## 1. Democracy and Social Justice Efforts

- Facilitating listening to understand those in an individual's circle of influence who are oblivious to the big picture(systems) and the long-term consequences of the current environment.
- Working with and forming coalitions with non-profit and community groups to identify, develop, and promote Systems Thinking Leaders as alternatives to tribe followers.
- Developing systems for holding oneself and friends accountable during election cycles and getting actively involved in protecting voting rights.
- Providing collaboration infrastructure for supporting current resistance and protest movements that support one's personal values and definitions of character.

## 2. Leadership Development Support Technology

- Take advantage of rapidly emerging AI learning tools (NotebookLM, Claude Cowork, Gemini..)
- Leverage neuroscience research and discovery.
- Incorporate differences in learning styles and learning objectives.
- Understand the differences between motivation (willingness) and skills (ability).
- Incorporate methods to address stakeholder mental health issues.
