BASIL'S BLESSINGS LESSON 1(PG1-23)-INCLUDING GOD IN YOUR DAY

Theme: Pray without ceasing 1 Thes. 5:17
Walking with God throughout your day

Objectives:

- The student will learn that prayer is talking and listening to God
- The student will know how to say a simple prayer.
- The student will learn that you can pray at any time to God.
- The student will learn the different kinds of prayers.
- The student will learn how to involve God in their day.

I. Lesson

- A. Define what prayer is.
- B. Talk about the different kinds of prayers. Give examples: Help me God, Thank you God, You're awesome God, etc...
- C. You can pray to God as many times as you would like-he is always listening.
- D. Read the story... pages 1-23
- E. Activity-go back through these pages and find all of the different ways Basil prays to God.

II. Craft

- A. Give each student two foot prints made from cardstock.
- B. Decorate each foot print with different ways of praying by drawing pictures, adding stickers, writing different prayers, coloring them. The student will use as a reminder to pray all through their day.
