God willing this month pastor Washington will be traveling to Manaus where he will meet with WBF missionary Mark McCuthin and the two of them will be translating for a group visiting from North Carolina. The group will be visiting the Institute for Transforming Lives. The pastor who planted this work is deeply grateful for the financial help the ITV has received for this work. As a result of this work a new church has been planted and pastor Plinio has joined hands with pastor Paulo Arruda to help in this work.

The two-hour meeting on Tuesday evening has become a wellspring of blessing and support for all who participate. I am honored to have a part in this meeting to teach Brazilian pastors. The promise of Romans 8:28 is reassuring to these men no matter the circumstances. Many of these servants of God have been through faith-building experiences that lead them to trust God's promise to work all things together for their good and God's glory.

In closing I ask you to pray for Eloina, pastor Paulo Arruda's wife, who is presently battling cancer. They are the couple God has used to plant the Institute for Transforming Lives and the new church in Brazil. A groundswell of interest and excitement is building in view of the upcoming Dedication Event for the Complete Old Testament Scroll Display set for Saturday, October 4th. This interest was punctuated in the last few days by a special visit to CEM by Messianic Leader Joel Chernoff and his wife Myriam. He is the General Secretary of the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America, a group of over one hundred Messianic Congregations. Joel is also Founder of the Joseph Project, Israel's #1 Importer of Humanitarian Aid, providing assistance for hundreds of thousands of Israeli citizens. His response was an overwhelming outflow of appreciation for what we are doing and for our stand with Israel. He plans to be present for the Scroll Dedication. In the photo, Joel and his wife are shown to the right of Mary Ann Mize who gifted the Scroll set from the Christian Heritage Foundation. Together they are holding one of the sacrificial bones excavated from the Tabernacle site in Shiloh, Israel.

At the opposite "uttermost part end of the earth" (Acts 1:8) from Israel in Fiji. Our involvement is Fiji stretches back nearly haft a century. As you know, we have been able to distribute Bibles and present the book *Pearls in Paradise* in the public high schools over the past nine years. The Vice President of our *Creation Science Association of Fiji* is engineer *Bruce Malone*. Bruce is the co-author of *Pearls* and holds nineteen research patents. Some of the products he developed are used in our space program; others in our cars and homes.

The distribution plan has worked so well in Fiji that Bruce has now carried these efforts to six different countries, and has presented the Creation and Gospel Message to 220,000 students! He will be at CEM to describe these phenomenal events at Director's Discovery Series on Saturday, August 2nd. His lecture title will be "Scripture and Science in Action." An exciting must-attend event!!!

#### Sisak Mission Trip

In June, we went to Sisak, a town 1.5 hours away and met up with an American short-term team. This team was led by a Pioneer missionary family who worked closely with our team for years and continues to come back yearly for this trip. They brought

13 people from 3 different churches, and with our team there was a total of 21 people. We had a full schedule filled with VBS-style clubs in 2 different Roma villages. Wesley was one of the leaders for games and activities within the clubs, which he loved! I, Rebekah, unexpectedly took over the role of team cook. I prepared lunch and dinner daily for the team while they worked hard at ministry. I really enjoyed this role, but I will admit that I came home completely exhausted! Reese and Beau both had a blast with their "new friends". The kids and I all ended up getting sick, but thankfully not until the very end of the trip! Taking a family with 2 little ones on a jam-packed trip was fun, exhausting, and downright hard. We pray the Roma kids had open ears while the gospel was being shared many, many times. Thank you for praying for our trip, the Roma and for us! (Lots of pictures below)

#### Visas

As most of you know we have been struggling with our future Visa plan. We are currently here on a "volunteer visa" which was supposed to be the "easiest" route and one we could renew every year. However, this spring the law radically changed and that visa no longer exists! We are now in the process of applying for a 6-month extension to give us time to work on a new "work visa". Wes and Sergej have been going back and forth to MUP (visa office) only to find out the process is becoming more complicated and delayed. We are fairly confident the outcome will be fine, but the process is a rollercoaster. Please be praying as we navigate this. We know God is in control and we have peace about all of this. Thank you for continuing to pray with us!



"But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:" {1 Corinthians 1:30}.

I Corinthians 1:30 is the context of our forum for our young people. There are two principal effects that sin produces, which cannot be separated: the defilement it causes, the guilt it brings. Thus, salvation from sin requires both a cleansing and pardon of the one who is to be saved. Through salvation we are given our inheritance in Christ Jesus. We are sanctified and justified in eyes of God. These two things are inseparable. Note the following references; "In the Lord have I righteousness and strength" (Isa 45:24); "but of Him are you in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption" (1 Cor 1:30); "but you are washed, but you are sanctified, but you are justified" (1 Cor 6:11); "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).

The Lord has blessed us with several Bible Institutes and another one is being built in the state of Acre. The pastor there has done a great job and he has realized that he needs an Institute. He has already started on the foundation. Our Bible Institute here will be starting again in August for our 4 year students. All 7 students plan on returning and we should have some new students also. The morning classes will begin again on September 8 with all 7 students returning. The 2 year classes have 8 students. Pray for them as they prepare to serve the Lord in their churches.

