and saw 59 youths open 50 businesses.

2022

Saugeen Connects extended the program to Arran-Elderslie and South Bruce. In 2022, Saugeen Connects helped 48 youths open 47 businesses. SSUP is offered to students to try self-employment during their summer holidays, July and August.

HOW IT WORKS

Students apply to the program by May 5, 2023. Once accepted into the program, they will receive **\$150** start-up money for their business idea. Throughout July and August, there will be 5 weeks of workshops for students to attend. If they attend all 5 workshops, they receive a bonus of up to **\$150**. At the end of the program, students submit their final report by September 8, 2023, and they can earn up to another **\$150**.

In total, students have the opportunity to earn up to **\$450** by completing the program.
