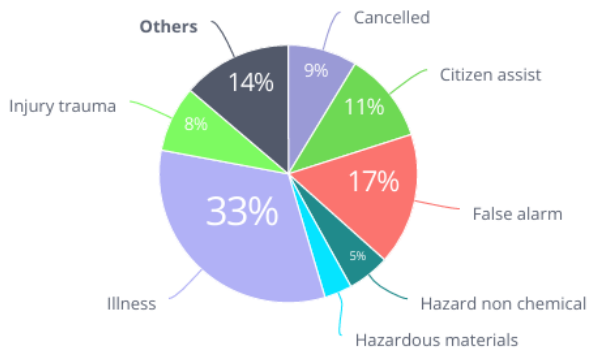

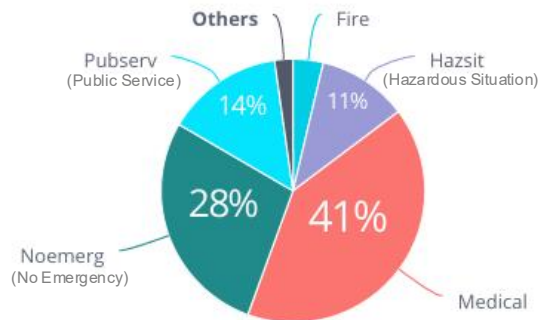

Incident Type Sub-Category



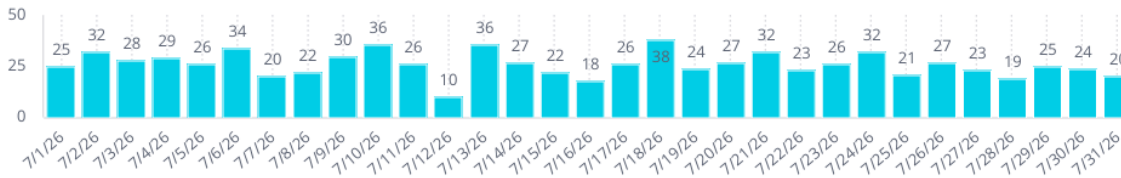

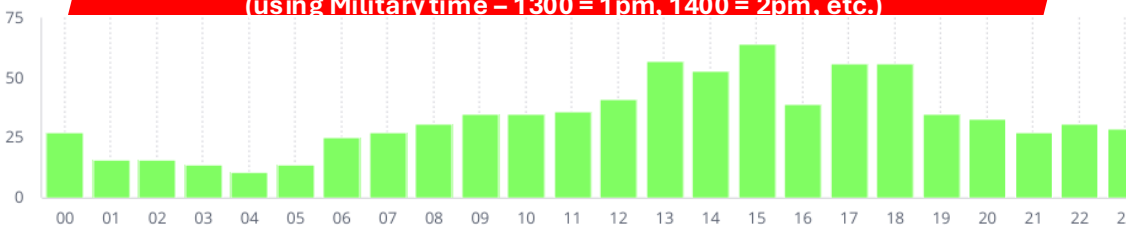

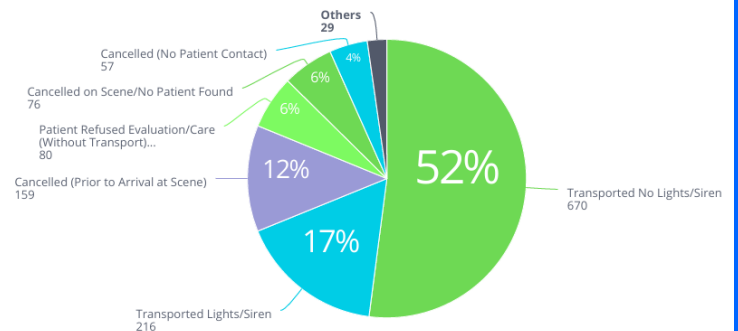

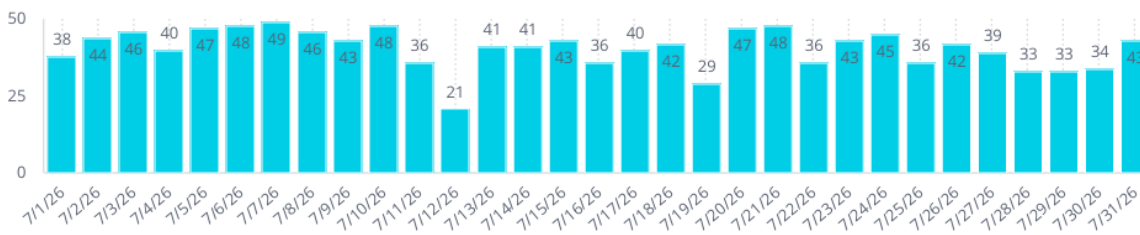

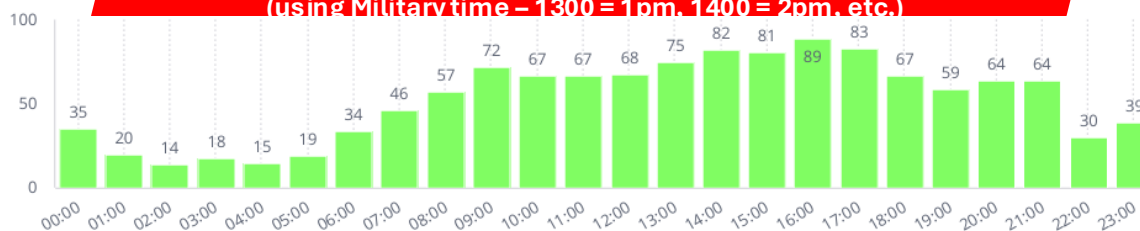
Call Disposition