Our bi-annual Bible Conference for leadership on the upper Rio Negro was held on August the 18 - 20 at one of the churches along the river about 2 hours above Sao Gabriel, at a place called Aparecida. It was well attended and a blessing to those that were able to come.



Our graduates continue to preach, baptize and teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. There is a new Congregation starting up on one of the tributaries of the Amazon river. God is blessing our churches that are scattered through out the state of Amazonas, Brazil and South America.

What a wonderful time we had during our 2½ month stay in the States! Our kids took good care of both of us, since I was recovering from surgery and Antonia was dealing with back issues. It was also so sweet to see my mom and dad, as well as my brother and sister (and their families). Finally, it was a blessing to be back at our home church, the Pleasantview Baptist Church, during our time there. The fellowship, S.S. lessons and great preaching were a real encouragement to us.

We want to thank those of you who helped us with the travel and medical expenses that we incurred, and we also thank you for praying for my recovery from the hernia surgery that I had, as well as the ongoing back issues that Antonia was having and continues to battle constantly. We are blessed to have incredible prayer warriors helping us, so now that we are back on the field please continue to pray for us.

There is another piece of good news for me to share! My brother John and his wife Isabel have prayerfully decided that God is moving them back to Brazil after serving for several years on staff at our mission agency in Arlington, TX. We are looking forward to having them back on the field, and we ask that you pray for them as they raise additional support and seek God's face about where exactly they will be serving upon their return.

#### CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

We are thrilled to report that the Lord has provided the funds necessary for us to finish phase 3 of our building program at the Independent Baptist Church in New City! Thanks to the generous offerings of God's people in the States, we have been able to raise \$117,582 of the \$185,000 that we need from our partners. In addition, the church members here are diligently working and giving toward their \$37,000 part of the matching funds campaign. We praise the Lord and thank you for your part in this project!

Meanwhile, construction is full speed ahead on phase 2 of the building program. Please pray that God will provide the remaining \$67,418 that we still need from our U.S. partners to finish the entire building!







During the construction project, we are meeting in a very small house nearby. Nevertheless, we are thankful to have had two new families visiting, as well as other visitors. Please pray for souls to be saved as we continue the Lord's work. Thank you for partnering with us! May God bless you as we labor together!

Hello Bro. McNeil & Pleasantview Baptist Family,

We want to share our heart-felt gratitude for sending Mrs McNeil and Sandy Thomas as the quest speakers for our ladies retreat in May. We were honored to have them both. Thank you also for providing financially for them both to be here (as well as the extra help for

camp expenses)! They did a tremendous job communicating the theme "Anchored in His love" and were a HUGE blessing to us personally, as well as to the 62 Dutch & French speaking ladies of Belgium.

Another praise is that our Belgian residence visas were renewed last week without any issues. They have been extended for 5 more years. If you remember the last time they renewed our visas, it was quite a struggle as Belgium is an essentially a closed country in the fact that the government has taken away all missionary and religious worker's visas. We continue to be amazed at God's amazing grace.

Our Family Camp just ended and it was the biggest ever with 25 who came. Paul & Alydia Moore, former missionaries in Belgium, were our guest speakers. Our theme for the week can best be translated into English as "Now what? Our lessons included Paul & Barnabas separating as friends, now what? Joseph being accused of something he didn't do, now what? Elijah was told to go stay by the brook, and then it dried up, now what? It was a time of joy reminding us to rest in God's timing and His plan. Now we're at teen camp, which started 3 days ago!

As you may know, we operate on support given in U.S. dollars, but living and serving in Europe means that most of our expenses happen in Euros. We mentioned in our last letter that the Euro-to-Dollar exchange rate has shifted

significantly — it's now at a 17% loss in value. That means every dollar we receive is now stretching quite a bit less than it used to. This is going to have a very real impact on one of our most effective weekly outreach efforts: our Saturday evening Bible study and shared meal. Preparing a home-cooked meal ahead of the Bible study has become a powerful way to open doors, break down walls, and invite people into conversations about Jesus. It's not just the food, it's the fellowship, connection, and gospel seeds that are being planted. With the current financial shift, however, we are facing the real possibility of having to scale back or pause the meal portion of this gathering — something we really don't want to do.

We are committed to continuing the work, adapting where we must, and trusting God every step of the way. Thank you for standing with us — through every conversation, every meal, and every changed life.

So many times I have heard people say, "Door to door visitation doesn't work for me". They only wanted to get out of our Lord's command to take the Gospel to *every creature*. They say it's *embarrassing* or *too hot* or they don't know if they'll be *bothering people*... and many other excuses. But I can tell you for sure that you may be the **answer to someone's prayers** when you obey God's command to go! Here is one such example.

A house with 5 big dogs outside its fence was skipped by a group of our ladies during visitation because it scared them. Plus a large "NO TRESPASSING" sign was posted by the open gate to the house. The Lord was leading me with a need to go to that house. We walked past all the outside dogs, the "No Trespassing" sign and the 11 puppies inside the yard and I knocked on the door. A surprised little girl answered the door and called for her mother to come. When I introduced ourselves, the mother started sobbing. It concerned me as her 3 children all crowded around her and she called for her husband. I explained that we wanted to get to know all our neighbors and pray for them. I told them, "We were from down the street at the Baptist Church". The crying mother begged us to come in. That's when I noticed her tears were flowing down a smiling face. She explained that times had been rough lately and they didn't know what they were going to do. Both she and her husband had lost their jobs and were unable to find new ones. They were almost out of food and their rent and car payment were due with no money. She shared that she had just been praying to God, pleading that He would help them and we showed up at her door. That's when I noticed her husband had a shocked and disbelieving look on his face and said "Wow! You're here". Looking at her husband she reminded him, "No one ever comes to our door and knocks. They always call out from the open gate fearing our dogs." That's when I explained that I felt God urgently wanting me to visit them today. I wanted to start home Bible studies with them and I asked if I could come back in about an hour. By the smell of things, they were about to eat dinner and I wanted to give them time to finish. They agreed and as we walked out mother pulled me aside and admitted that she was the only Christian in her family. We were the answer

to her prayers and her family saw it! If nothing else happens she asked us to please pray that her husband would get saved. I told her we would be back in about an hour after they were done eating.

After buying some groceries, my partner and I returned to their home. They greeted us with even more tears of appreciation plus a plate of fried noodles. As we were eating, the husband admitted that God must have heard his wife's prayers and was willing to do the **Bible studies** with us to learn about salvation. We started our first Bible study with the "Good Test" and gave him a Bible with homework to do before we returned. 

Now that mom is not homeschooling, we were able to hire her as our new Pre-K teacher (the current teacher is expecting a baby soon). Triple blessings!

It is so difficult to find qualified teachers who speak English well, who share our worldview, and who are willing to accept our pay, especially since English speakers have higher paying options elsewhere. However, our father is providing.

He has also provided another teacher, A. She is a retiring public school teacher that I have known for years and wished that she might serve at our school someday. We can really benefit from her expertise and experience. She was having a difficult time deciding, but then she asked me if she can teach from our favorite book. I said, "Every day." She said, "I've decided." Praises!

We also are looking to hire another teacher, S, to teach twin girls whose English levels will require a dedicated ESL teacher. However, she just discovered a lump in her breasts. Most doctors were recommending a double mastectomy. However, she found another doctor that says she can be treated with less drastic measures. Please ask that our father give us wisdom and grace in these matters.

In case you are wondering, we still have not started summer vacation. It does not start until mid-July. We will get a few weeks of vacation, of which the teachers will have three weeks of training and preparation before starting up again in September.

However, we are super excited about the Torres Grandparents coming to visit in July. Please ask for their safety, health, and lots of great memories!

Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings once again from Arlington, Texas.

As I am at the mercy of the medical community scheduling, it appears I am stuck here in the States for a bit longer.

I'd like to give you a detailed update on exactly what is happening.

First of all, my body is continuing to recuperate from the massive infection and the painful falls that I experienced in Croatia, and I have every reason to believe it will continue to strengthen and recover over time. I'm able to move around quite a bit better than I was back when I first arrived in the US. Eventually I should be able to regain a considerable amount of the capabilities I had lost. Other good news is, this Friday I will have an ablation procedure on a large vein in my left leg, which is malfunctioning. I have been waiting several months on this procedure, and it's almost here! I've learned that veins have valves that open and close at certain rates to enable the proper flow of blood. The valve on this main vein doesn't close properly, allowing blood to collect in the leg, leading to swelling and pain. It will be quite a relief to have this valve permanently closed, causing the other veins that do function properly to take over that workload. This should result in a significant boost in my quality of life. This procedure has a very high success rate and a very quick recovery time.

As I mentioned in my last letter, I unfortunately need surgery to correct the surgery I received in Croatia. Tissue healed incorrectly and now the incisions cannot close without surgical intervention. This is a source of constant aggravation. It's been a long process getting the surgery scheduled as I have now had three surgical consults and am currently waiting on a fourth. This corrective surgery will be a very complex process, involving a plastic surgeon and another specialist surgeon to work alongside one another. Once the surgery is complete, the recovery will be somewhat tedious to prevent damage to the repaired area.

I have done everything in my power to get this done as quickly as possible, but I have experienced delay after delay, which is very frustrating. My fourth surgical consult was just recently postponed for another three weeks. Very shortly after the surgical recovery is over, I am confident I will be able to get on a plane back to Croatia.

Meanwhile, Bible orders are still coming in over our free Bible website in Croatia and Pastor Telebar and I continue to work together to get them processed in a timely way.

Additionally, I am in the process of teaming up with a semi-retired preacher here in our church to begin visiting our shut-ins. I am overjoyed to have such an opportunity and we believe God will bless it.

Thank you so much for your prayers, understanding and continued support as I navigate this bump in the road. Please continue to pray that God will be glorified through it all.
